Mission selling property with interest-free, five-year term

Ocean-front property at one-third down payment and five-year terms with no interest rates is an offer difficult to refuse.

And that's what the North American Indian Mission is counting on as the group attempts to dispose of property in the Gulf Islands. None of the land is Indian owned.

William Lottis, general director of NAIM, said in a news release that "a change in emphasis has led us to phase out the camping and conference programs for Indian people." With a change in the program, the group found that land was available and the no-interest rate offer should enhance the sales potential of the land.

"By offering these lands on a financing plan with no interest when paid as agreed, we anticipate rapid sales," said Lottis. The immediate cash flow would allow NAIM to budget for missionary work and not be concerned about allotting money for land taxes.

NAIM began in 1949 as a ship-based hospital facility serving B.C.'s isolated coastal villages. The group, currently based in Delta, acquired its first land holdings in 1953 when a farmer on Thetis Island turned his equity over to the mission.

Over the years the amount of land increased and the properties were used as summer camps for Indian children as well as other uses.

"This type of camping is not now what the parents are seeking for their children," explained Lottis, "so we are phasing out the camping and conference part of our missionary work and disposing of the property."

The group initially limited the no-interest offer to five of the 19 properties it owns. The offer has been extended to a few more properties to entice quick sales and a review of the results is planned to determine if the offer can be continued for other properties.

Ed Webber of Delta Realty in Tsawwassen is agent for NAIM and he produced statistics to prove the value of the offer.

A two-acre ocean-front property with an August, 1981, price tag would cost \$68,900 with

monthly payments of \$766 at 18% interest. After five years the buyer would have paid \$36,366 in interest and \$9,594 in principal.

Under the NAIM scheme with the same payments, the title would be clear within the five-year period.

Down Through the Years with Driftwood

TWENTY YEARS AGO

B.C. Hydro was increasing power in a new line on Scott Point to allow Holdfast Natural Resources, the pozzolan plant on Welbury Bay, to increase its use of electricity. The new line would carry 25,000 volts and a Hydro spokesman said service would be interrupted at various times over six weeks in order to complete the project. Areas of Salt Spring as well as the Outer Islands would be affected by the power breaks.

The Canadian Arthritis and Rheumatism Society on Salt Spring Island gathered \$473.50 in a canvass of the island.

Ganges would be the recipient of \$185,000 from Ottawa for the construction of a boat basin. The Salt Spring Island Chamber of Commerce had been lobbying for the facility and the national budget had included that amount for the proposed moorage.

Driftwood pointed out that the United Kingdom is the only country in the world that does not have its name printed on its postage stamps or on its coins.

The Women's Auxiliary of the Anglican Parish held a St. Valentine Tea and sale in the parish hall. A choir girl costume parade was the highlight of the event. Brisk business was reported at the home cooking, needlework and plant stalls.

The P.T.A. gathered to discuss the book *What Ivan Knows That Johnny Doesn't*. Moderator Ray Hill led the discussion with about 50 people in attendance. Plans for a speaking contest for students were announced.

Stowell Lake was graced by five white swans.

FIFTEEN YEARS AGO

Salt Spring Island was spelled as two words, according to the British Columbia Gazette. Precedence for the two-word version came from an entry in the Gazette of January 4, 1873 when Salt Spring Island was incorporated as a municipality. The new civic structure, third such in the province, would be styled The Corporation of the Township of Salt Spring Island. The corporation was later dissolved but the two-word name stayed.

The Fulford Athletic Club tried again to hold a meeting. Not many showed up to the Fulford Community Hall and the meeting had to be moved to a nearby residence because of lack of

heating in the hall.

The Gulf Islands School Board released figures showing that the school population in the islands was growing faster than the provincial average. In 1963, there were 529 pupils enrolled in local schools. By 1966 the figure had increased to 620. The Salt Spring Island numbers were: 1963, 438; 1966, 529. The yearly percentage increase was about seven percent compared with a five percent growth province-wide.

The Galiano Club held an annual meeting and re-elected Margaret Robson as president. She was the first woman president of the 43-year-old organization. The group established a fund to finance the project for 1967 which was to put a new floor in the community hall.

The Women's Auxiliary of the Anglican Church held a St. Valentine Tea and sale in the parish hall. The sale of goods from the home cooking and sewing stalls raised \$75.

Guests at a shower held in honour of a bride-to-be in Fulford were treated to a game of name-the-lakes on Salt Spring Island. The participants had to say how many lakes wet the island as well as give a name for each.

TEN YEARS AGO

Following the election of school trustees several months before, the seat reserved for Mayne Island remained empty because no resident of that island wanted it. The provincial government named Gordon Ducklow to be the trustee from Mayne Island.

The oil slick spread over Stuart Channel from a parked freighter and even as investigation began, the ship moved off. A resident of Salt Spring Island notified RCMP that the slick was spreading. A helicopter of the department of transport flew over the scene, gathering photographic evidence. The slick, apparently from cleaning a bilge, was dispersed by the high winds and tides.

The Sea Master ran aground in Ganges Harbour near Chocolate Island. The fishing vessel remained in a precarious position for 12 hours before high tides aided other boats in refloating the beached fishboat.

The Gulf Islands School Board delayed a decision on the fate of the dormitory on Ganges Hill on Salt Spring Island until discussions with the Gulf Islands

Community Arts Council could be held. The trustees agreed that the house would no longer be used as a dormitory.

Salt Spring Island soccer teams won one, tied one and lost one in weekend action both on and off-island.

Licence plates were due and sales on Salt Spring Island were down from previous years. The licence office would be open on a Saturday to serve late-comers. Deadline for the purchase of plates was February 29.

Pay raises for teachers would be limited to 6½% by decree of the minister of education. Any amount over that figure would have to be decided upon by referendum. Trustees for the Gulf Islands School District expressed displeasure at the government requirement.

FIVE YEARS AGO

B.C. Ferry Corporation changed the rules again and residents of the Gulf Islands who are not on the voters list can apply for and receive a card. The system of using the voters' list to determine qualification was the only equitable way to proceed with an otherwise discriminatory system, said CRD chairman Jim Campbell. The system had been questioned by Gail Secor of Salt Spring Island Community Society.

The health committee from the Capital Regional District board came to Ganges to see first-hand the problems of sewage disposal. The group, closely watched by TV cameras, toured various sections of the village. Representatives of the business community hosted the group and were asking for the use of holding tanks until a solution to the problem could be created. The tanks would enable the businesses to carry out renovations.

The CRD released an estimated cost for the proposed Ganges sewer of \$2.6 million. When village incorporation for Ganges was defeated in a referendum in 1967, the sewage system bore a price tag of \$186,000.

B.C. Forest Service donated \$2,000 worth of hardwood and softwood shrubs to the Gulf Islands School District. The

Commuting problem half-solved by board

The Gulf Islands School Board has solved one-half of the problem facing the commuting Saturna students.

The students won't have to use the ferry service Fridays which often saw them arrive home at 11 pm. They will join other Outer Islands pupils on the water taxi to Mayne Island.

There the students will either catch the regular water taxi taking children home or if it is missed will have a taxi hired for them.

"I'd rather see them home," said Galiano trustee Jim Ripley. "I don't care how much it costs."

Students from Galiano and Mayne use a water taxi to come to and go from the secondary school on Salt Spring each weekday.


The Saturna students had to catch the Fulford ferry to Swartz Bay where they faced a long walk to the ticket booth despite the fact they rode free. The Saturna ferry docked in the adjacent berth to the Fulford ferry but ferry officials claimed the need for passenger control. The Saturna students must use the ferry system to get to Salt Spring on Sunday for school on Monday.

opportunity to tighten programs instead of cutting teaching positions," said Aust. "We're going to attempt to reduce our budget without affecting instruction in the classroom."

He said the board is in the process of creating a committee to study programs with a view to eliminating those not needed. The committee will be composed of members of the school board, school district administration, the Gulf Islands Teachers' Association, Canadian Union of Public Employees as well as ratepayers.

They will examine every program outside of the core curriculum as set by the education ministry. The locally initiated programs will be looked at to see if they continue to meet the original intention, whether they are cost effective and whether they meet the requirements of the students.

CONTINUOUS REVIEW

The review will be continuous, said Aust, and should accomplish its findings in about two years.

"It's the only way I can see that we can examine the school budget and not affect the education we are able to offer to the students," he said.

The review will also look at facilities available to the district. While Aust admitted that some schools, such as the Pender school, are among the best in the province, others such as Salt Spring Elementary need a thorough review.

In referring to the Salt Spring school, Aust said, "We are using areas for instruction which were not planned for that purpose and which are not up to either ministry

or our standards."

He said plans will continue for the Fulford school in light of the fact that the capital budgets have not yet been brought under the guidelines.

WILL CARRY ON

"We're going to carry on with our plans and until we're told otherwise, we'll go with the information we've been given so far."

He received notice from the ministry that the deputy minister for facilities will speak to each school district about the needs for buildings. The Gulf Islands district has followed ministry regulations in asking for a new facility and, said Aust, "the ministry criteria more than proves the need for six rooms in Fulford."

At a conference of district teachers and instruction staff last week, Aust explained the ministry guidelines to those attending. He told the teachers that their help is needed to meet the reduced budget. He explained that jobs were not on the line but that the board needed their advice in the

evaluation on programs.

The cutbacks may adversely affect other districts but not the local one.

"I'm not trying to justify the healthy increase we put on this year," said Aust, "but for the next two years we should be in good shape."

Hotel purchase denied

Bob Wright, owner of the Oak Bay Marina, has denied reports that he had purchased the Harbour House Hotel in Ganges.

Wright, in a telephone conversation with *Driftwood*, said he has not bought the hotel, has no intention of buying anything on Salt Spring and has no property on the island.
