

# Review committee shares Clement's concern for electoral area forum

On many occasions during the past several years Regional Director Mike Clement has proposed that there be provided a council somewhere between a local committee and an accepted municipal council.

This council would act on behalf of Salt Spring Island residents, administering, recommending and performing small local functions.

The Regional District Review Committee reached the same conclusion.

Here is the committee's recommendations on its proposed Electoral Area Commission.

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### ELECTORAL AREA SERVICES

During its hearings, the Committee heard many times that regional districts are serving a useful purpose in providing the means whereby electoral areas of the province can acquire local facilities and services. Many regional districts were praised for this aspect of their work.

However, there seems to be a need for more participation by people residing in the area concerned, both in the planning, implementation and operation of such services, and in the land use planning of the area.

The Committee, therefore, decided that there should be some mechanism whereby residents of electoral areas could have a clearer voice in local affairs. An elected body to assist and work with the electoral area director and with limited authority over local matters is proposed.

It would take over the responsibilities of the advisory planning commission, which would be abolished.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

This body, called an electoral area commission, would be responsible for:

- (a) Making recommendations to the regional board on local matters, including rezoning and subdivision applications and regional planning.
- (b) Managing local services either directly or through specified area committees.
- (c) Preparing local service budgets for presentation to the regional board.
- (d) Making recommendations with regard to settlement plans.
- (e) Considering such other matters as may be referred to it by the region.

The electoral area commission, would consist of the electoral area

director and four elected members.

Two of these would be elected each year at municipal election time for two year terms. There would be no alternates.

The members of the electoral area commission would elect a chairman annually from amongst themselves.

A vacancy on the electoral area commission may be filled by appointment by the regional board from amongst electors in the electoral area.

Members of the electoral area commission should be reimbursed for expenses incurred while on

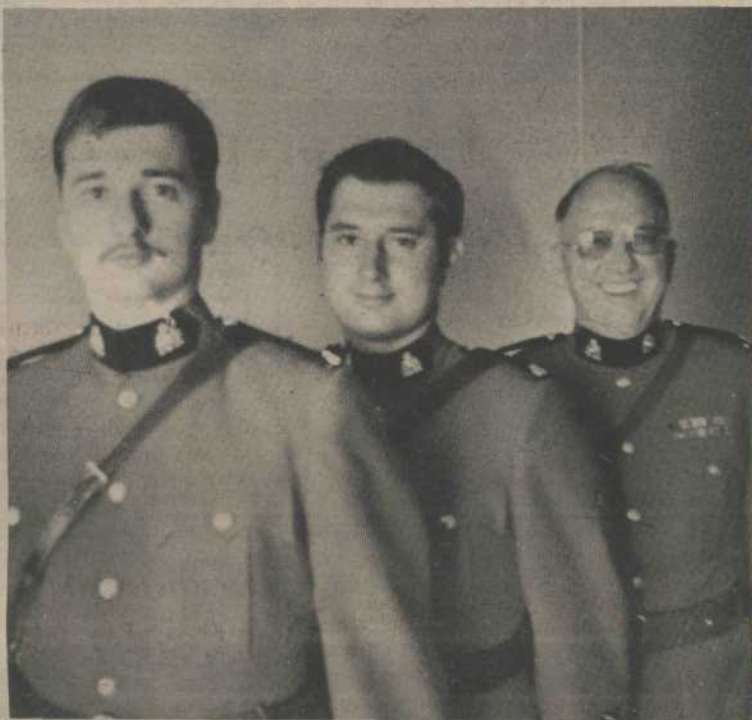
authorized commission business.

### OPEN MEETINGS

The electoral area commission would hold regular open meetings in the area. Staff support, including meeting procedures, accounting and other services, would be provided by the staff of the regional district. The costs would be charged to the electoral area.

The chairman of the regional district board would be an ex officio member of the electoral area commission entitled to take part in discussion at meetings but not vote.

### TEN YEARS AGO

In the Ganges telephone district, which covers all of Salt Spring Island, there have been 108 new connections during the year. This represents an increase of 10.7 per cent. # Gordon Head tramples hapless island Strikers

Gordon Head stepped out of their cars, stepped onto the field, and commenced to step all over the Strikers for the first half of Saturday's game. The only good thing that can be said for that first half is that the Strikers got a tremendous amount of experience in goalmouth scrambles. Unfortunately, they were all in front of our own goal. Although team-wise, this period was a disaster, two members of the Strikers turned in noteworthy performances, one expected, and one a delightful surprise.

**GARNER SHUTS DOOR**

As usual, Mike Cue was superb in goal and registered at least 25 saves in that first half. Much to his credit, only two shots got by him, and one of those was a penalty shot, which no goalie can be expected to stop. The Strikers have a very consistent and determined defensive trio in the persons of Mike Cue, Alan Stacey on left defence, and Peter Schroeder on right defence.

The man sent in to fill this very important position was Darren Garner, and his performance was a delight to watch. Even with the confusion and pressure around the Strikers goal in the early part of the game, it only took Darren about five minutes to figure out where he fit in to the scheme of things and from that time onward, he never made a bad play.

Included in his list of credits are four goal mouth saves, all of which would have been definite goals, had Darren not appeared from nowhere to sweep the ball away just before it went over the goal line.

During the second half, he completely shut the door on Gordon Head on his side of the field and during that entire half, only two attacks from his side resulted in shots on goal, and those were from a long way out.

**CHASE DAZZLES MIDFIELDERS**

Toward the end of the first half, it was noticeable that every time the ball was on the left side of the midfield, a blue shirt baring the number six seemed to be on top of it. Number six is the uniform number of Todd Chase.

Todd's domination of the mid field started slowly at first, every second time the opposition picked up the ball in his area, he moved in to tackle him. By the time the first half was over, it was nine times out of 10. By the mid point in the second half, Todd was not content to tackle Gordon Head players but instead was moving up and muscling them off the ball before they

could get organized. It was obvious that his attitude had changed from defensive to offensive and his change in attitude started filtering through to the other Strikers.

The half backs picked it up first and started to move up and challenge Gordon Head at mid-field, rather than sit back in defensive positions. The forwards started to shake off their checks and get into the open.

Todd's accurate passes to his forward, Ken MacPherson, sprang Ken for five clear breakaways.

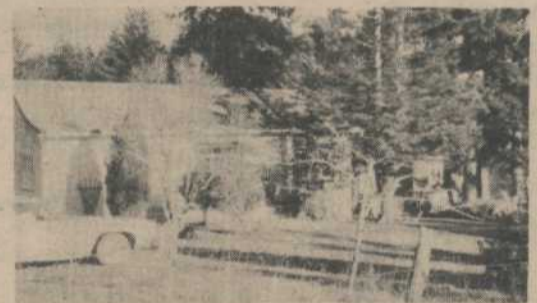

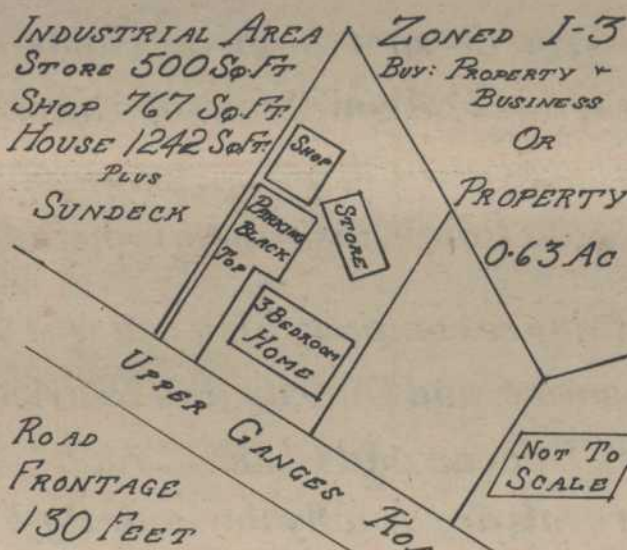

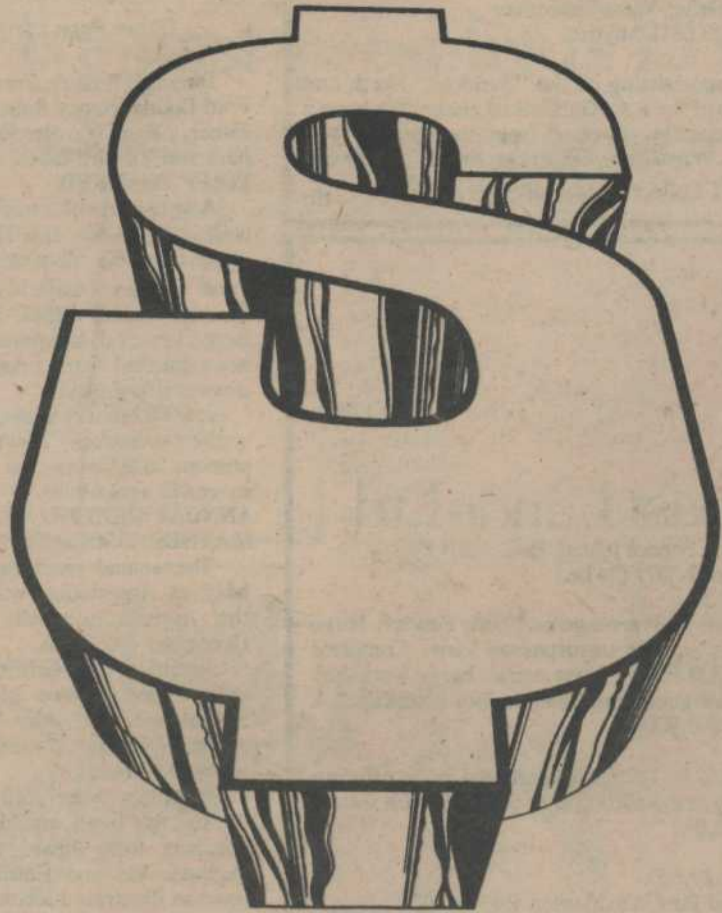
