**OPTION 1** \$52.50 per month for five years to reduce your monthly mortgage payments.

**OR:**  
**OPTION 2** Lump sum payment of \$2,500 to reduce your first mortgage.

Here's how it works. If you're a family with at least one dependent child under age 19, and you're buying your first home, you could be eligible to receive the Grant in whichever of the above options suits you best. There are no income restrictions and no income tax payable on the Grant. Single parent or adoptive families can also qualify.

The Grant can be used for:

You must have a minimum equity of 5% of the value of the home and the home must be priced within certain maximum price limits for the area. These price limits vary

from place to place, but as a guide, the price limit for Delta is \$50,000; for Saanich \$50,000; for Prince George \$44,000; and for Cranbrook \$42,000.

Remember, the programme is for families who have never owned a home before, whether in British Columbia or elsewhere. The Grant is retroactive on all purchases made on or after April 11, 1978.

If you're thinking about buying a home and you think you may be eligible, be sure to find out about the Family First Home Programme. Further information and application forms are available from all Government Agents, all Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing offices and many realtors.

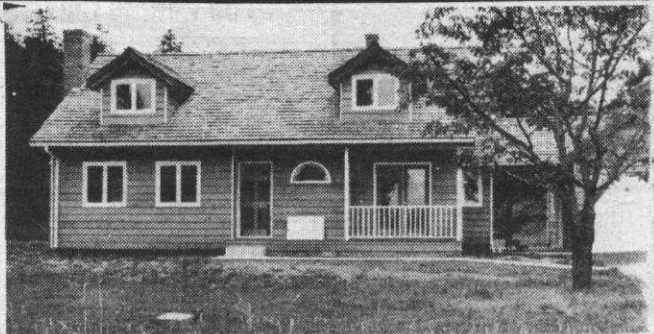
