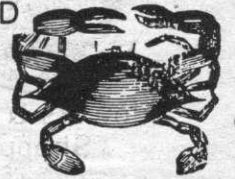

Oarsmen find St. Mary Lake ideal for practice

A professional team of rowers came to Salt Spring Island in July to hone their skills on St. Mary Lake. Two Victoria girls practised their rowing skills in preparation for the world championships to be held this year at Lucerne, Switzerland.

Their long, slender rowing boat may have looked a little out of place among the canoes, fishermen and sailors, when for about 2½ hours daily, the rowers traversed the lake.

The visiting oarsmen were the English Henley double champions in the sculling races in England and have been the Canadian champions. Janice Mason and Lisa Roy have been rowing since they began university five years ago and together they make a winning combination.

They came to the island with coach Ted Daigneault to stay at the lakeside courtesy of Jean Hoskin, who has granted the rowers access to the water as well as accommodation.

Why did they come all the way to Salt Spring Island? Elk Lake is too busy, they explained.

Too many power boats

"Power boats at Elk Lake eliminate soft water sports almost entirely," Daigneault said. "Canoeing, fishing, windsurfing and rowing are difficult if not

impossible when power boats and water skiing activities are in the area. So we needed a place to practise."

For an oarsman, in the unusually narrow space allotted him in the sculling or sweeping vessel, a bit of wake, wind or trouble water can disrupt the vessel and for the novice, capsize him.

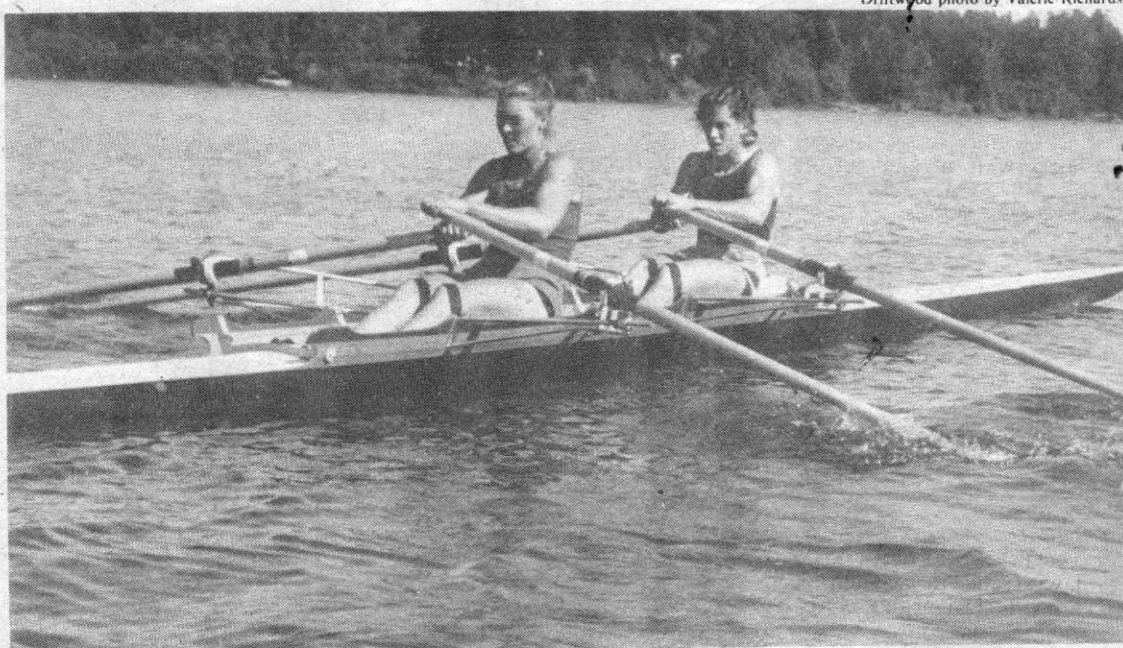
Rowing races originated during a time when oarsmen were licence holders and it was considered a trade.

When oarsmen crowded the river Thames and suffered accidents daily, Henry VIII made new rules by insisting that licences be acquired and apprenticeship made routine before one could row on the busy river.

In 1715 actor Thomas Doggett died, leaving a sum of money to support an annual race which would cover 4½ miles and start at London Bridge. The race would end at Chelsea and the winner would take home a cash prize taken from Doggett's estate.

Doggett's Coat and Badge race became an annual event in London and racing, by the beginning of the 19th century, was being enjoyed by both American and British rowing teams.

Canadians have been participating in rowing sports for over 100 years. The prime rowing location in Canada is at St. Catharines, Ontario. But the University of Victoria is centre for western oarsmen and the school

boasts many winners, including Mason and Roy.

Intense work-outs

According to the girls, life has been hard work this summer and work-outs have been intense. Weight-lifting, running and 2½ hours a day of rowing constitute the summer schedule for the champions.

But winter doesn't eliminate the work-outs or the rowing.

"I'm up at five on a winter morning and at Burnaby Lake by six," 23-year-old Roy explained. "I got sick in February this year because I wasn't getting enough sleep but working hard at the same time."

Sleep and rest are important to the girls who eat as much as they want and burn it off while on the lake or running.

A biochemistry graduate and ex-competitive swimmer, Janice Mason began rowing when she entered the University of Victoria. Her winter practices are on Elk Lake and she lifts weights about twice a week through the winter.

"Some people exclaim about how strong our arms must be," Mason explained, "but our legs are used more than our arms."

The rowing boats have sliding

seats which make them quite different from any normal kind of rowboat. With a beam of only 23 inches, the vessels provide the body with a kind of exercise machine on water.

Eat well, drink little

The girls eat well and drink little. "Our coach used to tell us that we could have seven beer a week but only one a day," recalled Lisa Roy, an architecture student at UBC.

The girls looked fitter than anyone else around the lake for miles, except perhaps, for Ted Daigneault, a full-time Victoria lawyer and an ex-Ontario rower himself. Daigneault works part-time at the university, coaching teams for St. Catharine's or for the world championships.

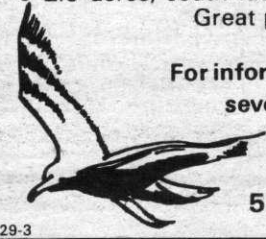

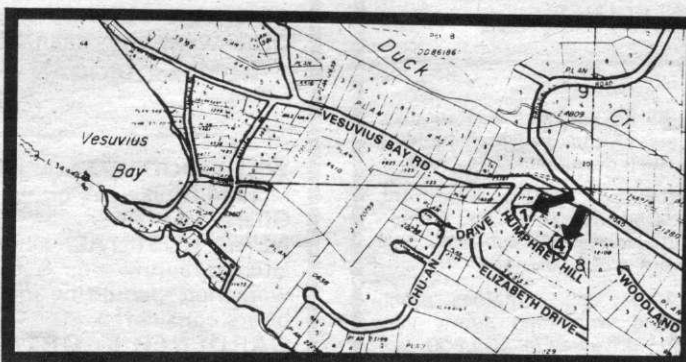

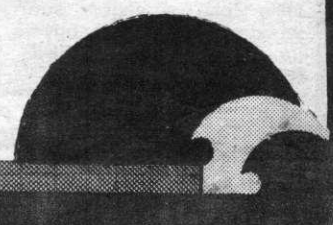

The happy people of Spain are happy to talk

Habla usted ingles?

And that's all you need to get around in southern Spain.

Half the people of Andalucia appear to be acquainted with English. The concierge in the apartment block; the taxi driver; the waitress and the store clerk, wherever you go you can get by with English.

It wasn't always like that.

A decade ago Torremolinos was a little fishing village. One who remembers it that way is Ron McQuiggan of Ganges. Today its high-rise apartment blocks rival Vancouver's west end. And the little signs to be seen everywhere remind the wandering anglophone that here is real English beer, real English fish and chips and real English music.

STILL SOME SPANISH

Yet, despite all that, there are still Spanish-speaking Spaniards in Malaga.

We spent a week in Spain. For more than half of that time I was sick in bed, so we saw less than we had hoped.

For a week we stayed in Fuengirola (fwen-hec-rola) in my sister-in-law's apartment. We lived

in a block providing some 200 apartments for northern Europeans.

It was a quick trip and a short stay, but the impressions were vivid. Cheap living is the first. An apartment which might command \$80,000 here in the west, may be found for \$30,000 in the south of Spain.

Taxi? A mile and a half or two miles will run you \$2.50. Hotel room for two, downtown, was \$32 a night.

ALL FOR \$11

Small cafe in an elite suburb offers suppers. Chicken for four, with french fries and a massive plate of salad, cost \$11.

There was only one sour face in our encounter with Spain. In one store the clerk refused to change a 5,000 peseta bill. It sounds like a lot, but it is the equivalent of \$50. It was too big for a small purchase, she snapped, in Spanish. Hers was the only scowl we found. And that was soon gone.

Taxi drivers, store clerks, casual encounters, all were courteous and happy. Even the police, who we expected to be more overbearing than those we know, were

reminiscent of the Canadian Mounties, cheerful and taking part in the community activities.

ONLY ONE

Only Spaniard I thoroughly disliked was the weatherman, who sent us too many days of overcast in a land we had so long identified with sunshine.

The only question I brought away with me was that of diet. We found English-style dishes and northern European cuisine. But we found no Spanish cuisine.

Sign taken

The sign was made by an artist and when potter Meg Buckley had it made she was ready to open her potting studio.

The "Open" and "Closed" sign was stolen from Meg Buckley's residence last Wednesday. The sign indicated whether or not Buckley's studio in Fulford was open.

It had only been hung at the gates to the potter's studio this spring.

RCMP at Ganges are investigating.

Either they've all switched to a most un-Latin diet or the Spanish cuisine is hidden away from the northern visitors.

Gasoline costs plenty

But the Brits spend about the same

It's just a little car in a little country. You drive up to the gas station and tell 'em, "Fill her up!"

And there's your bill: \$45! Gasoline doesn't come cheap anywhere in Europe and Britain is no exception.

Not many things are cheap, but lots of things are cheaper than here on the west coast of Canada.

Smoking costs and the price of drinks runs very close to the price at home.

What is the difference? Food is not far away from prices here. Potatoes from Israel and Cyprus competed with the common British spud and vegetables of all kinds could be grown around the corner or across the world.

Cabbage was 25¢ a pound and cauliflowers ran around \$1.50. Canned food was a little cheaper and, while meat appeared to come

close in price, it was a shock to come back to \$20 roasts and the discovery that meat is much cheaper in Britain.

Thirty small eggs were being offered for about \$2.60 the week I left and the same number were offered in K & R this week for \$1.98.

MEAT COSTS

New Zealand lamb was around \$2 a pound and pork sausage was from 70¢ to \$1.40 a pound. Apples were about level with island prices. Cheese was slightly lower than here.

To balance the figures, the average wage or salary in England is lower than the British Columbia average. The gap is narrowing, but the edge is on the Canadian side.

The cost of living doesn't always hit the traveller. Rents and property values are part of the cost of accommodation, but they are hidden.

The man in the street of Britain

may rent a municipally-owned property. Or he might buy his own.

If he rents he will pay from \$80 a month and up. Rental accommodation is extremely scarce.

COST OF LIVING

Cheapest home will cost him \$25,000 and that will be a terrace home. Like town houses, up to a dozen houses are built in one row, sharing common dividing walls, with access to the rear by way of a tunnel through the building. The home would be of two bedrooms and bathroom, or three bedrooms and no bath or toilet inside the house. At that price it would not likely be centrally heated.

Larger, comfortable home with full plumbing indoors, central heating, garage and more cat-swinging space will come in at about \$60,000 and up.

You want a car? What about a 1978 Ford Escort for \$3,500? A '71 Mini Minor for \$1,000 or a 1981 Chevette for \$5,600 after only 2,500 miles?

Don't want to buy? You can rent a small car for upwards of \$160 a week. If that hurts you could buy a motorcycle. For instance, how's about a 1977 Honda, 4-cylinder

400 for \$1,250?

Gas will cost you exactly double what you would pay at home.

Wheel-balancing cost me \$10 a wheel and insurance was \$70 for four weeks comprehensive. And on looking back on my visit to Europe I'm not sure I can afford to live there or here!

Twenty years ago

The government's own printed schedule shows the time as 10:55 under the heading of Salt Spring Service. The ship is the *Motor Princess* returning from a long day servicing the other islands.

First, our transportation problems will be solved by Fletcher Bennett's helicopters using the helicopter port on top of the Ganges Hilton Hotel, a 20-storey glass and chrome edifice situated at the present location of the Harbour House Hotel. With an intense desire to create more waterfront property, which will be selling at \$1,000 per front foot, Chuck Horel will dredge out Booth Canal and clear to Ganges Harbour and the Fulford Valley from Burgoyne. This would create two new areas, the Booth Bay Backwater and the Fulford Flushway. The present school would be turned into a museum because the school budget would be so large that it would be more economical to close the schools and send the children to expensive, European private

She's running scared!

And she's asking for support

Salt Spring Island driver is fearful of another cycling tragedy in the islands unless strong measures are taken by the province to safeguard lives.

Patti Lawson, of Upper Ganges Road on Salt Spring Island, reports that she had a close encounter with a cyclist when returning to the island recently and that she is still fearful every time she sees a two-wheeler.

And Lawson is doing something about it.

She is seeking the support of the Salt Spring Island Lions Club in calling attention to the extreme dangers of island cycling.

She is also courting the Royal Canadian Mounted Police for an increased surveillance of visiting cyclists.

Patti Lawson is echoing the story told by many island drivers of the hazard represented by large numbers of cyclists on the twisting, narrow and hilly roads of the islands. The death of a Vancouver cyclist on Galiano recently has added to local concern.

LAWSON PLAN

The Lawson plan calls for a greater awareness of the dangers of island roads and a warning sign at

the ferry wharves to advise visiting cyclists that extreme care must be exercised when riding here.

The second step in the Lawson plan calls for assistance from the police in a tighter patrol of cyclists and a system of warning any rider seen breaking the rules of safe riding.

No. 3 Lawson measure calls for the recommendation to the ferry corporation that cyclists be held aboard the ferries until the motor vehicles are unloaded. By this means the major traffic through the island will be dissipated by the time the cycling traffic is on those roads. Under the present system, she points out, the cyclists are well fanned out over the highway before the motor vehicles arrive.

Final plank in the Lawson platform is a pressure on the provincial government to enact the legislation necessary to bring cyclists completely within the range of all traffic regulations which might not yet be binding on

two-wheel, manually-propelled vehicles.

MORE FEARFUL

Each year, the island populace becomes ever more fearful as the holiday season opens to bring the happy, carefree cyclists from all parts of the world to the islands roads.

Each year, residents have more reports of rudeness and offensive behaviour of youthful riders who have endangered other road users.

On B.C. Day there were reports into the *Driftwood* office before midday of cyclists blocking traffic into Ganges by standing three abreast to chat and of two riders forming a traffic island in the middle of the road at Central and requiring traffic to pass on each side of them while they consulted their maps.

Lawson is convinced that she will enjoy a wide support from Salt Spring Island drivers and other residents in her campaign for greater safety on island roads.

Cyclist clipped by car

A 13-year-old cyclist visiting Salt Spring Island from Courtenay was clipped while riding his bicycle on Fulford-Ganges Road.
