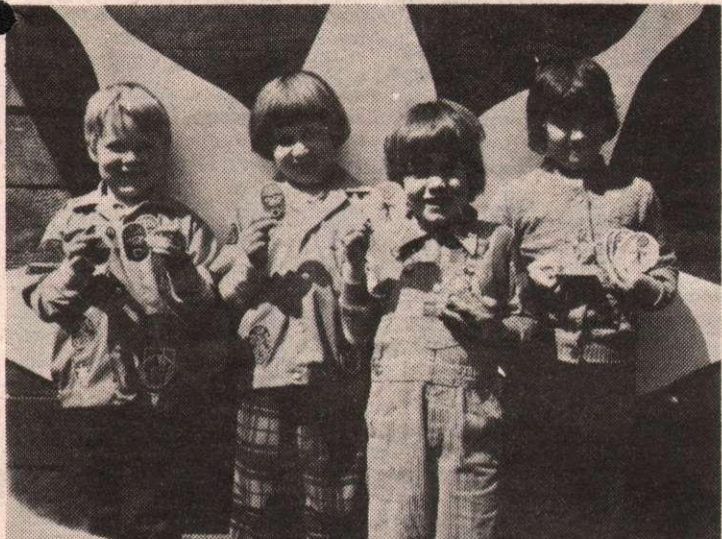

For Nepal home

Mendies Fund offered possible \$20,000 if other donations made

The campaign launched on Salt Spring Island by two women to assist a family in Nepal is having some results.

Doris Anderson, of Beaver Point and Nan Merkeley, of Ganges, sponsored the rummage sale recently in St. George's to raise funds to aid the Mendies family in Kathmandu. The family has steadily adopted so many

orphans that their home constantly overflows.

Mrs. Merkeley was back from the Nepal city when the rummage sale was launched. It raised an initial \$1,000. A subsequent donation of \$800 has been sent to the recipients.

A Calgary philanthropist has offered to donate \$20,000 if the other \$20,000 is raised from

other sources.

The house sought by the Mendies family will cost them \$40,000.

World Wide Vision has contributed \$6,000 and a Florida man has given them \$5,000. The initial Salt Spring Island contribution made it even, with another \$8,000 to find. Total now stands at \$12,800, reports Miss

Anderson and another \$7,200 is needed to reach the point where the \$20,000 will be forthcoming.

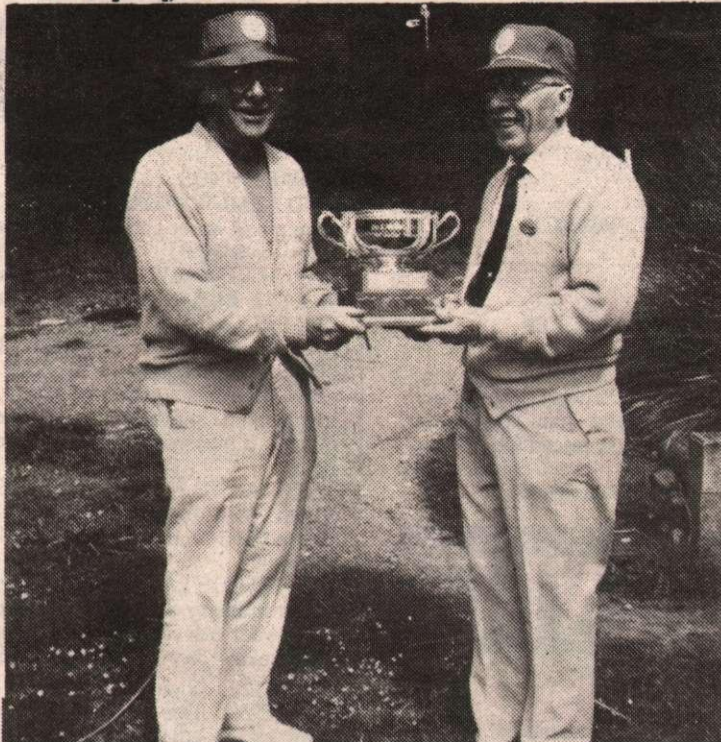
