Information sought on exchange

Is it a fair exchange?

An order-in-council, approved pending survey, for the purpose of exchanging a piece of unsurveyed crown foreshore property for Lot 541, Ganges Harbour.

1. Lot 541 is the lot with the new large septic field in the core area of Ganges.

2. The unsurveyed crown foreshore property lies between the

new septic field and Miller and Toyne office. It is a strip of approximately 197 feet long by 66 feet wide, plus another strip of approximately 125 feet long by 40 feet wide, designated for waterfront access.

3. The order-in-council number is 1922 and I believe 1979 (late) according to the information received from the lands and housing branch. The survey in question has been ordered on January 15, 1980.

I, as your elected representative, have promised full disclosure of facts that would affect this community. I feel that this land exchange will definitely affect this community and therefore, I am laying these cards on the table for you to decide whether you feel this exchange is fair or not!

This information was not freely given, but upon my insistence to have copies of health permits, and twice I have been denied by the departments, via Mr. D. A. Young,

and until the Capital Region Board decided that I was to have access of the said files, I could not examine and ask the necessary intelligent questions that would produce the answers or information this community is entitled to.

I personally do not know if this proposed exchange of crown land has been advertised or not. However, I should receive these answers shortly. Many letters requesting all information are on their way to the relative offices of

government.

I personally cannot conceive that the members of cabinet would knowingly accept on our behalf the concept of a commercial enterprise septic field in exchange for unsurveyed crown foreshore property.

I was surprised when I telephoned the lands branch department to hear the acknowledgement at the other end of the line, the reply, "Good morning, lands and housing."

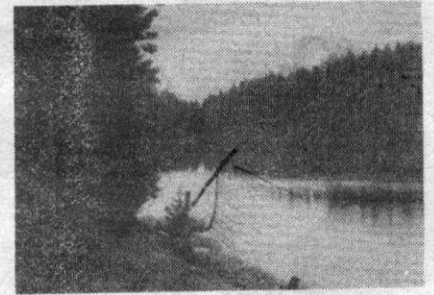

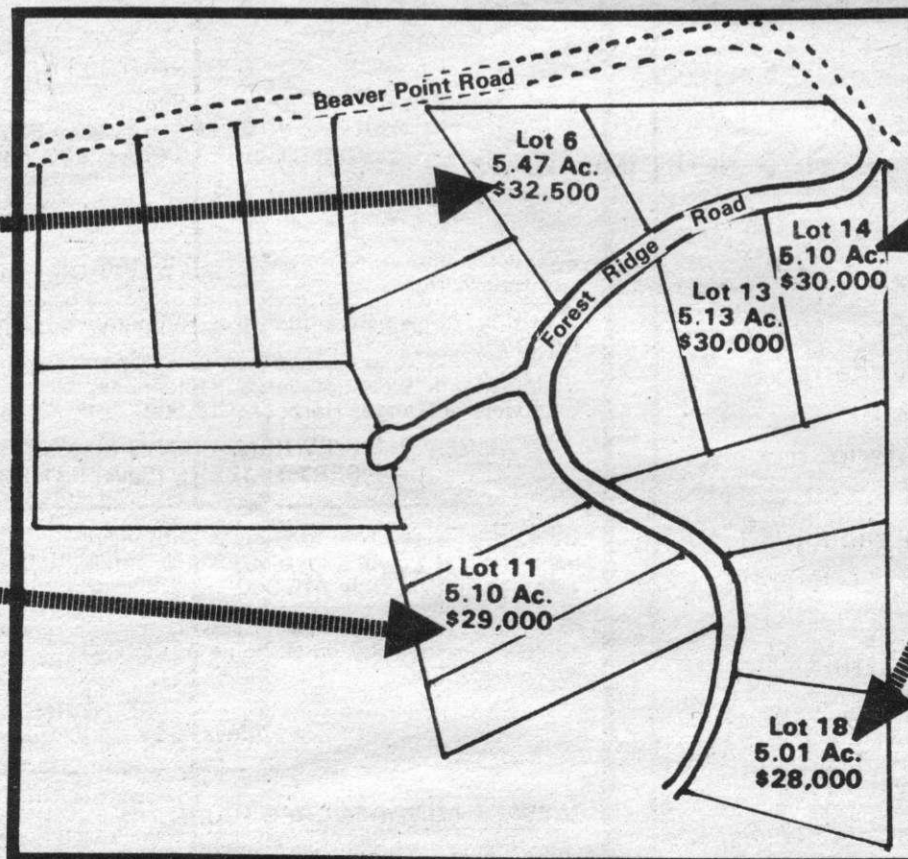

Report reveals problems of \$40,000 private wharf

Television news report on Monday evening examined the results of the Mayne Island dispute between Weldon Pinchin and the Islands Trust.

Pinchin gained permission from the ministry of lands to install a wharf, although the adjoining land was not suitably zoned. The Islands Trust declined to change the zoning or approve the structure in Bennett Bay, on the grounds that a commercial venture would be a detriment to the bay.

The Mayne Island hotelier went ahead and built his wharf, viewers were told, at a cost of some \$40,000.

A subsequent court decision ruled that the wharf was innocuous, provided that it was not used for commercial purposes. The Islands Trust has already indicated plans to appeal that decision, but the property owner is caught in the squeeze.

The wharf is a private project and may not be used for commercial purposes.

Hence, he may not charge for wharfage and he has no means of recovering the cost of the structure: or the \$25,000 he estimates was spent on the legal fees attached to the litigation.

To this point the two cases are similar, though not identical.

The adjuster did not then look at the machine, offer \$20,000 and settle the matter. He disagreed with the insured value of \$17,000.

Prior to the accident the owner had been negotiating for a new machine. The vendor had estimated its trade-in value at \$12,000, but no haggling had taken place.

The insurance corporation had accepted the original insurance proposal showing a value of \$17,000. The owner and ICBC were already aware that it was valued at wholesale, or trade-in value, at \$12,000.

So the insurance corporation paid that \$12,000, ignoring its likely market value of \$18,000. And ICBC promptly sought \$3,000 for the wreckage. The \$17,000 insurance policy was sold out for a net \$10,000.

It all goes to prove that a British Columbian is on a better bet if he acquires a beat-up heap than an industrial machine.

The operator still figures he was twisted by the insurance corporation.

And it looks like he was!

No funding from Ottawa for moniteur

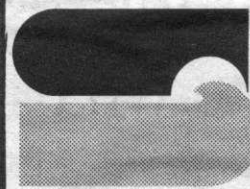
Fernwood School's French immersion program planned for September is not considered a priority by the federal government, Gulf Islands school trustees learned last week.

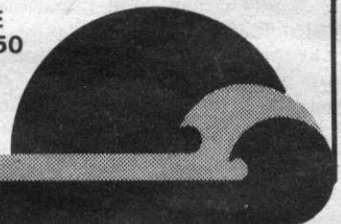

Vote on alternate class fails to pass

alternate class at Ganges was entering its seventh year, and that she had two children in the class who were doing "extraordinarily well".

She urged the board to reconsider its decision in view of the fact that the groups involved in the controversy had met at the board's direction, and then the board had voted against their recommendation.

"The new (independent) school will go ahead," she concluded, "but there are ways in which Pender School can be helped."

Pender trustee John Zacharias was given a round of applause when he stated that he had made his decision (to oppose the class) on the basis that the school population was too small to warrant a publicly-funded alternate school.

"If the population were 150 or greater I would have voted for the motion," he observed.

Implementation of the class, he continued, would have made it necessary to decrease services to the rest of the school.

"I'm not bigoted with regard to an alternate school though I'm not convinced of its worth. Since nothing has really changed, I regard this motion as a nuisance motion."

Mayne trustee Jeanine Dodds reminded the board that the origi-

nal motion read that the concept of an alternate class be accepted by the board, not that the class be started.

Charlie Baltzer of Salt Spring didn't think that the board should be voting on the issue again. **SHOULDN'T BE ON AGENDA**

"I feel that as there's an independent school starting...the motion shouldn't even be on the agenda."

Mary Williamson, Vivien Pinteau, Strick Aust and Jeanine Dodds voted in favour of the resolution, but as a two-thirds majority is needed to rescind a motion, it failed to pass.

Later in the meeting, three Pender residents opposed to the alternate class addressed the meeting.

Douglas Harker recalled having read in *Driftwood* "some very

serious comments" about the Pender School.

Conditions at the school had been described as "deplorable and intolerable". But, he recalled, when a public meeting was held to discuss the issue, "I didn't hear one specific fact...to justify those statements."

GIVEN BAD TIME

"I left the meeting feeling that able, hard-working, conscientious teachers were being given a bad time," Harker stated.

"In my opinion, respect and agreement between parents and teachers are far more important than educational theorizing. Without mutual support, your children will...be the sufferers."

During the question period following the meeting, a number of residents wanted to know if the

issue was finished. "Can mothers be mothers again and can teachers be teachers again?" one parent asked the trustees.

OUT OF ORDER

Chairman Ivan Mouat said that unless the board received additional information, another motion supporting an alternate class would probably be ruled out of order.

The school population at Pender is expected to drop by at least 10 when the independent school opens in September. Number of students at the end of June was 79, 68 elementary and 11 secondary.

Final question of the evening went unanswered.

Pender resident Eve Smith asked, "Why should people oppose anything as traditionally accepted as an alternate school?"
