two were well supported by Audrey Thomas, Akasha Haenan, Johanna Newmoon and Andrew Loveridge. As the Duke remarks, the play "was very notably discharged".

So much fun was shared by both players and the audience, it seemed a pity that the most hilarious scene of all, the death by their own hands of Pyramus and Thisbe, did not conclude the story as it does in *Midsummer Night's Dream*. Perhaps this scene may be added to the Galiano repertoire for performance at a future Summer Solstice Festival.

The finale was provided by the Sweet Adelines, a Beauty Salon grouping consisting of Heather Martin, Mary Harding, Jackie Besler, Johanna Newmoon, Ursula Medley, Lynda Kenyon and Akasha Haenan. Their dulcet a cappella tones made pleasant music of old favourites.

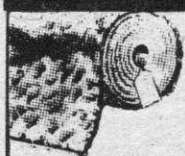

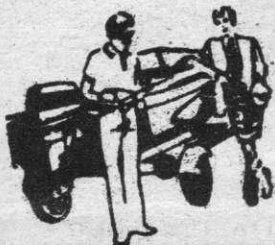

Down Through the Years With Driftwood

FIVE YEARS AGO

New provincial health centre on Mayne Island will be a community project from start to finish. The building is to be constructed on the Mayne Island Improvement District property opposite the school. First local participation will be in the form of site preparation. The building will be partially furnished by the community.

Last year property owners in the Hundred Hills area complained to the police that they had lost lengths of garden hose. Police looked around but could find no trace of it. This week the tale came to a close when Ganges RCMP found some 500 feet of old hose. It had been used to take water from the reservoir. Identity of the thieves could not be ascertained.

Man who gave his blood and the man who was instrumental in taking it took part in a recent ceremony on behalf of the Canadian Red Cross. The man who was honoured for donating blood was J.N. McConnell of Old Scott Road. He was presented with a certificate to mark the donation of his 35th pint of blood. Man who made the presentation was Peter Bingham,

who has sparked the Legion blood clinics for a number of years.

TEN YEARS AGO

Residents of Beaver Point Road are alarmed at the danger to children using Stowell Lake. Fast traffic on the newly paved road represents a grave threat to youthful bathers. *Driftwood* was told this week. When a group of children was crossing the road to the lake recently, a motorcycle came round the corner at a rate of speed. An accompanying adult snatched a small child from the road seconds before the motorcycle reached them, said a local resident. She asked for traffic control on the road and enforcement of speed restrictions.

Number of lawn bowlers and prospective lawn bowlers on Salt Spring Island want help. The bowlers are eager to go ahead with long-standing plans to establish a bowling green in Centennial Park at Ganges.

FIFTEEN YEARS AGO

A Mayne Island resident was rescued by local businessmen Slim Thorburn and Mac Mouat when the man's dugout skiff capsized in Active Pass last Wednesday. Felix Jack, a resident of Mayne on Active Pass, was pulled from the water quickly when his boat sank. Slim Thorburn's boat was nearby and managed the rescue. Jack was taken ashore and when checked on

by the RCMP boat next day seemed none the worse for his spill.

It was nice last week to see the *Pender Queen* docking again at Ganges after a long absence. The Outer Islands ferry has resumed daily calls at this point for the duration of the summer schedule.

Frank Jones, key figure involved in a fatal accident on the Fulford-Ganges Road last July, was convicted of criminal negligence and was sentenced to 90 days in jail. Jones was also barred from driving for four years. The accident, a head-on crash between the Jones vehicle and one driven by Victor Sholes, resulted in the death of Sholes and critical injuries to Mrs. Sholes.

TWENTY YEARS AGO

A motion to purchase four acres of the Vic Jackson property on Scott Road for use as a Rod and Gun Club shooting range was overwhelmingly endorsed by a 28 to 1 vote at the meeting held last Friday.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE is hereby given that all persons who deem their interest in property affected by the following proposed By-laws will be afforded an opportunity to be heard on the matters contained therein at a Public Hearing to be held in the North Pender School and Community Hall, North Pender Island on SATURDAY, JULY 5, 1980, commencing at 10:00 am.

- Proposed By-law No. 6 for South Pender Island is a By-law to amend the "Official Community Plan (South Pender Island) By-law, 1973" by amending the section on Forest Areas to provide for a single family dwelling and one cottage per parcel.
- Proposed Zoning By-law No. 4 for South Pender Island is a By-law to regulate the use of land, buildings and structures and regulate the height and siting of buildings and structures on South Pender Island. The regulatory provisions of this By-law have been drawn up to conform as closely as possible with the policies contained in the Official Community Plan for South Pender Island, adopted by Capital Regional District By-law No. 129 in 1974. The By-law establishes both provisions of general applicability and provisions and regulations for each of the eight (8) zones established by the By-law.

The 'General Provisions' section of the proposed By-law includes regulations and requirements for such items as the issuance of Development Permits; building setbacks from lakes, swamps, ponds and the sea; home occupations and off-street parking.

The zones may be summarized as follows:

RURAL I (RI) ZONE

Allows for land uses such as residential, agricultural, parks, ecological reserves, home occupations, public services, golf courses, riding stables, lighthouse stations. One single family dwelling and one seasonal cottage per parcel is permitted.

AGRICULTURAL (A) ZONE

Recognizes Agricultural Land Reserve lands and allows for land uses such as those permitted in the Agricultural Land Commission Act. Except as otherwise permitted by the Provincial Agricultural Land Commission, one dwelling unit and one seasonal cottage per parcel is permitted.

PUBLIC AND RECREATION (P) ZONE

Allows for land uses such as parks, campsites, boat launching ramps and a caretaker's residence.

RESOURCE PROTECTION (RP) ZONE

Allows for land uses such as residential, parks, playgrounds, golf courses, home occupations and boat launching ramps. One single family dwelling or one seasonal cottage per parcel is permitted.

FOREST AND WILDLAND (F) ZONE

Allows for land uses such as residential, parks, nature house, home occupations and portable sawmills. One single family dwelling and one seasonal cottage per parcel is permitted.

COMMERCIAL I (CI) ZONE

Allows for a range of commercial services and retail uses. Residential use is permitted in conjunction with the commercial use, under specified conditions.

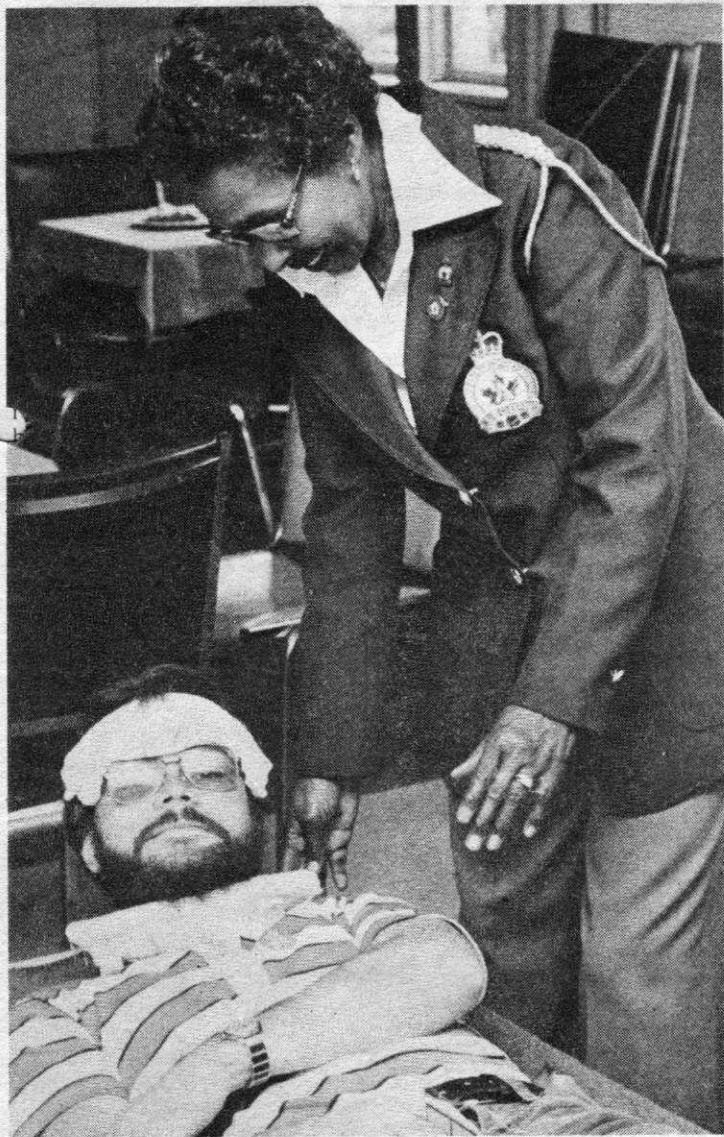
WATER ZONES (WA, WB)

Regulation of water and foreshore uses. WA permits non-commercial boat moorage. WB provides for foreshore oriented commercial facilities.

Where land is classified as Agricultural Land Reserve, the provisions of the Agricultural Land Commission Act shall take precedence over the By-law.

Copies of the proposed By-laws may be reviewed at Bedwell Harbour Resort, South Pender Island, between the hours of 8:00 am to 9:00 pm, Monday through Sunday inclusive. The proposed By-laws may also be reviewed at the Islands Trust Office, 848 Courtney Street, Victoria, B.C. during normal working hours of 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday inclusive.

You know what my spinach did? Nothing. Nothing at all since April 15. It reached two inches in height two weeks ago and then turned to seed.

All of this leads me to believe that it has been too cold and too wet for too long. A little bit of sun and a little bit of heat will fix that. So, if things aren't doing as well as they should, that is why; and if things are doing just fine, you probably live in our local riviera, Vesuvius.

Well, I am planting my cucumbers for the third time this year. Both direct seeded into the hills and in my bottom-heated propagating box, just to make sure. Something has to grow somewhere. **NOT TOO LATE**

For all the folks who are having similar problems, it is not too late to start cucumbers, squash, pumpkin (it's doing just fine) or melons right now. Out of the six seeds planted in each hill, I got one little plant, hanging in there. Usually I get six out of six from my reliable Stokes seeds. That's why I am seeding for the third time now.

On the bright side, the peas are doing well; lovely pea weather we have had. Onions look just fine; especially the "autumn spice", and the tomatoes too, surprisingly. Although some folks seem to have problems with some of their tomatoes, a little heat will fix that soon enough.

Cabbages are doing just fine. They just love all that moisture and the chicken manure side dressing. The cool temperatures seem to suit them just to a tee. All the other stuff is coming along nicely, and so are the weeds. I am sure they are cold weather weeds.

Had a bit of a problem with my bed of dill. That is where the horsetail decided to grow in profusion. It takes better than 20-20 vision, augmented by intense concentration, to distinguish between the two. I guess that's why couchgrass loves to grow among the onions. It must be some kind of self-preservation instinct which makes them think that they can get away with it.

BRING UP NUTRIENTS

Thistles don't bother with disguises. I don't mind them really,

for they bring up subsoil nutrients and minerals with their deep roots. I am going to have a lot of subsoil nutrients this year, I can see that already.

Some of the tomatoes got some seaweed mulch, and some of them didn't. The ones with seaweed mulch are greener, look better and have fewer weeds; except for thistles. But then that gives me more subsoil nutrients. So, next chance we get it's off to the beach for seaweed.

So keep on top of the weeds, and look closely: Horsetail is not nearly as good with pickles as dill is.

A light weeding more often is far better and less time consuming than an emergency operation

against a dense jungle. A three by 50-foot bed takes me about 20 minutes to weed about once a week. The weeds go into the walks to be tilled under or on the compost. (All those subsoil nutrients).

SUCCESSION SEEDING

Reseed the spotty or poor rows, and do some succession seeding with bush beans, carrots, beets, lettuce, peas, radish and spinach. I have sown bush beans as late as July 15 with excellent results.

Use both manure tea and seaweed tea to boost lagging candidates; manure tea for the green leafy vegies and seaweed for the fruiting vegies as well as for the others. But don't use manure tea on peppers and tomatoes unless you have a severe nitrogen deficiency. In other words, you can use seaweed tea on everything but manure tea only leafy green vegies.

The last two columns were on heat loving and drought resistant shrubs and trees; I know now it was wishful thinking.

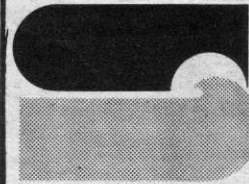
To all the winners who I can't mention - well done, you obviously deserved it. To those who didn't win - next year, it's never too late.

New courts to be opened Saturday

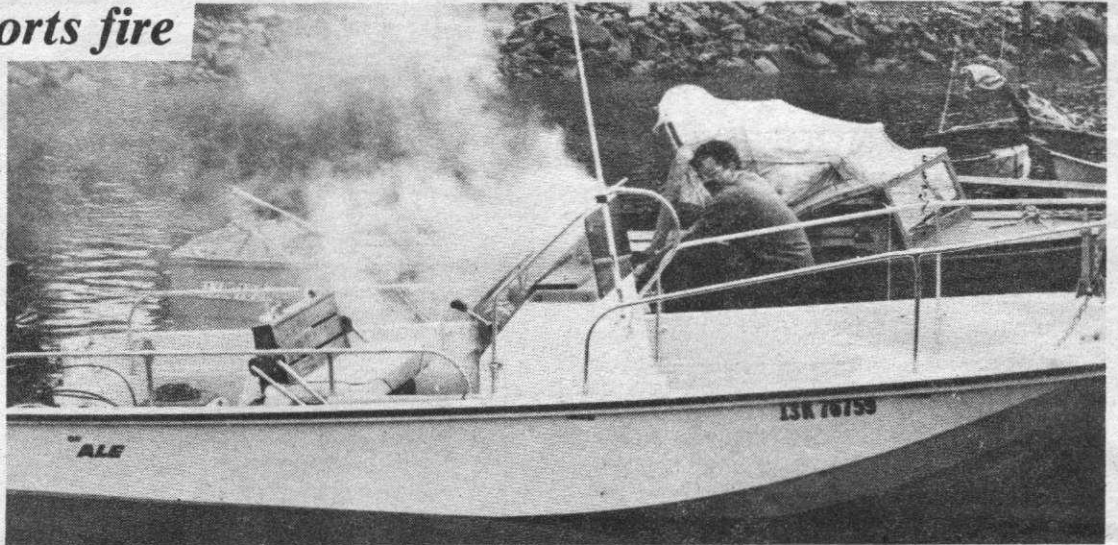
Tennis will soon become the sport of the day at Mayne Island with the opening of the new tennis courts on Saturday.

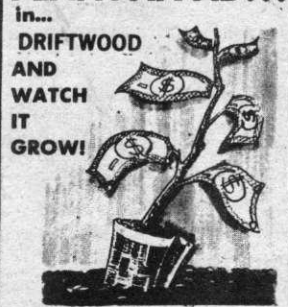
Farmers' market at Mayne

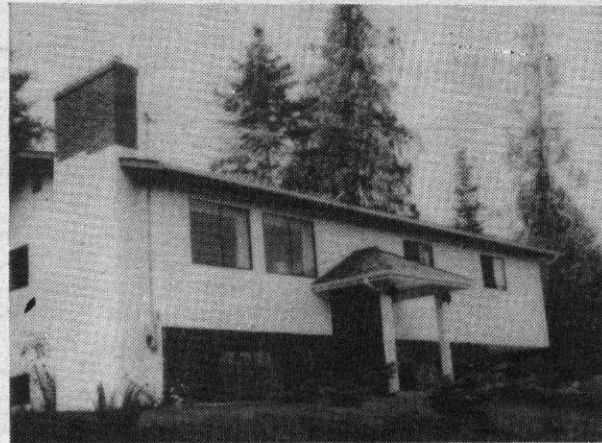

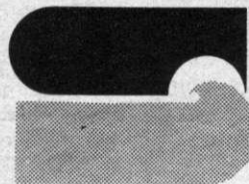

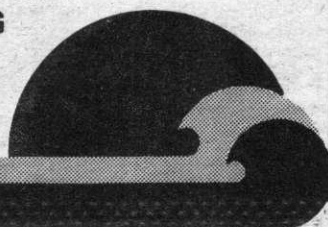

SALT SPRING ISLAND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
By-Law No. 32

A By-law respecting the installation of fire hydrants within subdivisions of land in the area comprising the District.

The Trustees of Salt Spring Island Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Every owner of a proposed subdivision shall submit to the Trustees of the District for approval, following submission of the same to the Department of Highways for approval of such subdivision plan under the Land Registry Act, the following:
 - (a) The necessary plan of subdivision of lands, showing each and every lot, including all common property situated therein.
 - (b) A plan of the waterworks system including any and all fire hydrants, sprinklers, or swimming pools to be connected to such system within such subdivision.
2. Before the Trustees of the District approve the subdivision plan as hereinbefore submitted, they may require the owner or owners of the proposed subdivision to deposit a sum of money or Government of Canada bonds and their guarantees or Province of British Columbia bonds and their guarantees, as a guarantee that fire hydrants will be installed therein.
3. Every owner of a subdivision and every owner of land who subdivides any parcel of land within the District shall install at his own expense and at no cost to the District, and under the supervision of the Trustees of the District, or their representative, all hydrants deemed necessary by the District to provide an adequate supply of water for fire protection within the said subdivision, and shall pay for all engineering costs; the said fire hydrants shall become the property of the District.
4. Every owner who disobeys or fails to comply with any provision of this By-law shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding Two Thousand Dollars and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.
5. By-law No. 16 is hereby repealed.
6. This By-law may be cited as "Subdivision Fire Hydrants Regulations By-law".

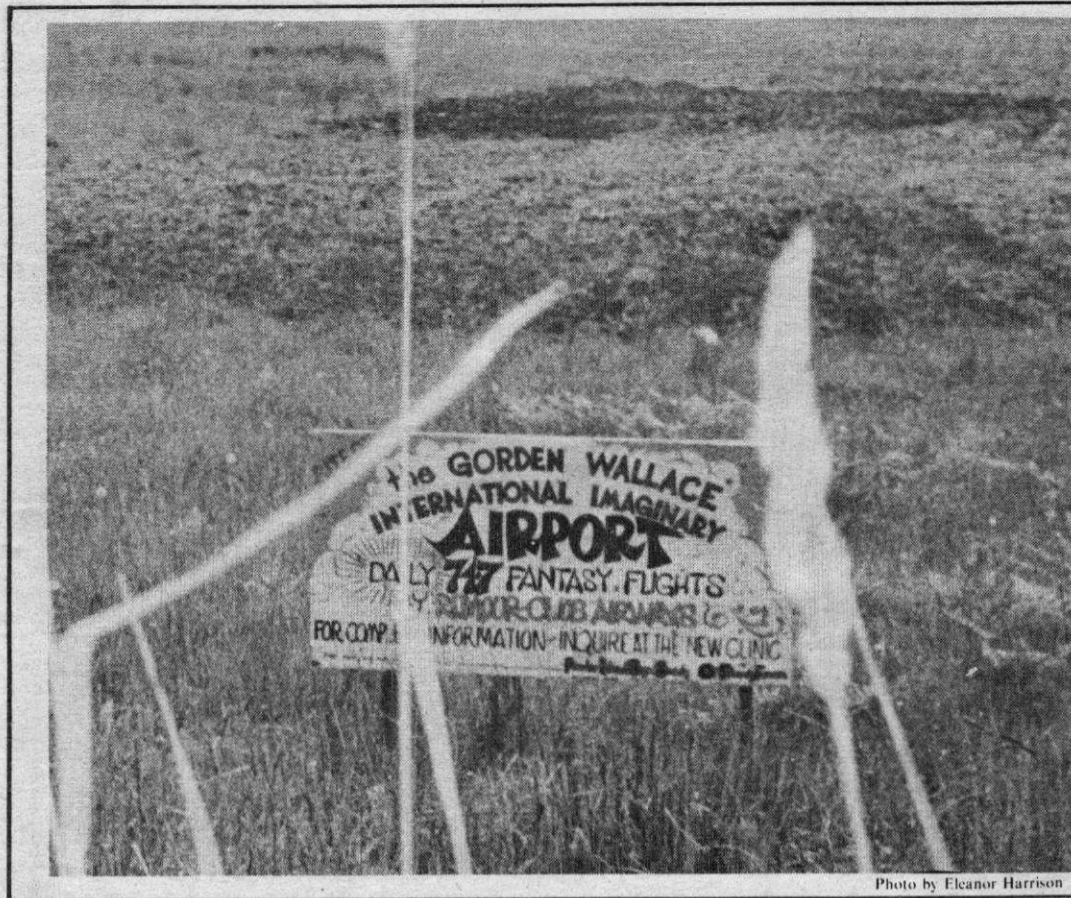

Sign is just rumour, but airfield a fact

Although it has been a few weeks since this sign was erected, there have been no reports of 747's landing at the new airfield at Pender Island. It would appear, in fact, that the information conveyed by the sign is merely rumour.

However, property owner Bob Fearn has announced that he intends to construct an airfield on which to land his own plane.

Meanwhile, the B.C. Agricultural Land Commission has advised Fearn that he must have permission for conditional use of the land, which lies in the agricultural land reserve.

The airstrip has been named after Pender Island Trust representative Gordon Wallace.

Commission asks Trust for smaller limits on split lots

Islands Trust decision to permit subdivision of properties split by a highway, provided that the smaller parcel so created is not less than three-quarters of an acre, was challenged last week by the Salt Spring Island Advisory Planning Commission.

The planning commission heard an appeal from A. Paul of Long Harbour Drive for permission to divide his property under the same program, although the smaller resulting parcel will be fractionally less than the statutory three-quarters of an acre.

The Salt Spring Island Trust Committee recently introduced a bylaw to permit division of split lots. A split lot under the bylaw is one that has been severed by a highway where no communication exists between the two halves without crossing a public road.

There are 89 such lots on Salt Spring Island, eight of which provide for a lot smaller than the requisite size, the commission was told.

Thirty-six are smaller than a quarter-acre; 16 are between a quarter and a half; seven measure three-quarters to one acre and 22 are larger than one acre, the commission learned.

No more are being made. Where the gazetting of a new road splits a parcel of land the ministry of highways now acquires the smaller piece, it was explained.

There are smaller lots already subdivided on the island, commented regional director Yvette Valcourt.

SHE SEES HALF-ACRE

"I can't see a quarter-acre, but I can see a half-acre."

The community plan was not predicated on the creation of more lots, commented trustee Bud Kreissl. The retention of the three-quarter acre size would exert a hardship in some instances, pursued the director.

The bylaw was prepared in an effort to relieve some of the hardships, said planner Dean Strongitharm.

Owner of the property cited a new subdivision on Salt Spring Island in which the lots are only half an acre.

It was explained that under the averaging principle this was feasible.

The minimum size should be brought down to a half-acre or there should be no more subdivisions approved in which lots are permitted less than three-quarters of an acre, said Paul.

"These people deserve consideration," suggested director Valcourt.

WHERE IS THE LINE?

"Where do you draw the line?" asked trustee David Lott. "Set it at half an acre and you'll have people saying, 'What about us.'"

He is still paying taxes on the lot, although it is of no value to him, explained the owner.

"Do you think anyone would buy it?" asked Lott.

"I'll sell it to you!" flashed back Paul.

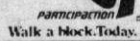
There was no deal. Motion of director Valcourt that lots of one-half to three-quarters of an acre be accepted, in the case of split lots, was approved.

The motion of the Advisory Planning Commission is not binding on the Islands Trust Committee. The committee will receive that recommendation and it may adopt it at the next meeting. If the Trust Committee goes along with the proposal, then it has to be approved at a public hearing before it becomes statutory.

The two local trustees both voted against the recommendation.

The lot in question is only 200 square yards short of three-quarters of an acre.
