

# New store finds customers are friendlier here than in Victoria

One of Ganges' newest stores offers islanders a full selection of new furniture and accessories.

The Traders, located at the Valcourt Centre in Ganges is managed and operated by Lyle Braun and his niece, Marianne Kowalchuk. Kowalchuk's parents own the new store and the Traders store in Victoria, where Braun has worked for 12 years.

For three days a week the two come over from Victoria to open their store on Salt Spring. "I always thought this was a deserted island," said Braun. But business has been good, he added, and the possibility of opening the store up more often is not remote.

"I hadn't realized how many people there are here," he said. Braun also said he thought people here were much friendlier than in Victoria. "Customers here are friendlier and not in such a big hurry."

Both work in the Victoria store where prices, Braun said, "are a little higher than they are here." This can be attributed, he added, to the low overhead and low transportation costs. "The ferry rates to Salt Spring are pretty darn reasonable."

As the name suggests, The Traders does a large business taking used merchandise in trade for the purchase of something new. Trade-ins are shipped to Victoria where they are sold in the other store.

Everything sold at The Traders is covered by a factory warranty or the store's own warranty. A few major appliances are also stocked.

Because the parent store buys

large quantities of furniture, prices can be kept lower than at most other places, he added. The new store contains 2,000 square feet of showroom space and has a 500 square foot warehouse in the back.

obtained his advanced education at U.B.C., Oxford (as the Rhodes Scholar from B.C.) and Toronto, and has written a number of books on political subjects. As part of his current political science assignment at the University of Victoria he is now doing major research for a new book on B.C. government and politics. He is also heard frequently on the C.B.C. as a political commentator.

The May 1 meeting is open to all and there is no charge for admission. The event is sponsored by the Gulf Islands NDP Club.

# Recreation report

from the Salt Spring Island Recreation Commission

Among the guests present at the recent meeting of the Salt Spring Recreation Commission were John Tranter and Ian Thomson. Tranter has been trying to promote wrestling in the local high school without too much success. He reported that he intends to try again once the school term ends.

He is also interested in promoting flag football, a variety of touch football, and this would take place in the summer months. He received the moral support of the commission and a small amount of money for advertising to get the program started.

Thomson is president of the Salt Spring Tennis Association and was present to explain the plans of that organization for the coming summer. Tennis instruction will start on April 21 and continue until June 30. Details will be announced in Driftwood.

Tennis tournaments will be held every two weeks and will of course be open to members of the public in addition to members of the tennis association. Any such organized events will never use more than two courts so that at least one court will always be available for casual play. A number of other projects are planned for later in the summer and will be announced at that time.

### INSTRUCTION FOR STUDENTS

David Reid was present to get the support of the commission in organizing tennis instruction for high school students with an eye to competing with schools from off-island. He was given every encouragement, and practices and instruction will be held for a short time after school twice a week. The students hope to enter the B. C. High School Championships in June.

The Capital Regional District informed the commission that it was preparing an application to the Islands Trust so that a rezoning hearing could be held in connection with application to use some of the subdivided portion of Moutat Park for a possible recreation centre.

In discussing this subject, concern was again voiced by members of the commission that there still seemed to be some misunderstanding on the part of the public as to how the selection of DiCastri and Farmer was made by the commission. Mr. Woodley was asked to prepare an explanation and this appears elsewhere.

The Salt Spring minor softball association asked for a contribution to buy equipment. An amount of \$300 was voted to buy bats, balls and bases. Registration has already been held.

### FITNESS TRACK

A letter was received from Hal Leighton in Nanaimo concerning a fitness track. This is a jogging course with exercise equipment, which adds variety as well as improves the value of the exercise. Two members of the commission will go to Nanaimo to view this in the hope that some similar project could be set up here.

Glenn Woodley then introduced special guest Jim Lee, who is employed by the provincial government but is serving as a field representative for the C. R. D. He explained his duties and how he might be able to help the Recreation Commission.

He reviewed what grants had been awarded to Salt Spring Island by the provincial government since 1973, and this amounted to \$167,528.31. He then explained how the commission should go about applying for financial assistance for a recreation centre if this should come to pass.

There didn't seem to be any reason why this money would not be available in our case. He also outlined how part-payment for staffing of such a project might be done. He will return any time we ask for his assistance.



## Weight clinics popular at Pender

A Pender Island resident has her weight checked at the newly-established weekly weight clinic. Nurse Susan Powell, who arrived on the island from Toronto recently, initiated the clinics, held Thursdays at 6 pm in Dr. Sutherland's

office. Response to the program has been described as terrific, as some 40 to 50 islanders have attended clinics to learn how to shed unwanted pounds by correcting their eating habits.

## Thieves take \$400 from post office

Thieves netted \$400 last weekend when they broke into the Galiano Post Office, RCMP reported Monday.

Police said the culprits removed \$150 in cash and \$250 worth of stamps from a safe which they ripped open.

Experts from Victoria were flown in by helicopter to assist the Ganges detachment in their investigation. A police spokesman said the safe was opened with an axe or similar tool and was an unprofessional job.

The investigation is continuing, he said.

# Some will follow anyone: megalomaniac or faded star

The tragic life and death of Jim Jones, as portrayed on television last week demonstrated not so much the triumph of evil as the evil of infallibility.

Only God is always right, and the amount of truth contained in "power corrupts and absolute power corrupts absolutely" depends on the measure of infallibility claimed by the powerful.

A good person attempts to do good and succeeds. Given the circumstances of Jim Jones' beginning, he could hardly fail. His perversion came when he accepted the praises lavished on him as his due. Had he given the credit to God he and his flock might still be alive today.

Infallibility, like all absolutes, is inhuman and dangerous. If the televised account of his life was correct, surely Father Divine must be held partially to blame for the corruption of Jim Jones. But he keeps a low profile and is presumably seen as a benign tumour rather than the cancer represented by Jones.

### HARD TO FATHOM

Did "Father" Jones really believe he was God? Megalomania is hard to fathom. In a sense all killers believe they are godlike, or they would not dare to take another's life. All criminals, indeed all those we dub "anti-social", possess a feeling of godship: their needs override those of their victims.

It's not a long step from there to those who exploit others for profit!

Infallibility wears many hats and many faces. Those who condemn others to poverty; to imprisonment, torture, exile - they must be so sure they are right and all those others are wrong - or relatively unimportant!

I remember the Rev. Fred Anderson's counsel to a man searching for spiritual answers. "Search everywhere," he said. "Ask questions and pray. I can't tell you where you will find your answers. But this I know: beware of those who say, 'We have the only answer.'"

Jim Jones began by doing good and ended by becoming a monster. How did he go wrong? When he came to believe that he alone was always right. That his desires alone must be fulfilled, and that all others owed him homage and obedience.

He was a glaring example of the

double standard practised by the sanctimonious. While practising homosexuality he condemned it in others; while dissolving marriages he held his wife in thrall. Why? Because he, being God, was above the laws made for the common folk.

I'm guilty. Are you? I make rules for my children which I don't keep (but they are only children!) I preach "by Canadian" and I buy what I can afford, which often isn't Canadian. (Thereby perpetuating the poverty in Korea or Taiwan which I deplore). There's always a reason, that's the frightening thing! Poor Jim Jones had a reason once.

A master of inconsistency, at least he doesn't claim infallibility. When retracting remarks he had made about Vietnam veterans not receiving the G.I. Bill of Rights, he put the blame on the shoulders of two four-star generals!

But what a man to be coming so close to presidency of the world's most influential nation! A man who has claimed to reduce the welfare rolls of millions of dollars - by admitting those same tax dollars were those he himself had gouged from those same people who are

now rapturously saying, "Reagan is the man for me!"

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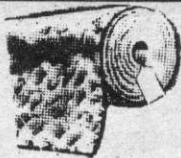
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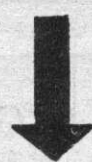



Police are reminding motorists that the use of studded snow tires will be against the law after midnight April 30.

Sgt. Mitch Hanks of the local RCMP said that a \$15 fine is the penalty given to offenders.

Also, assistant fire chief Les Wagg says that after May 1 permits will be required for any open fire on Salt Spring, including fires on the beach below high tide mark.


## TWENTY YEARS AGO

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

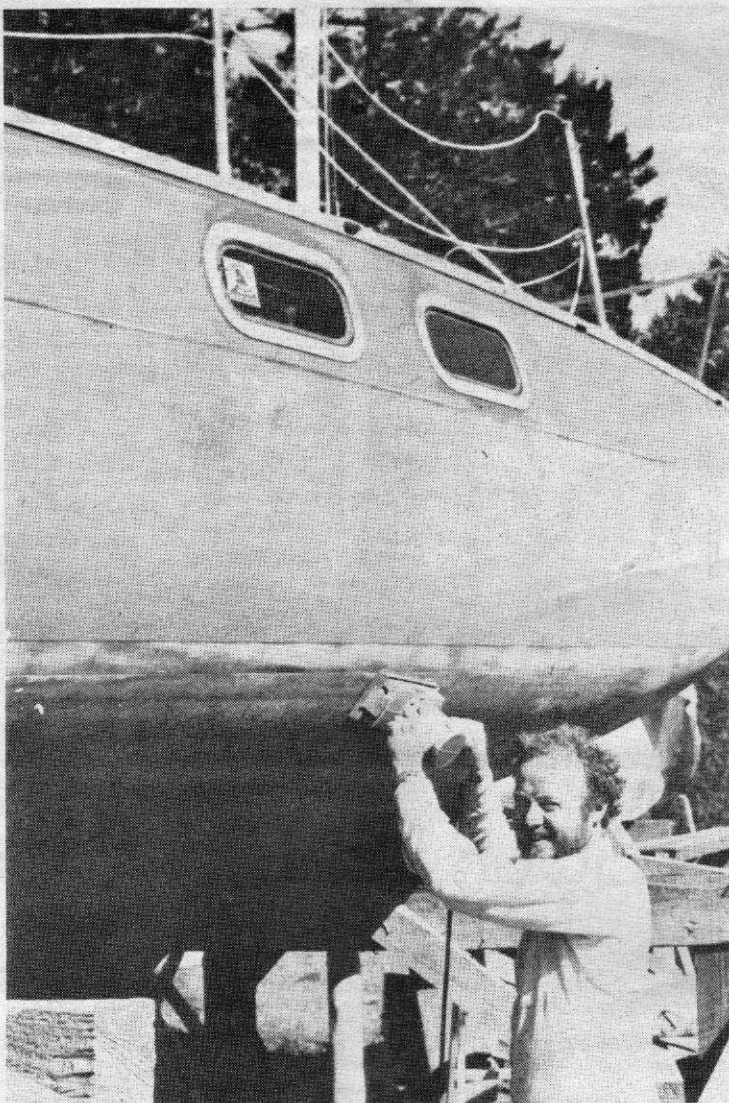

diate employment of an extra nurse.

One resident attending the meeting criticized the present British Columbia government for pinching pennies in the area of health care and then allotting money for such matters as a feasibility study of a tunnel between the mainland and Vancouver Island.

Another resident asked Dr. Arneil whether or not he recognized the situation on the islands as one of emergency. He stated that he had been involved in an emergency situation on Mayne Island when a nurse was unavailable and he was fearful of a recurrence.

### HADN'T KNOWN

Arneil answered that he had not known that an emergency situation existed before.

John Rainsford told Arneil that he himself had informed the doctor that there was dissatisfaction regarding health care in the islands prior to that meeting. Rainsford proposed the formation of a working committee to resolve the problems as laid out by Gina Dingwall.

Fred Flick offered his services as a consulting officer while residents volunteered to sit on the committee.

Five committee members are Denise Fragomeni, Roy Betts, Margaret Billsten, Sandy Ingram and Clara James.

Denise Fragomeni presented a petition to the CRD calling for an examination of the whole islands health scene. She commented further that "little could be done working with Dr. Arneil" that afternoon.

She had been advised by the ministry of health, she said, that only the CRD could make recommendations to the provincial government for more money. As medical officer Arneil administers the policy of the CRD but is not engaged in formulating policy.

Critics of the health program on Mayne Island have called for the resignation of director Jim Campbell on the grounds that he does not reflect the wishes and concerns of the islands residents.

They were disappointed that the regional director for the Outer Islands was not present at Saturday's meeting, *Driftwood* was told.

The group is circulating a petition on the islands calling attention to the provision of health services. The petition will be sent to the community health committee of the Capital Regional District.
