This is the work of islanders at show

Annual Artercraft show in Mahon Hall, at Ganges, this year is completely revamped. The emphasis is, to a far greater degree, on crafts, while the art display, of paintings and drawings, is located on the hall stage.

Pottery and weaving have taken over the bulk of the display area.

Artercraft is presented every summer by the Gulf Islands Community Arts Council. For the past seven years it has been located in Mahon Hall, allocated to this use by the Gulf Island School Board.

Preview of the showing was offered on Tuesday evening last week, when members of the art council were invited.

Exhibits covered every phase of handicrafts practiced on the islands: and the stipulation is that all articles must be the work of islanders.

The hall was full at the opening and a steady flow of visitors is expected during the summer. Most work exhibited is offered for sale and the arts council retains a small commission on sales.



There is a small admission fee for the show. This fee is not levied if the visitor is a member of the arts council.



New island supermarket to get health permit

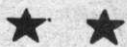
Approval for the grocery supermarket at Valcourt Business Centre in Ganges will likely be given on Wednesday, Driftwood was told this week.

Final plan approved

Ganges Secondary Plan has been finalized by the Ganges Planning Committee after 16 months of "very hard work", reported Regional Director George Heinekey last week.

He expressed his thanks to the committee, which is now disbanded.

The committee had attempted to amalgamate the two reports into the plan which was approved by the committee on Tuesday evening last week, he

explained. The secondary plan had not gained full support of the planning committee and there had been a majority and a minority report presented by that committee.

The plan for the Ganges area will now go before the various regional committees before being given first hearing by the regional board and coming to a public hearing on Salt Spring Island.

The Common Nighthawk is easily recognizable all across southern Canada as it flies high over city streets and roof tops, or open country areas on summer evenings.



A hollow, booming sound is produced by the wings as the bird pulls out of a steep dive while in pursuit of flying insects. Nighthawks catch mosquitoes, flying ants and other insects on the wing. Their enormous mouths, with surrounding bristles, are ideally suited for aerial capture.

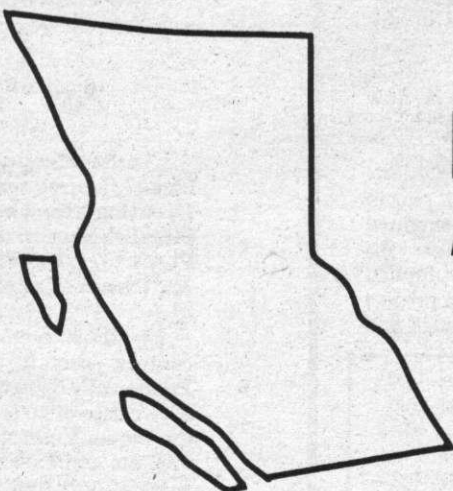

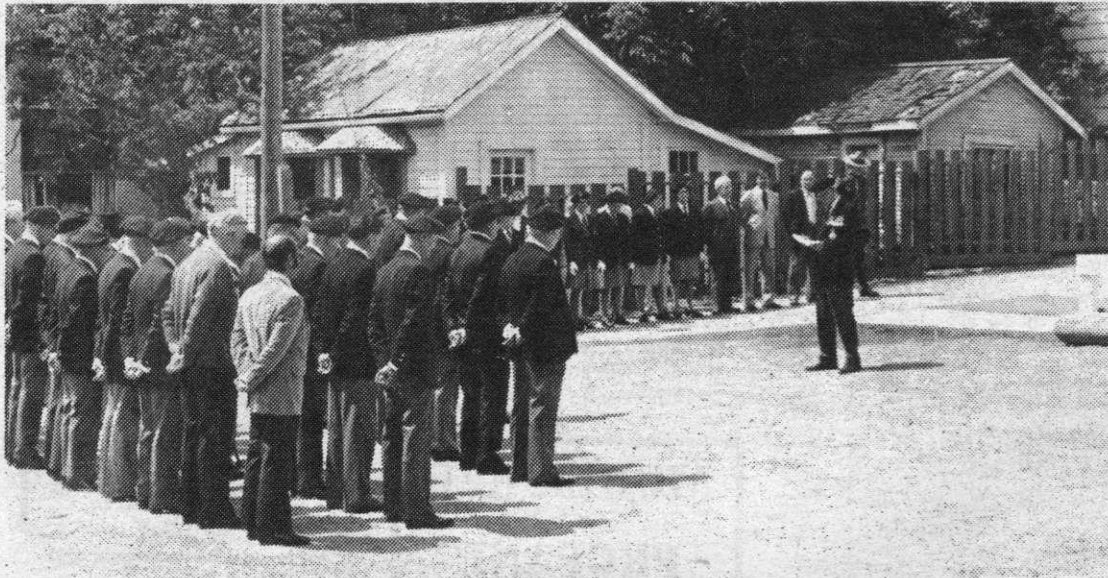

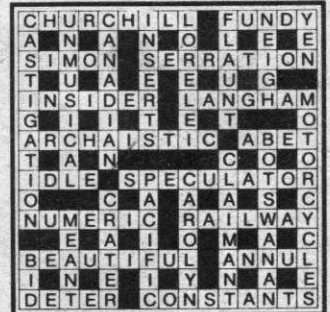
