GROUNDSTROKES THE BACKHAND

Very often, the problem with the backhand stroke for beginners starts with a difficulty in changing to a backhand grip. As a suggestion, try waiting in the ready position with a backhand grip, so that you are ready as soon as the ball comes to your backhand.

If the ball is on your forehand, you will automatically change to your forehand grip. Once you have

become accustomed to this, you can revert to the normal forehand grip when waiting.

As stated last week, early preparation is most important. Begin your backswing early, keep it relaxed, but stiffen the wrist. The sooner you have the racket back, the better your chances of hitting a good shot. If you wait till the last moment, your backswing will be rushed and you will likely mis-hit

the ball.

Make contact with the ball a comfortable distance from the body. Too close - no power; too far - loses control and pace. Again, like the forehand, make a full, free follow-through, finishing with the racket head high in front of the right shoulder with the shoulders staying perpendicular to the net.

The executive is chosen from this group. Mrs. Turner continues as president and Jim Dunn as treasurer.



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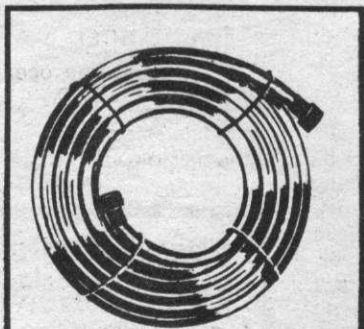
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New dormitory rises in Kathmandu

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Motion for full spectrum lights rejected by trustees

Full spectrum lighting will not be experimented with in the Ganges elementary school, Gulf Islands school trustees decided last week. Only two trustees voted in favour of

a motion to replace burned out fluorescent tubes with the full spectrum type.

The parents advisory committee of the school had shown a film on the subject to trustees and had requested that the board try the lights.

The board decided several meetings ago to request information from the Greater Victoria School Board, which is contemplating an experiment with the lights in one Victoria area school.

Trustee Tom Davidson, from Saturna, said the motion annoyed him. "The move is an attempt to circumvent the board's efforts to obtain information from the Victoria school district."

Trustee David Stacey said he saw the film and read a book on the subject but was still unconvinced that full spectrum lights helped hyper-active children.

Strick Aust, who presented the motion, said that he thought the existing lights in the school were too harsh and were a cause of tension in the classrooms. "I think everyone will agree to that, but not everyone will agree that full spectrum is the answer."

Aust told the board that even if the motion was defeated he still wanted an investigation into lighting in the schools.

Development of park sought at Cusheon Lake

Thirty acres of land on the south side of Cusheon Lake is now under the control of the Salt Spring Parks and Recreation Commission.

The commission has applied to the provincial government for permission to develop the site into a community park, featuring picnic tables, washrooms and a beach for swimmers.

Commission chairman Glenn Woodley told *Driftwood* that the property would not be the site for a major development by the commission. He said the park will be designed for the use of the community.

The land was given to the people of Salt Spring Island in 1957 by Powell River Logging, a company now owned by MacMillan Bloedel.

Woodley said the land has been held by the Chamber of Commerce. He added that the commission had been looking for lakefront property on the island for a small park. Only recently did the Cusheon Lake property come to the attention of commission members, he said.

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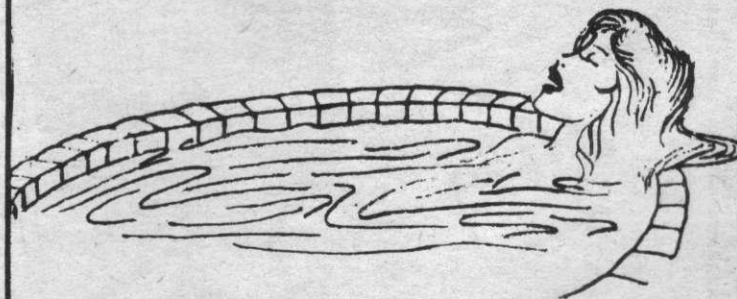
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
