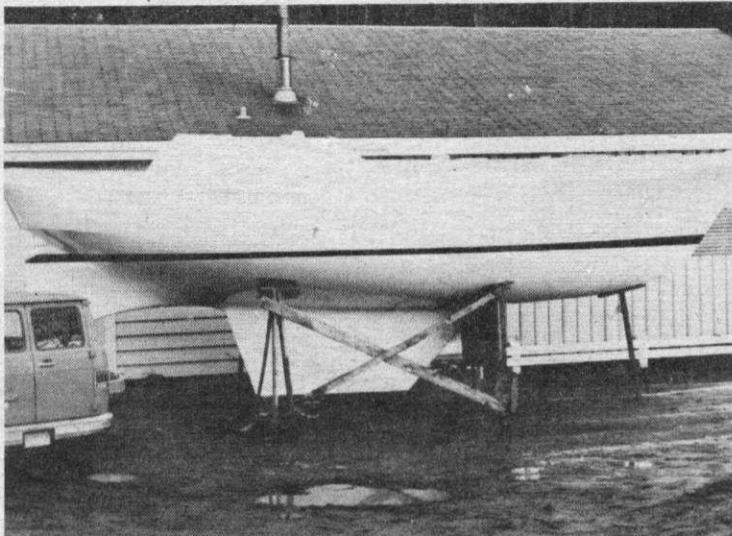




The Kajen after launching at Ganges

## Truant launches another

The Salt Spring Island boatbuilding yard of Truant Marine successfully launched the *Kajen* in Ganges Harbour on November 12.

The boat, a Pilot House model designed by William Garden, is the 14th in a series to be completed by Truant Marine.

Owners Bill Karny and Ernie Creamer were on hand at the launching to take the tiller from builder Mike Betts.

Betts' team of boatbuilders includes Tom Gilbert, Bud Davies, Len McAlee, Dave Betts and Dennis Beamish.

Three months of work went into the *Kajen*, from its birth in Saanich where the fibreglass hull was made to its completion at Ganges.

The *Kajen's* home port will be Sidney.

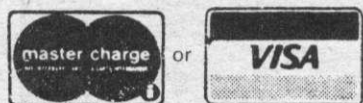

# Stanley Jackson celebrates his 93rd birthday

Stanley Jackson celebrates his 93rd birthday this week and on Saturday night a full contingent of admirers gathered at Stanley's on Southwind Road to bring in the 94th year.

Earlier that day, I'd had a long chat with Stanley about the path that led him from Liverpool, where he was born in 1888, via 17 years in Vancouver, and finally to Galiano Island in 1927.

As we begin to talk, I am struck with the crystal-clear quality of his recollections, and the completeness of his memory bank. Stanley came over on the *S.S. Canada* and arrived in Quebec September 5,

Labour Day, 1910, and was on the train the next day bound for Vancouver where his future brother-in-law would meet him.

He remembers the gas lamps overhead, and the strong smell of garlic on that six-day train trip. He first set up with his brother-in-law in a rooming house on Carl Avenue in Vancouver, now called Princess. But soon they got wind of a cabin at Third and Granville, fronting on the interurban tracks with a water tap by the front steps.

### SWIMMING AT FALSE CREEK

Stanley remembers playing baseball and swimming just off the Indian Reserve at False Creek. The next year, the rest of the family

came over: sister, mother and father. They moved into a bungalow at 14th and Gladstone, one of four cottages built on posts over a running creek.

In the early 20's, the family caught "land fever" and bought a lot way out in the sticks, on 47th Avenue. By this time Stan's sister was working as a teacher. Stan was driving a 1916 Model T around town, working for a laundry service, which he did for nine years.

Stanley laughs as he remembers being dragged over to Galiano for a weekend by a friend of his sister's. Then, suddenly, he is quiet as he recalls seeing Montague for

the first time.

"It looked like a little bit of heaven. There was only one thing missing: the angels." (There were only two other residents, on the other side of the harbour.)

Stan's sister felt just about the same way and that year Stanley began work on what was to be Sutil Lodge, a holiday lodge with several small cabins and fishing, hiking, archery, tennis and home-cooking.

### A 14-HOUR TRIP

Stanley recalls vividly the 14-hour trip from the foot of Fraser to Montague Harbour one summer night, when he brought the family's possessions over on a

scow. As they were coming down from Porlier Pass after midnight, the sky was clear, and the phosphorescence was sparkling on the water. You can still see that twinkle in Stanley's eyes today.

One of the favourite pastimes of the guests was touring through the islands with Stan in his gasboat. He soon realized, however, that as long as he just kept going, they didn't care where they went!

At the end of two or three weeks Stanley would take them back up to Sturdies Bay by boat. Into the 30's, business was so slow they practically had to kidnap people to get them there. But by selling one

200-foot waterfront lots, they kept things going. Stanley's not quite sure how they made it through those years.

When the massive logging at Winstanley Point and other Mac and Blo holdings occurred in the early 50's, the lodge stopped attracting customers. But in 1958, the Canada Pension came along, and that was enough to live on.

### ANOTHER MIGRATION

Then in the 60's there was another way of migration: those people who wanted to step out of the mainstream.

There was one fellow who had one of the back cabins: "He was singing all day long, not while he worked - just singing." Shortly after, the cabins were full again, this time with year-round residents: wood carvers, artists, jewellery makers and others.

I asked Stan how he managed to get through all those years without being caught by some female. He laughed and quoted from an old music hall song: "I know what's good for me...Standing on the corner watching other people

work. That never bothered me." That's not to say Stanley's not a worker. There's always an old lawnmower to fix around the place. It's just that Stan's always been a bit of a side-liner, not a joiner.

He kept out of the two wars, too. With Stan it's not whether you win or lose, but how you play the game. He's pretty good at the game, too. After all, he's had plenty of practice.

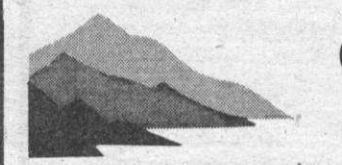

# The apple is one of nature's exquisite gifts

There is an apple tree in front of our kitchen door. I pass under it first thing every morning on my way to milk the goats.

There is nothing sweeter on this earth, save the love of a good woman, than to bite into an apple fresh with dew, and cold with the morning chill.

It's a most exquisite gift of nature, wholesome and delicious, and freely given. For here, certainly, is the greatest return for the least effort.

In five years, and this was an old, totally neglected tree, I have spent about 12 hours total in caring for it. In those five years it has given us at least 1,200 lbs. of apples. At 30¢ a lb. it has given us \$360 worth of apples.

We don't fertilize, irrigate, spray, dust or cultivate. We try not to prune either. I have cut out dead wood, damaged or diseased branches, and what appeared to be another tree growing upon a branch. I found it hard to believe, but there was this 15-foot tree growing vertically from a horizontal branch.

## NEGLECTED TREE

As I said, it was a neglected tree. We had some tent caterpillars one year, which required snipping off the affected twig and burning it. Another time we had to put tanglefoot paste on the trunk because the ants were getting into aphid raising on a really massive scale.

This is it. The sum total of our labour investment in this tree. Sure, I check our trees out every year. Just a practised look. I look for at least four inches of new growth every year. Colour and size of leaves normal. Lots of blossoms, of good colour and shatter resistant.

As long as a tree shows all these signs of health, it does not need anything at all. We leave it alone.

If at all possible, bending and training of branches is far better than pruning. Recent research has proven that bending of branches results in earlier and better fruit production. It makes sense.

## TIED OR WEIGHTED

Instead of cutting off a vertical branch and waiting for a new one to grow, the upright branch is

simply tied or weighted to 45 degree or horizontal position. This encourages setting of fruiting spurs or buds.

The trouble with pruning is that it causes a lot of water shoots. Those are the shoots which grow faster than anything else and take energy from everything else. Cutting these off seems to encourage more of them. So keep pruning to a minimum.

Inward growing branches, crossing branches, weak crotches (sharp "V"s) and misplaced laterals should come off, though. Do this in spring, when the buds are swelling and the sap is rising. Our winters are too mild and wet for winter pruning. We would just invite fungus diseases, especially with tree-wound dressing, under which fungus seems to thrive.

## ITS BEST PROTECTION

The tree's own sap, rising from within and covering the wound, is its best protection.

Don't plant a new apple tree where there used to be one. Apple trees exude a substance from their roots which prevents other apple trees from growing near them. This substance stays in the soil for quite a few years. That is why we never see apple seedlings growing under apple trees.

In this manner the tree prevents competition for water and nutrients with its offspring. The seed is encased in fruit, delicious to man and beast, thus ensuring wide dispersal and greater chance of good growing conditions.

Oh yes, if you are planting new trees this year, chuck in a pound of bonemeal. Mostly phosphorus, it encourages root development and blooming and fruiting. Bonemeal decomposes slowly and lasts for many years.

And if you are planting new apple trees this year and are bewildered by the many kinds, use this basic approach. To spread out

the harvest and to have fresh apples as long as possible, simply get an early one, a mid-season one and a late one.

## GOOD FOR STORAGE

The late ones are mostly good storage apples as well. This way, you can have fresh apples from July to December. For example: Yellow Transparent, Spartan and Red Northern Spy; or Yellow Transparent, Gravenstein and Red Delicious.

The first three are self-pollinating and do not require a pollinator. In the second group the Gravenstein will be pollinated by the Red Delicious (a good storage apple, by the way). Another good combination would be Yellow Transparent, King and Red Jonathan with Jonathan acting as pollinator for the King. Or use two or all of the above combinations.

And here is another tidbit of useful information. Full development of fruit occurs only around pollinated or fertile seeds. Each apple usually contains 10

seeds. If all seeds have been pollinated in the ovum stage, there will be a fully developed apple.

If some of the seeds are infertile, full fruit development will not occur and the apple will be smaller and oddly shaped. So, the busy bee again; it can increase your harvest by as much as 30% in weight by complete pollination.

## NO SPRAYING OR DUSTING

We do sell some apples and some pears, but we are not a commercial establishment. And so we do not spray, or dust. We are only interested in apples, not in profit. Our apples have scab and worms, but not all of them, mind you, there are plenty which are perfect. And the ones which are less than perfect still make good dehydrated apples, apple juice or cider, apple sauce and apple pie, dutch apple cake (my favourite) or apple crumble. And any recipe which can accommodate a bit of apple somewhere will gain. Chicken stuffed with apple and seasoned with thyme, fried apple

rings with ham, beef stroganoff with a touch of apple, stir-fried vegies with just a touch, or coleslaw with a bit of apple...

The possibilities are endless, and once you have tried it, you will know what I mean, when I say that the essence of the apple is its loveliness.

**Never try to flag down rampaging slug herd**

Okay, you're ready for the hunt. Lariats, gloves, face masks, knee pads, binoculars and, of course, your faithful hunting duck Quack. You're looking down, wading through landforms typical to our community, looking for clues to the great slug hunt.

slug as a family pet or as an investment, such as show guard, or race slug, we know you will find this the most rewarding experience you have undertaken.

Your first sight of slug is the slime trail, but don't head off after the first one you see, keep looking for a large foraging herd.

We leave you with this thought: The love and companionship of a slug is one of the most truly satisfying, rewarding, enjoyable, enriching, fulfilling and unforgettable relationships one can have in life.

When you've located one with several likely specimens stampede the whole group, preferably into an open area. What you're looking for are those that are high spirited and have the endurance needed.

So endeth the slug owner's handbook. Many thanks to Jack Albhouse and the Elma, Washington, Chamber of Commerce for their inspiration and assistance, without whom none of this would have been necessary.

The chase, although sometimes lasting several days, is not a fast paced or rigorous undertaking. The average person, without special physical conditioning or training, will likely be able to keep up with the herd.

One cautionary note, though: never never try to flag down a rampaging slug herd. Famed slug huntress Melissa Muculeat was tragically struck down in her prime when pinned between cabbage plants and an onrushing herd.

Having cut your slug out from the herd, you're now ready to start down the road to slug ownership. Whether you decide to acquire a

### REFUSED TO PASS

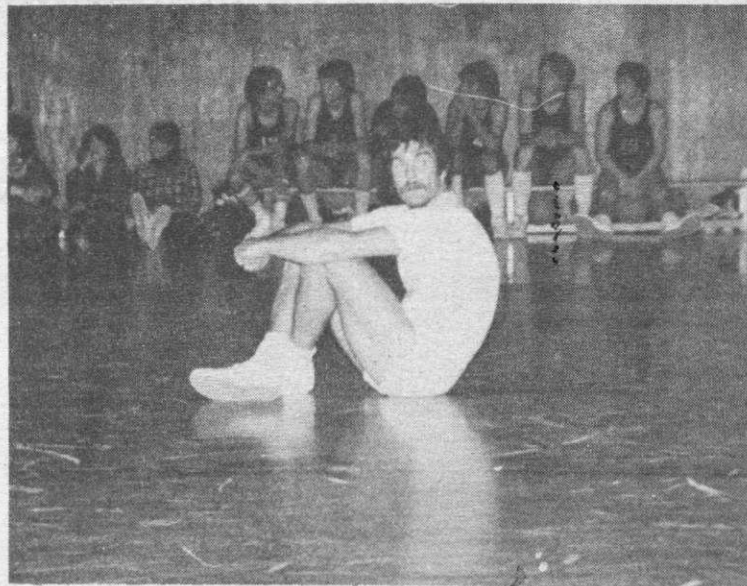
The worst part was that when they got on the ice they refused to pass the puck for fear that the other would score. No wonder

# Down Through the Years with Driftwood

### FIVE YEARS AGO

School board elections on Salt Spring resulted in a recount for second place behind Colin Mouat who topped the polls. Ann Foerster edged Tom Marcus by one vote after the second recount of ballots. Mouat garnered 600 of the 1,768 votes cast while Foerster ended with 414.

A member of the Salt Spring Island Power Squadron won recognition for a training device. The plaudits and \$25 in silver dollars were awarded to Wolfgang Bassek for a unit which displays navigational lights for all types of vessels. The display enables the teaching of night recognition and allows viewing from any direction.

A definition of a Gulf Islander came from Transport Minister Jack Davis. He issued an outline of who could receive a resident's card and who couldn't. An islander is a person whose name appears on the local voters' list. Or a person who has applied to have the name appear. Or someone who had a note from a neighbour saying so.

The Galiano walkathon collected \$600 from various persons who sponsored walkers to hoof from one end of the island to the other.

Mayne Island members of the Legion paraded 27 strong to the war memorial to mark Remembrance Day. Following the ceremony at the cenotaph, the group held a church service.

Capital Regional District advertised a public meeting to hear plans for rezoning 80 acres east of Stanley Point Road. Stanley Point Estates Ltd. wanted a land use contract for the parcel to allow a subdivision.

### TEN YEARS AGO

Driftwood published an edition on Thursday, Nov. 25, 1971. But one of our copies is missing.

### FIFTEEN YEARS AGO

The Salt Spring Chamber of Commerce sent a letter protesting an announced telephone rate increase to the Board of Transport Commissioners. The chamber was protesting the change of status for Salt Spring phone users from one category to a higher one. The change was labelled premature. Part of the argument used by B.C. Tel for the change was that 1,093 telephones were in use on the island. A check of the phone book showed 913 listings.

The Cy Peck left Fulford Harbour for Vancouver and a new career with purchasers J.F. Todd and Son. No plans for the work to be assigned to the old ferry were announced except that she would be refitted for fresh-water use.

Plans to send Saturna school children on a cross-Canada train trip to Expo '67 in Montreal were being formed. The group organizing the excursion hoped to send 29 children on the trip which was described as "a kind of school on wheels".

Salary negotiations between the Gulf Islands School Board and teachers had stalled. The two sides decided an arbitrator was needed to sort out the wage talks.

The Salt Spring Legion branch reported \$461 was raised from the sale of poppies.

A Christmas tea, sponsored by the Burgoyne Bay United Church, raised \$70 for use by the women's group. A good time was had by all at Nan's Coffee Bar in Fulford.

### TWENTY YEARS AGO

B.C. Toll Ferry Authority took a 90-day option on a property on Long Harbour on Salt Spring Island. A company official stated the location was to be used for a terminal for a direct ferry run to Tsawwassen. Speculation continued about a Swartz Bay-Isabella Point hook-up.

The mule deer was marked with red paint on the rump and antlers as well as strips of red ribbon around the neck. It was a pet of a Beaver Point family. A hunter shot it and then bragged of the feat.

Humour, take it or leave it department: Did you hear the

story about the cannibal who found the missionary too tough to eat? The cannibal made the mistake of boiling him; he was a friar.

The noise of hammering and sawing could be heard well into the evening. A disgruntled Ganges resident phoned the police to complain of the noise. Investigation found the disturbance to have been caused by volunteer firemen using their spare time to finish the fire hall.

The Salt Spring Island Farmers' Institute at a special general meeting decided not to sell one-tenth of an acre which the group owned. The property was located on Ganges Harbour and two businessmen had offered \$2,400 to purchase it with plans to construct a commercial building with docking facilities.

Salt Spring Rod and Gun Club asked Ganges Sea Scouts to join as junior members. The boys would be taught how to shoot as well as how to take care of a gun. Several young riflemen had shown promise in trials.

## Most poisonings were among young children

The moral is obvious in poisoning figures compiled by the Capital Regional District, says health officer Dr. Allan Arneil: "Protect the young children against accidental poisoning, protect the adolescent against emotional trauma."

Figures show that most poisonings in 1980 occurred in the 0-4 age group, when one in 60 ate or drank something that could have poisoned him. Most of them were accidental.

There were few poisonings in the childhood years of 5-14 when only about one in 800 was affected.

There were more cases in early adulthood, 15-29 years, where one in 270 women and one in 500 men were reported. The majority, 35%,

were suicidal, 30% were attention-seeking, 22% were looking for a "high" and 13% were accidental.

In middle adulthood there were fewer cases, about one in 600, and in late adulthood and old age there were fewest of all, about one in 1,000.

It was found that young children would eat just about anything. Arneil said. The list included drugs, liniments, cosmetics, pesticides, cleaning agents, gasoline, turpentine, paint, plants and glue.

In the older age groups the most common substances taken were drugs, including alcohol.

Of the poisonings reported to the Poison Control Centres only 13 were fatal and none of them occurred among young children.

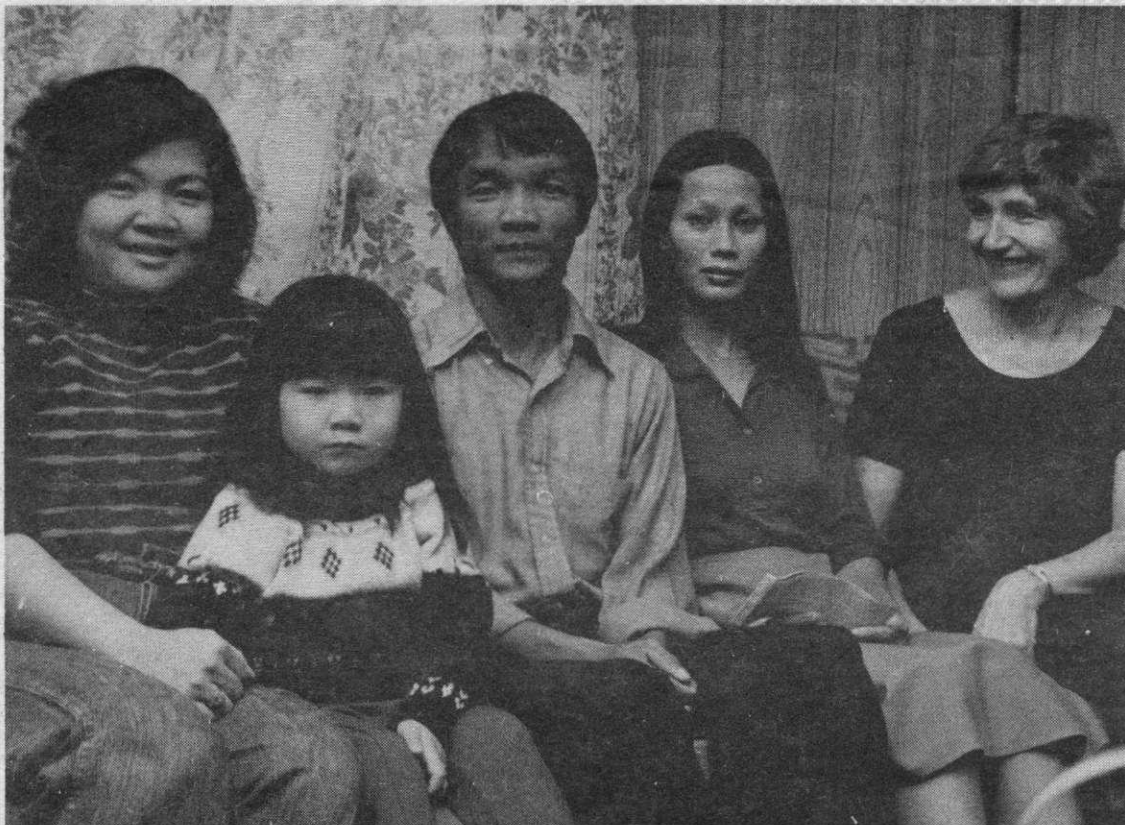

## He chose to come to Canada over joining army or jail

The journey covered many miles and threaded through several countries but Hiep and Hang Vo have arrived on Salt Spring Island.

The couple, refugees from Vietnam, were greeted at the

Victoria airport by members of the Salt Spring Island Boat People Committee last week.

Alice Andress of that group described a scene of conflicting emotions. She felt happiness at having the couple finally arrive but felt pity at the sight of them so lost and lonely amid the bustle of the airport.

Hiep Vo, 28, worked as a marine mechanic in Saigon. His wife, Hang, 27, earned money by cutting hair.

### ARMY OR JAIL

About eight months ago, he received notice from authorities that he either had to join the army to fight in Cambodia or spend time in jail.

The couple decided to leave.

Their parents were too old to escape and remained behind but the Vos took an open boat powered by a small motor and with eight friends joining them, set out for Malaysia.

They spent months in a refugee camp before learning that Canada, and Salt Spring Island, was to be their new home.

When Vo and his wife arrived in Victoria, each carried a small knapsack containing their worldly possessions. With the few clothes they owned on their backs, the bags contained small personal items.

For Vo, his pride was the basic English books and text he was using to learn the language.

The journey to their new home began at the camp, wended through Kuala Lumpur to Hong Kong and Tokyo and ended with a shuttle flight from Vancouver to Victoria.

### BROUGHT LETTERS

Vo brought 21 letters from those who must stay in the refugee camp. The letters are to friends and relatives around the world. Some of the letters are destined for Vietnam but the lack of postal connection between Malaysia and that country prohibits direct correspondence.

The Vos were greeted on Salt Spring by other people who came here under similar circumstances. They held a house warming party to begin the new life for the couple in grand style.

The Salt Spring Island Boat People Committee, 50 or so islanders who have contributed money and supplies to help refugees from that part of the world begin anew in Canada, will be helping the Vos adjust to life in the Gulf Islands.
