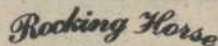

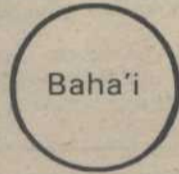

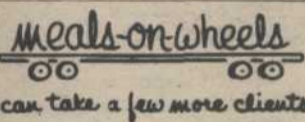

At present, subjects that can be offered include German, Spanish, French, edible wild plants, piano and Orff music, among others, and more are being sought.

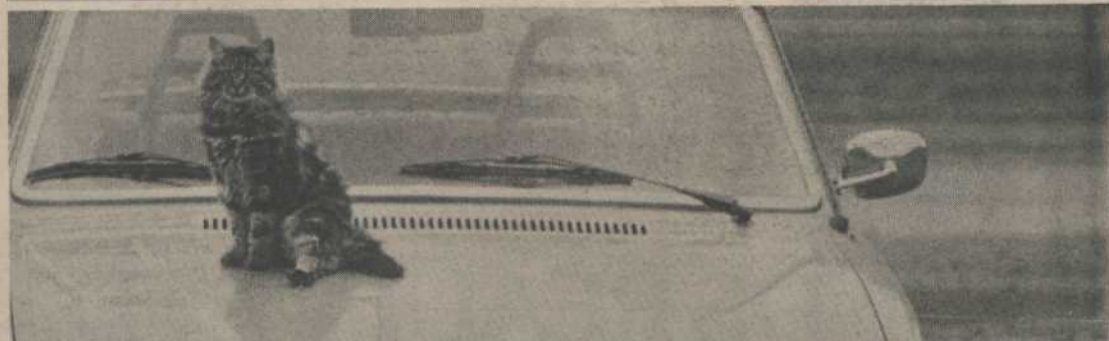

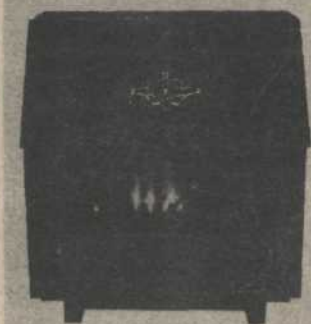
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Youth evade police
