

On rocks after anchor line breaks

The relative warmth of the days last week brought the boating crowd to the waters of the Gulf Islands but the Coast Guard crew at Ganges had a quiet week.

They answered six distress signals including three from boats which had run aground.

One boat hit the rocks in Ganges Harbour and took on water. The owner thought he was rounding Prevost Island but apparently was off course.

In another incident, a 32-foot craft broke its anchor line and drifted on to the rocks at Portland Island. Rick Tolonen, second coxswain of the Ganges unit, speculated that the boater did not allow sufficient slack in the anchor line.

He suggests to boaters to make sure the anchor has at least 25 feet of chain, which when the anchor digs in, will hold it down and in place.

Islands excluded from electric music bylaw

Rock concerts and the like were banned by the legislation.

Salt Spring group attends annual Pow-Wow

The Salt Spring Island Native Indian and Inuit Group (the Heritage Group), shared a beautiful experience with the native Indian people at the seventh Annual Mission Inter-tribal Pow-Wow on July 10, 11 and 12.

The Pow-Wow was held by native Indian people from Canada and the USA. The celebration began on Friday with the arrival of Ti-pis, tents and trailers. A drum warm-up was held in the evening while the craft and food tents were being set up.

On Saturday the Heritage Group proudly displayed their banner in the spectacular parade led by horseback riders and followed by floats and Indian clowns. (Channels 12 and 13 filmed the event, including our group).

The grand entry of representatives from 49 different tribes was the highlight of the celebration. The energy, solidarity and harmony among the native people

was clearly felt by all.

The dancing, led by seven sets of drummers (who were also the singers), included the Indian Waltz, Circle Dance, Hoop Dance and many traditional dances which continued into the night. There was a wide variety of dress from buckskin to the traditional cedar bark (which was the first cedar bark clothing to be made in the last 100 years!) of the Inland Salish people. Three of our Heritage Group participated in the dancing.

There were two levels of experience felt by the guests. The

first, exemplified through the colour and beauty of the dancers, was one of awe. The second, the more profound, was becoming conscious of the power, harmony and spirituality of the gathering.

The Heritage Group consisted of children Steve, John and Sandy Nelken, Erik Downey, Vickie Pappenberger, Sheri-Ann Windsor and Sharon Rowe. The adults were Fred Hennault, Oscar Riley, Darlene and Chuck Nelken, Bettie Johnston and Ariadne Sawyer.

GALIANO NEWS

Island appears at its best with sunny weather

With the arrival of sunny weather Galiano appears at its best. Flower gardens are at their most colourful stage. Garden Club members are a congenial group interested in each other's gardens.

Last Tuesday, July 7, club vice-president Margaret Robson, organized a tour of five south end gardens. About 25 hortiphiles assembled at her house and began their tour by admiring Margaret's own garden overlooking Sturdies Bay, particularly her water-lily lake, a flourishing cactus in bloom and a wide bed of perennials.

The party then proceeded along Burrill Road stopping first at Dorothy Lupton's home behind St. Margaret's Church. Dorothy's artistic talent was apparent in the grotto she had made from a fallen tree by a pool with a piece of sculpture as focal point. The garden behind her house graduates from a healthy vegetable patch to wooded glades through which a path winds to a playhouse of logs made by Dorothy for her grandchildren.

EMPHASIS ON NATIVE FLOWERS

Further along Burrill Road the garden lovers turned into Mrs. Bow's where she, with the help of her daughter Audrey, has created a garden with the emphasis on native flowers and shrubs. On the return the visitors viewed the garden of Jessie Bellhouse, which is at its best in spring but now contains a great variety of shrubs whose leaves and flowers produce a colourful effect. Perhaps the most spectacular is an American Pillar rambler rose with its hundreds of deep pink blooms.

The tour terminated at the Sturdies Bay Road home of the Hall Tingleys, where the visitors enjoyed coffee around the swimming pool while admiring the flowers and shrubs in the rock screen that borders one side of the pool.

The following afternoon the more tireless members of the Garden Club assembled in their usual meeting place, the North Galiano Community Hall, for their regular monthly meeting.

STIMULATING VISIT
Linda Laughlin reported on a stimulating visit to the Victoria Horticultural Society's Show where only prize-winning entries were on display. She reminded members that free pamphlets on gardening are available from the provincial department of agriculture office on Douglas Street in Victoria.

The featured speaker was Fred Maybee of Salt Spring, who instructed the members on the art of summer pruning illustrating his

talk with clear chalkboard diagrams. The meeting then adjourned to Alistair Ross' garden for a practical demonstration on his trees and roses. Visitors were intrigued by the Ross' white currants which escape the depredations of the voracious robins because of their lack of red colour.

The next speaker on the club schedule will be Mrs. James from Salt Spring who will advise members at the August 2nd meeting how to prepare exhibits for a fall show. Incidentally, Galiano's Fall Show on September 5 will be organized by the Senior Citizens Association.

A Christening

Last Sunday morning's service at St. Margaret's Church was a memorable one. A full congregation were in good voice led by the tuneful baritone voice of Reverend John Dyer who preached a moving sermon. A contributing factor to the size of the congregation was that rare occasion for Galiano, a christening.

The three-month old granddaughter of Donald and Winnie Elliot of South Wind Drive had been brought by her parents, Maureen and Ronald Venzi, from their home in Calgary to stay for 10 days on Galiano and to be christened in St. Margaret's.

The baby, Diana Victoria, was dressed in an heirloom fine cotton christening dress made in England at least 60 years ago and since used in many family christenings including that of the baby's mother.

The proud grandparents have been permanent residents of Galiano for the past 2½ years. With them at the ceremony was Winnie's father and the baby's great grandfather, Charlie Kerkhoff, who will be 95 on his next birthday. Attending the christening party at the Elliot's was Galiano nonagenarian Stanley Jackson, Winnie's uncle and the baby's great great uncle.

Besides having remarkable relatives, Diana Victoria gained fame for herself by sleeping deeply throughout the whole service and being acclaimed as the quietest baby to be christened in St. Margaret's.

Galiano Mountain Artworks

For years Ken Hardy has been urging his students who had talent and enthusiasm to take a chance to try making their living at art and see how it works out. At last, after 30 years of public school teaching, Ken is taking his own advice.

Ken was born in North Vancouver. He attended high school in West Vancouver where his interest in painting was aroused by art teacher Ed Lane. He took his teacher training at UBC majoring in biology, so for the first 15 years of his career he taught science.

While teaching at McRoberts Junior Secondary School in Richmond he decided that he needed a change, so he switched to teaching art. His enthusiasm produced a rapid increase in the number of students taking the subject. After five years he moved to Steveston Senior High as head of the art department, again generating increased interest and the development of a four-room art complex.

For 17 years Ken, his wife Marie and children Bruce, Kia, Schon and Drew have spent summer holidays at their property on Gossip Island, where Ken built an A-frame cottage at a cost of a few hundred dollars and a great deal of hard labour. Five years ago the Hardys bought a property up Morgen Road on the side of Galiano Mountain.

TAUGHT AT MAYNE

Ken continued to teach at Steveston, commuting by boat in all but the foulest of weather. An opportunity to teach on the Gulf Islands arose and for three years Ken has taught, mostly on Mayne, art, French and industrial arts. He has now burned his bridges and resigned.

Ken has converted a cottage on his property into a studio and art workshop with facilities for painting, printing of dry-point line engraving, glass-work and photography. Already two adult painting classes, a drawing class and a children's art workshop are in progress.

Classes are limited to nine, on the principle that students are entitled to a fair amount of the instructor's attention and, coincidentally, that is the number of windows available to provide each with natural light. Only the drawing class has vacancies.

Planning to devote at least three days a week to his own projects, Ken has begun producing paper-stretchers, is exploring the possibility of producing fine paper and is considering adding pottery to his classes.

EXCHANGE TEACHER

His introduction to pottery came when he was an exchange teacher in Oldham, Lancashire, England, where as art teacher he was expected to take advantage of the pottery equipment in the school there. He read up on the subject and was able to observe the internationally renowned Bernard Leach in action, and himself practise the craft at the famous St. Ives Pottery in Cornwall.

Ken is particularly interested in the theory that the right hemisphere of the brain is the source of most visual art creativity. This concept holds that the left hemisphere is concerned with symbols, logic, time and linear thinking, and that it impedes the development of artistic creation. He has used, adopted and developed interesting techniques to encourage students to use the "right mode" when drawing and painting with some exceptional results.

The creation of the Galiano Mountain Artworks promises to provide art enthusiasts, both beginners and more experienced practitioners, with an exciting addition to Galiano's already thriving art scene.

Buddleia Bounty

Buddleia davidii is justly known as the butterfly bush. Its fragrant mauve flowers develop in cone-like clusters on the ends of long arching branches. On sunny days the bush is alive with the sound of bees, the whirring of hummingbird wings and the silent yellow flutterings of numerous swallowtails.

Although a garden shrub, "escapes" may be seen beside the road in several open locations on Galiano. The blue-purple blooms of the real self-heal may now be seen, and in sunny, small clearings in deep woods the pink hanging-down blooms of prince's pine, now unfortunately rare.
