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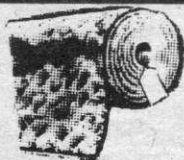

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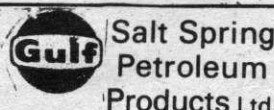

This is the first column in what I hope will be a regular series of reports to the people of Cowichan-Malahat-the Islands. In these columns I plan to keep you informed on some of the issues that concern me as your representative in Ottawa.

For the first few weeks my priority has been to establish offices in Ottawa and also in the different parts of the constituency. Fortunately, I can work with provincial MLA's Frank Mitchell, Barbara Wallace and Dave Stupich in sharing office space and staff in Langford, Duncan and Ladysmith. Since many problems have involved both federal and provincial governments it will help to have one office in touch with both.

In Langford call Sheila McFarlane at 474-2411; in Duncan call Joan Gillatt at 746-4721; in Ladysmith call Anna McMahon at 245-2922. Constituents who live outside these areas are urged to call collect with any problems they may have.

In Ottawa I have attended orientation sessions helping new Members of Parliament to become familiar with the mechanics of their new jobs. Speakers from all parties emphasized the many different pressures in an MP's job. Given the constant Ottawa pressures, each member has to create his own way of maintaining touch with the local constituency and also preserving some semblance of family life.

I enjoyed the first meeting of our new 32-member NDP caucus. The 12 members from B.C. form a large group within that caucus and we will make sure that our concerns are heard.

While we rejoice in larger representation from the west, we regret the loss of valuable NDP MP's from northern Ontario, Nova Scotia, and Newfoundland. Oysters have been here many years

Oysters are found along the west coast of North America from Northern B.C., down to California.

In B.C. there are three species, the Olympia Oyster, which forms a very small part of the market; the Eastern Oyster which was introduced in 1903 to Boundary Bay and is now only a small population in that area, and the Japanese Oyster, introduced in 1912-13 to Ladysmith Harbour and is now found everywhere along the coast and is the only one cultivated for the market.

The Japanese Oyster can grow to a size of 25cm. and live from 15-20 years if left alone.

They start as larva for a month or so and, when large enough, settle on a suitable surface, often other oyster shells or a rock and cement tower shells to this surface. The

rest of life is spent in a sessile existence in this same spot.

Oysters are filter feeders, meaning they take in water and sieve it through gills, which are covered with cilia, they obtain their oxygen and food this way and can filter up to 13 liters of water in an hour.

Oysters are hermaphroditic, they have both male and female gonads and switch back and forth from male to female, ejecting either eggs or sperm into the water where they

meet by chance. An oyster can produce several million eggs at one time.

Oysters are preyed on by starfish and the oyster drill snails, but they have been around for 70 million years or so.

If you are gathering oysters, it is a good idea to shuck them on the beach and throw the shells back as this is where the spat or larval oysters are found, so you will be helping to preserve the next generation.

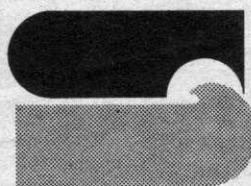

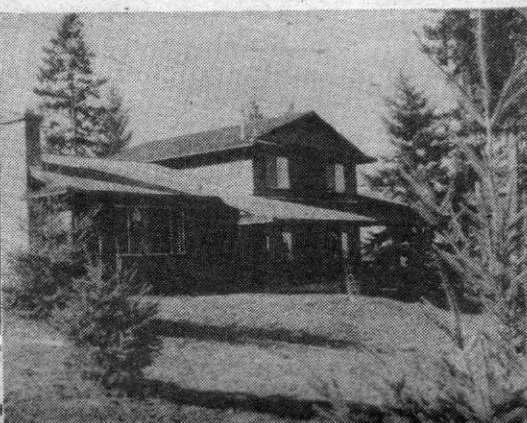

WELFARE

Sue Perkins, like many professionals, is well suited to her job. As a social worker for the ministry of human resources, the 28-year-old University of Calgary graduate has learned to be understanding towards the people she is paid to help.

Perkins is a civil servant; a title she said she has learned to live with, but not one that she feels totally comfortable with.

For the last two years Perkins has been coming to Salt Spring each week. Driving a barely identifiable staff car, she visits her office in Ganges for a short while then heads out to visit those children and adults who come indirectly under her care.

For any social worker first starting out in his chosen career the initial part of the road is usually rough going. There are many things to deal with: frustrations with bureaucracy, opposition from fellow employees and the degree of success one has with those in one's care.

NOT EASY TO HELP

People are not always easy to help, and any social worker will tell you that most clients never get any great measure of benefit from counselling.

With a note of conviction Perkins admitted that her earlier attempts at helping people did not produce

the ideal results which, according to her own nature, she demanded.

"Now my basic premise is that people are doing the best they can with what they have. Once I stopped feeling responsible for people my attitude towards the job changed. I felt a great burden had just gone when I realized I was just a resource for people and not their only hope for a better life."

Perkins said she considers herself a socialist and for that reason she moved to British Columbia from Alberta when the NDP government came into power. "Their (NDP) values are more consistent with social work than other political parties."

A LAWYER

Perkins wanted to be a lawyer while attending university, but she said she soon realized the limiting aspect of life that lawyers deal with. Perkins, who lives in Victoria with her oceanographer husband, has worked out of the Sidney office of the human resources ministry for two years. Before that she spent four years working at the Victoria West office.

On Salt Spring Island Perkins handles approximately 50 different cases, including adoption cases, daycare resources and family service cases. Family services comes under the Protection of Children

Act and utilizes a variety of programs to deal with problems in the home.

Child care workers and homemakers are at the disposal of Perkins who, when asked for assistance, prescribes what she thinks is the proper remedy. Perkins acts as a go-between for adopting parents and the relinquishing mother, and helps foster families plan for the children in their care.

For mothers and fathers who have not learned basic home-making skills, she can find them a homemaker to teach cooking skills, and the necessary funding which is provided by her department.

Parents who are overwhelmed with difficulties or depressed can find relief by calling Perkins. She can contact a child care worker to provide one-to-one input with the children and a homemaker who will take some of the pressure off the parents.

Most of her work is with families, and she considers herself to be a resource person with enough on hand to help most families in need.

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About 130 Salt Spring families are receiving income assistance

Dealing with applications for income assistance, commonly known as welfare, is one of the most stressful jobs in the ministry of human resources.

That is the opinion of Leslie Bell, a financial assistance worker who has been coming to Salt Spring Island each week for almost a year. It is her job to ask the questions required by the regulations of the department: questions that relate to money, work and the relationships of the people who live under the same roof as the applicant.

Because Bell usually has the initial contact with the client, she takes the financial burden and other problems that arise during the first interview. "When people are under financial stress and come into the office yelling and scream-

able to assess another person's crisis, without becoming involved. Although Bell attends frequent workshops dealing with crises and stress, her duties do not include the counselling that an applicant may require. "But we are able to pick up on the indicators of problems that should be passed on to the social worker."

Bell, who is married with a ten-year-old son, works half-time out of the Sidney office. "The time I spend when I'm not working is with my son. I'd like to make up for those years when I was away working."

According to Bell, the type of people she works with on Salt Spring are not like the clients she handled in the city. "People here are more relaxed and easier going," she said, "and are much more resourceful with their

are being met, and that the children are being properly taken care of.

DAYCARE

Bell, who has worked as a daycare supervisor for the government, sees a need for more licensed daycare facilities on Salt Spring. If a mother comes to her requesting daycare there can be a problem finding the facility, especially for small children. "I have to tell mothers to find their own daycare because there is no available list that I can choose from."

Bell said she has all the information a person would need to start a small daycare centre and a social worker from human resources would even visit the home and help the potential operator get through the "red tape".

Any person on welfare can apply for daycare for their children and it is likely they will get it. If people are attending school, looking for a job or just plain down and out, social assistance will pick up the tab for daycare.

Although single people are not encouraged to apply for welfare on the Gulf Islands there are extenuating circumstances which, Bell believes, make it worthwhile giving an interview to everybody who requests one. "If a single person moved here from Victoria with no job then he would be told to move back. If he had a job lined up, then it would be a different matter. Individual circumstances have to be taken into consideration."

CAN CONTINUE

If families on welfare have plans or seem to know what they want for the future then chances are they can continue to collect money for a good number of years until their children are old enough to take care of themselves. However, if the father of the family has no intention of working then the whole family can be cut off income assistance. "I have to follow department policy," Bell said, "and can operate only within the scope of my job."

Whether welfare recipients can survive on the amount of money they receive is a question that Bell said is hard to answer. "Some do and some don't," she replied. "Some people can manage on what they get now while others end up becoming absolutely destitute with no way of recovering. I think we would all like to see an increase in rates but it all goes to individual upbringing. If my parents had brought me up charging everything on their credit cards, it might be more difficult to suddenly be faced with poverty."

UNLIKELY TO SURVIVE

"The fellow who has worked for 10 years at a high paying job is unlikely to survive on welfare if he is suddenly forced to."

The rate for a family of two (mother and child) is currently \$490 per month. If another child is along the way, the mother can look forward to a raise of \$105 on her monthly cheque. Family allowance, foster home payments and child tax credits are some of the incomes that will not affect the amount received from the government. Any additional earned income, over \$100 a family, will be deducted from the monthly cheque.

Once a person is on welfare he is virtually assured that continued assistance will be sent through the

ing, the assistance worker must know how to defuse and handle them," said Bell, who has worked for the department for 11 years.

RANK HIGH

The incidents of illness rank fairly high among assistance workers. Job stress is very high because the worker must listen to and be

money."

SKID ROAD

Nine years ago she worked out of Vancouver's lower Hastings Street office. In 1971, after completing a one-year welfare aid course at Vancouver City College, Bell accepted a position in the department's skid road branch. "It was nothing like working here. In those days only the social worker visited the applicant's home. Now, I get to go out and visit each family; the whole system is more personalized than it was."

On Salt Spring, Bell's case load is made up primarily of single-parent families. The 130-odd names in her book are mostly of people receiving ongoing assistance, she said. "Considering the population of Salt Spring, 130 families is not that many. The figure has remained pretty static since I started coming here except during the winter when the figures can go up as much as 25%."

A home visit is required when income assistance is given to a needy person. The financial assistance worker tries to ascertain whether or not the family's needs

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Centuries-old concept

Bed and breakfast program seen as suitable accommodation here

Picture this scenario: visitors on bicycles, unable to find accommodation on the Gulf Islands, head back to the city and the nearest motel. The islands are great places to visit, they tell their friends, but don't try to stay overnight.

That type of reputation is possibly not what the islands need. In other areas of the province the problem has been resolved with the construction of more motels, hotels and campgrounds. However, the Gulf Islands are not the place for that kind of development, feels the Islands Trust, the body responsible for preserving and protecting the area.

Its solution to the problem of accommodating all types of visitors, especially cyclists and hikers, does not require large investments of capital or any noticeable change in the local scenery. Bed and breakfast is what the Islands Trust sees as a way of retaining the rural atmosphere while at the same time allowing more people than before a chance to vacation here for as long as they wish.

CENTURIES AGO

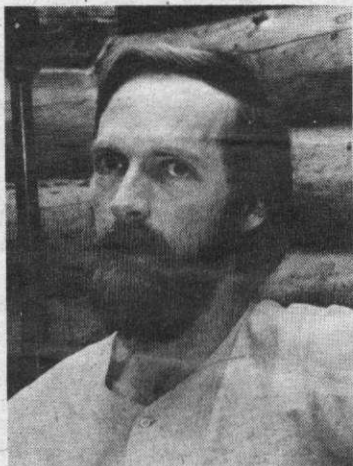
The concept of bed and breakfast began in Europe centuries ago. The maritime provinces, particularly Prince Edward Island and New Brunswick, have recognized the benefits of extending hospitality to visitors directly in the home. Their bed and breakfast program has been in operation for years and can be used as a model.

As a service primarily for overseas visitors, an organization called Bed and Breakfast Canada offers bookings to people who have a spare bedroom and want to earn additional income. As a guideline they suggest that the fees in B.C. be maintained at a certain level and will provide, for a \$45 yearly fee, a directory of tourist accommodation which is distributed free coast to coast.

Your name can be included on their list if you write to them immediately: Bed and Breakfast Canada, #315 - 470 Granville Street, Vancouver, B.C., V6C 1V5.

TO MEET LOCAL PEOPLE
One of the chief proponents of the program for the Trust Area is Nick Gilbert of the Salt Spring Island Community Planning Association. Gilbert and other members of the association see bed and breakfast as an alternative to roughing it in campsites and an opportunity for tourists to meet local people.

"If we developed an itinerary of bed and breakfast homes on the islands," Gilbert explained, "hikers and cyclists could enjoy travelling

shorter distances. This would also cut down the impact of the automobile on the island and would generate a different type of tourist visiting the area."

Gilbert said he didn't think the system would hurt local resort owners as most of them attract a different clientele than the type who would use the bed and breakfast program.

"A little extra income can mean a lot to islanders who are presently just scraping by," said Gilbert.

AT NEXT MEETING
The next meeting of the planning association, at the School Board office on April 14, will deal with bed and breakfast. At approximately 9 pm, following regular business, the meeting will be open to the public for discussion of the idea.

The chamber of commerce has been asked by the planning association for permission to use the tourist booth in Ganges as a centre for bed and breakfast on the islands.

Chamber of Commerce president Jake Javorski said that the chamber approves of the idea and has decided it is definitely needed on the island.

"No one is against the idea," Javorski said. "However, each home must be approved, because if it isn't controlled it would give people a bad impression of the area."

Department of tourism requires each home, if it is to be listed in their directory, to undergo several inspections.

Fred Colthorpe is manager of accommodation services for the tourism ministry. According to Colthorpe, the ministry of health must be contacted if food is going to be served, the fire marshal will want to know if there are adequate exits in the house and an insurance agent should be contacted with regard to liabilities.

MORE INVOLVED

"It's more involved than just opening the door to take in a couple of bucks," he said. Zoning requirements may not permit it, room tax must be paid to the government if more than four people stay over on the same night and income tax will be applied to the earnings of each household.

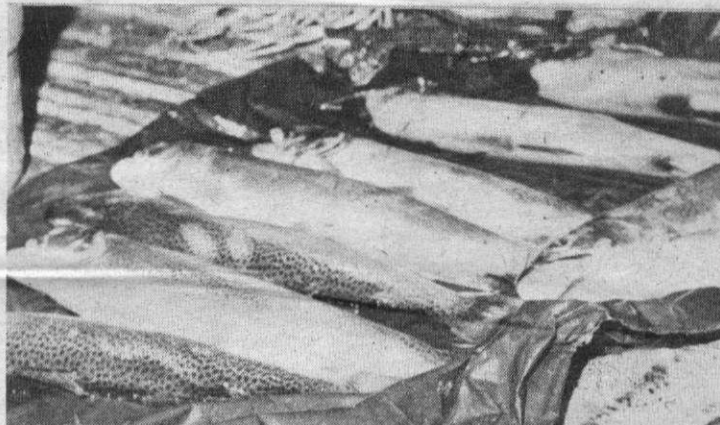
Although Colthorpe didn't know of any such programs in B.C., he said he thought the idea was "wonderful" and quite successful in the maritimes. "I have never heard any complaints surrounding the idea."

He suggested that people should look into all the requirements before embarking on any bed and breakfast venture and they should seriously consider any liabilities.
