The Artcraft show has been an annual feature of Salt Spring Island since the initial days of the Arts Council. Each summer the Mahon Hall is devoted to the exhibition.

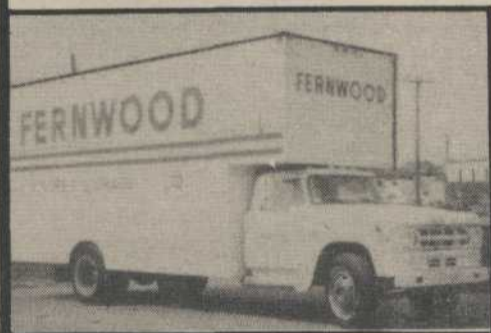

**Director Valcourt reports**

**Seeking support for anti-bus campaign**

I, at this time, must come to you for support on the matter of Hydro Levy for Urban Transit Authority, for the following reasons:

1. My motion of June 11 to exclude Salt Spring Island from the urban transit area, was declared lost by error, the votes stood at 21 in favour and 20 against and it is so recorded in the minutes of that meeting.

The chairman, J.M. Campbell, declared that motion lost! Nobody around the board table was able to explain why this motion was lost. 2. Thursday, June 12 I, personally, placed a call to the legal department of the ministry of municipal affairs and requested from them the interpretation of this declaration of motion as being lost. I requested to find out why with a majority of the votes we had not had this motion declared carried?

3. Friday, June 13, a letter from Mr. Campbell addressed to all board members:

"From examination of the Municipal Act I have now concluded that the motion to exclude Salt Spring Island from the transit service area should have been declared carried. This error can be corrected in the minutes at the time of the next board meeting.

"In order that there will be no further delay, however, I have instructed the executive director to place a request to the Urban Transit Authority, at once, to have Salt Spring Island excluded from the transit service area."

4. Mr. Campbell, at the June 25 board meeting, acknowledged that he had made an error in declaring the motion lost, and requested a motion to endorse his action taken to correct the error. It was so moved and seconded. The discussion that followed, the motions after motions and no ruling from the chair, as to whether or not the error could be corrected in the minutes at this meeting.

A motion to recall the vote was then placed and seconded, director Couvelier stated that at least one director who voted in favour of Salt Spring Island's exclusion was absent and therefore placing Salt Spring Island at a great disadvantage.

The whole affair ended up by turning into what anyone could classify a three-ring circus, with nobody knowing the legal avenues which should be followed.

5. A long discussion took place before the whole matter was tabled until a solicitor could attend.

6. I feel at this time that with the situation being what it is, that the majority of the board, having been criticized by some members of the Urban Transit Authority, are now more than ever determined to keep Salt Spring Island locked into the urban transit system, and that another vote at the C.R.D. board level, is unacceptable. You cannot correct an error with another error! It may be legal to recall the vote.

However, it would be highly improper without going through the whole presentations over again. No wonder a lot of the board's time is taken up for Salt Spring Island matters, they won't let us go!

It was my intention to allow the error made on June 11 to be corrected without a fuss, and to let the people responsible for the error, to bow out gracefully, however this was not to be, but only by the actions of a few vociferous

members of the board, who are so determined to make us pay for their deficit, even though they well know that they will not give us a bus service on the islands, and by the chairman's mild, quiet, unusual, almost non-existent statements, and inability to rule on the correction of his error.

We, the residents of Salt Spring Island, now have been placed in a position of Salt Spring Island vs. the C.R.D. Board. The solicitor who will be there will be there for the benefit of the board. We have been placed in this situation by D.A. Young and J. Campbell declaring our motion for exclusion, lost. I believe the vote counting and declaration has never been questioned before.

7. In order to be assured of Salt Spring Island's best interest, I now ask you, the residents of the island, to make a small donation to pay for our own solicitor, to represent our interests to the board and not the board's interest to us!

The response of your donations will be used as an indication of your approval or disapproval. Donations may be sent to Box A-1, Driftwood, Box 250, Ganges, B.C.

The next board meeting is on July 9, 1.30 pm.

# Raising fish for sea lions?

## No way says fisherman Fred Robson

Federal fisheries regulations governing the taking of fish by humans should be extended to include sea lions and other predators, avers Fred Robson, of Galiano.

The long-time Galiano spokesman told a CBC radio program on Tuesday morning that there was little benefit in closing an area to sports fishing when sea lions can swim around and take their fill.

He could see his neighbours ignoring the restrictions on salmon fishing, he told Bob Sharples. His neighbours are sea lions, five herds of about 75 animals.

They each eat up to 90 pounds of fish a day and they waste a lot more.

"You can see them tossing a salmon into the air," he explained. "They just take two or three bites!"

He recalled that the department of fisheries used to patrol the islands waters and exert a control on the sea lion population.

"You have to make up your mind which you want," he told the commentator, "the salmon or the sea lions."

They were controlled at one time with the use of firearms, he admitted, but today they are protected and cannot be shot.

"It's fruitless spending millions on hatcheries; you've got to decide whether you breed the salmon for humans or for sea lions!"

Seals are not the predators that sea lions are, noted the keen island fisherman.

"If you're going to save the fish, you'll have to do something about the sea lions," he concluded, "and you'll have to issue tags."

# Careful landscaping can create micro-climate around the home

My weeds are growing faster than anything else. It seems that they have grown another inch while I was turning around.

I haven't actually seen them grow, but I am reluctant to leave them out of my sight. So while weeding away I have been thinking of macro, mini and micro-climates.

The Vesuvius area being about two weeks ahead of us (and they are North of us). It's a perfect example of a mini-climate within the macro-climate of the Victoria-Vancouver area.

Several factors work together to shelter the area from cooling influences and enhance the ambient warming influences. It is simply that the environment makes maximum use of the available energy here and henceforth they are ahead by some two to three weeks in blooming and fruiting of flowers, vegies and trees.

Aside from the obvious benefits of this, there are others. Chief among them is a saving in home-heating energy.

The reason for talking about a favourable mini-climate is that we can create a similarly favourable micro-climate around our homes by carefully considered landscaping.

## WINDBREAKS

We can use trees, bushes and shrubs to create windbreaks, block or divert cold air flows and currents, even provide cool shade in summer and much needed sun and light in winter by simply planting deciduous trees.

Aside from sheltering our home and gardens from selected aspects of the elements, the added benefit is a strong and obvious feeling of being sheltered. This sheltered feeling will affect our lives subtly but pervadingly. It will also affect those who come to visit us.

So, landscaping is a mood setter; famous examples are Japanese gardens which convey first of all a sense of tranquility and then lead to appreciation and contemplation with a direct simplicity.

Then there is our open adventurous "west-coast" style, with elements borrowed from the Japanese and facets borrowed from the mountains, the forests and the sea, represented by rock and driftwood in combination with shrubs and trees in meaningful arrangement.

Another is the "New England" style, a little more formal and opulent, with gate, trellis and house in careful, loving and joyful balance.

## CARELESS ELEGANCE

The "English Garden" is another much beloved style which reminds us more than anything of the feeling of overgrown and careless elegance; of the wellworn and beloved tweed jacket at a formal gathering.

Aside from "marrying" the

house to the surroundings; balancing visual aspects with fence, trellis and gate and other buildings, the owner's personal preference and inclination will be expressed in a definite personal style.

This may be "open and inviting" with few visual obstructions; "open but private" personal style, carried out in a "fairy tale", (albeit a Japanese one) manner.

## ENHANCE VALUE

All this can be integrated with a design for a favourable micro-climate to enhance the value and liveability of the home. It is best to actually sit down and come up with a complete design for your surroundings and then work towards it in stages. In this manner anything you do to complement this plan will

be a step towards its completion.


Other considerations in designing a plan for your home are areas of use. There is the "entry" garden, the approach to the house. The "passage" area will lead from the frontage to the rear which usually contains patio or deck areas, entertaining and play areas, flower and vegetable gardens, compost bins and so on.

Don't forget occasional places to sit, rest and enjoy your surroundings. These are an often overlooked or neglected asset which can give one a great deal of pleasure.

Micro-climates work; examples are our Vesuvius area and the peach tree on the south side of house, shed or fence. And the values are there as well; ranging from energy and monetary to wood and re-sale benefits.

Both body and soul benefit from the combination of the useful with the beautiful.

And one last item: anything new starts to depreciate from the moment of completion except landscaping; it appreciates with every growing year.

# School board meeting held at Galiano Island

The Gulf Islands School Board continued its practice of conducting public business on an Outer Island each summer by meeting on Galiano on Thursday. For nearly three hours trustees debated, passed motions and dealt with a delegation before an audience of 15 interested citizens.

Much routine business was dispatched in short order. Recurring problems reared their heads and wafted on the westerly breeze. The Ganges sewer controversy was aired on Galiano by a motion to study alternatives for the school complex. A matter taking a considerable amount of the board's time and attention, the daily transportation of high school students from Galiano to Ganges, is reported in the Galiano column.

The board received the report of the GIPSY evaluation committee. The Gulf Islands Program Serving Youth was recently discussed in detail in *Driftwood*. The report took a positive approach to the operation of this rehabilitative program. The committee recommended continuation of the program with improvements to the premises used, upgrading of equipment, transportation for work experience and acceptance of a more responsible role for the teaching aide.

The most important recommendation was that an advisory committee be set up with representation from the board, the staff, the secondary school, the department of human resources and the community society. Not only would this committee provide liaison between

groups involved in the program, but also screen admissions and relieve the teacher of legal and political responsibilities which take time and energy from his main task.

Facility projects approved included renovations to the Galiano School, continuation of work already begun on Saturna and the South Salt Spring Elementary School site and work on the band area at Ganges.

The department of highways has rejected a request for a pedestrian crossing on Rainbow Road on the grounds of insufficient traffic and has not yet ruled on the "no parking" designation in the same area. Work on an adventure playground for the Salt Spring Elementary School will begin shortly and provide summer employment for two students.

The board accepted a policy recommendation on the subject of freedom of information. Non-confidential documents available to board members prior to meetings will, in future, be posted on the notice board at the school board office.

The curve ball that ended the innings was thrown by Mary Williamson with her notice of motion to rescind the motion regarding an alternate class at Pender School. This battle will recommence on July 24 in the Pender School where the board will hold its next meeting.

An alternate class in a small school inevitably provides problems of multi-grading, class size and cost which naturally concerns other parents, staff and taxpayers.

### NORTH VS. SOUTH

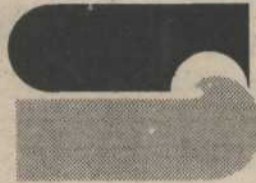
Yet another tournament of note is coming up. A few weeks ago, the South Salt Spring team met North

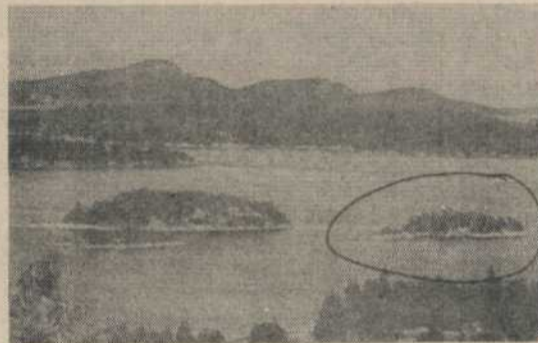

# Regional plan for islands to be reviewed by residents

Saturday sees the kick-off for the Islands Trust Regional Plan meetings in the islands. The new overall islands plan will be considered at Pender Island on Saturday.

Residents will be invited to examine proposals for long-term planning and to make suggestions. Meetings will be informal gatherings and not public hearings.

All the southern designated islands now have community plans and community planning.

These are all concerned with local planning, whereby residents of each island reach consensus on the plan for the future and then, implement it.

Regional plan calls for agreement of the entire Islands Trust area, as a whole. It embraces all the islands and it also considers the other 237 islands of the Islands Trust area. These are the islands such as Russell Island or Prevost, where the island is not designated, but where the Islands Trust still holds sway.

The Islands Trust is concerned with all the islands, designated or otherwise. With this responsibility goes the requirement to devise a philosophy and a plan which will protect and preserve all islands, large or small.

The Islands Trust is circulating a booklet on its regional plan ahead of each island's meeting. The booklet asks a series of questions as a guide to islanders.

**GUIDE QUESTIONS**

Fresh water is limited in the islands. What does this mean to future development. Twenty-five per cent of islands land is owned by the Crown. Is there a special role for these lands.

The brochure expressed concern for the ALR and the future of

farming as well as tree preservation and forestry. Or do the islands need special logging practices, asks the circular.

Mining in the islands: recreation; islanders are urged to give them consideration.

How can the flora and the fauna of the islands be preserved?

How protect the coastal zone; the attractive scenery and rural atmosphere? How can air and water pollution be minimized?

Island residents will be invited to consider all these points when they attend the meetings on their own islands.

Half the lots, 9,000 parcels, throughout the islands, are vacant. What does this mean in connection with future planning policies?

Should islands provide their own commercial services and job opportunities? Are parks, marinas, hotels needed? Are roads and highways what they should be?

Variety of lifestyles: overpopulation. Are they matters for concern?

Land prices and taxation will have a bearing on future prices and costs in the islands; to what extent?

**FERRY SERVICES**

What should be the regional objectives for ferry service? Should growth rate be controlled by controlling ferry access to the islands? Do we need more trails?

How protect the area from outside influences, such as oil spills?

What do you appreciate most about the Islands Trust area? Do you see any threats to these values? Do you have any proposals which would preserve these values?

The brochure also reminds the reader of what the Islands Trust is and what it embraces. It consists of 3,200 sq. km. of land and sea, and some 250 islands. The area is mostly water and the land measures about one-eighth of the total area.

In 1976, the Trust area was home to an estimated 9,500 people.

Statistics also describe the foundation of the Islands Trust by the province in 1976 to preserve and protect the unique character of the islands for the benefit of the islanders and of all the province.

The 1977 amendment to the act provided for the transfer of land planning authority from the regional districts to the Islands Trust.

Each island will be the stage and the actors will be the Islands Trust outlining just what a regional plan would do for the islands and the islanders.

Trustees are hoping for a response from residents and owners as a guide to their further deliberations.
