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# No road through ecological reserve, Islands Trust assures protest groups

Two petitions have been submitted to the province in respect of Mountain Road, at Musgrave.

A petition had been submitted asking that the highway be declared a public road, the Salt Spring Island Trust Committee was told last week. Such a declaration would authorize the ministry to bring it up to standard.

The second petition, shown to the committee last week by Patrick Dupuy, urges that the road runs through an ecological reserve and that no change be permitted in the standard.

Highways minister Alex Fraser has been asked to develop the road and to leave it as it is.

The planner, Richard McKellar, noted that although the road runs through the ecological reserve the property beyond that reserve could be developed if served by an adequate road.

Last year the committee considered it and urged that the ecological reserve be respected, recalled John Rich.

These reserves are set up by an act of the provincial legislature and they are important, he urged.

"We are supposed to be an environment protection group and we have no business looking further than that. The integrity of the ecological reserve must be protected."

The committee will report to the highways ministry and to the ministers of the appropriate departments that the Salt Spring Island Trust Committee does not support any upgrading of the road in the ecological reserve.

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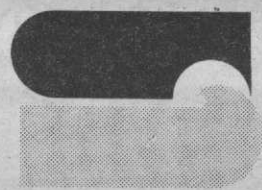

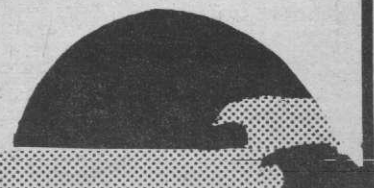
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# Down Through the Years with Driftwood

## Twenty years ago

**Victoria Day** was celebrated on Salt Spring Island at Fulford Hall for the 41st year. The May Queen led the parade flanked by cadets of the Canadian Scottish Regiment of Duncan. The event continued through the afternoon with games for the children and food for the hungry.

**The weeping willow** graced the shore of St. Mary Lake until an animal decided to sharpen its teeth. The island resident viewed the downed tree and wondered if the animal had been a beaver or perhaps an unknown monster which inhabited the lake.

**An automobile** driven by a Salt Spring resident visited the Fulford post office. The brakes of the vehicle failed as the car was driven down the hill to the ferry wharf. The driver drove into the side of the post office to avoid causing further damage to other users of the road or himself.

**The students** of the Salt Spring schools celebrated Commonwealth and Citizenship Day under the auspices of the IODE.

**The anniversary** marked 50 years of service to the Anglican ministry. Archdeacon G.H. Holmes received congratulations from many friends both on the island and from elsewhere. He had been ordained May 12, 1913 in Saskatoon and had come to Salt Spring in 1941.

**The balance sheet** for the Gulf Islands School District showed expenditures for the previous year of \$261,662.97 from a budget of \$268,243. The largest expense to the district covered instructional costs of \$152,957.72.

**Trustees** of the school district were ready to complain about education financing from the provincial government. The government supplied only 17 percent of the school budget.

## Fifteen years ago

**The cougar** had claimed many sheep and deer for food during its few weeks' stay on Salt Spring Island. A trio of hunters took a dog to the slopes of Mount Maxwell and when the cougar showed up, it was treed and killed.

**The ambulance service** on Salt Spring, run by the Lions Club, would be improved when the new ambulance came. The vehicle would be more comfortable, larger and faster than the ambulance in use.

**Colin Cameron** was the unanimous choice as candidate for the New Democratic Party in Nanaimo-Cowichan-The Islands. He represented the riding in parliament in Ottawa and had done so for three terms.

**The rummage sale** held by the Ladies' Auxiliary to the Legion raised \$340. The money would be used to decorate the Legion Hall.

**The soccer team** at the Salt Spring School won two games. The boys defeated Crofton 11-0 and took a second game from Cordova Bay 3-2. Both games were played on the island.

**Ferry traffic figures** showed more visitors came to Galiano Island for the holiday weekend than was usually the case. The tourist population of the island was also increased by the many people who came by yachts and cruisers. Few campsites on the island were empty.

**The Mayne Island water taxi** was laid up for repairs. The boat struck a log near Port Washington. Another vessel was pressed into service while repairs were being carried out.

## Ten years ago

**The cost of ambulance service** went up 20 percent. The Salt Spring Lions Ambulance Society decided to boost the costs to meet expenses. The service would cost \$6 instead of \$5. The raise in price was the first implemented in many years.

**The dump truck** breezed through Ganges without slowing or stopping. The main reason for the action was lack of brakes. The driver had tried to brake the loaded truck on Ganges Hill and discovered that the brakes did not work. He sounded the horn continuously and stopped the vehicle by driving into a pile of cement blocks just short of the harbour.

**The girls' softball teams** from Salt Spring defeated teams from Crofton in four games. Scores in two of the games were 31-13 and 61-30.

**The Salties** won again. The roller hockey team outscored the All-Stars 7-6 in another rough game.

## Trust seeks information

Owners of land in a commercial 4 zone will be invited to summarize their plans for expansion for the Islands Trust.

A letter has been authorized explaining that the Salt Spring Island Trust Committee is reviewing zoning provisions for such property.

The owner is asked to submit a brief outline of any plans he might have, as a guide to the planner, Richard McKellar in his work with the trust committee.

Earlier plans for changing C4 zoning were sent back to the Trust by the ministry of municipal affairs for a review.

**Hugh Curtis**, MLA for the area, spoke to the Galiano Chamber of Commerce. He stressed the need for planning for each island by residents of the island.

**Youthful visitors** to Galiano and Salt Spring Islands caused problems for residents and police during the long weekend. Complaints of noise and vandalism had been made and charges were laid against several of the tourists.

**Commercial fishermen** from Galiano Island prepared for a season at sea. Many boats were being cleaned and painted in anticipation of the fishing ahead. Fulford. Police said he was apparently on the wrong side of the road when the accident happened.

## Five years ago

Walter Brigden, 83, gathered \$600 for the use of the service club. The walk had been postponed a month from the usual start but was plagued by rain.

**Mother's Day** on Mayne Island was marked with a breakfast sponsored by the volunteer fire brigade. The pancakes drew many people to the event which was becoming a tradition on the island.

**Mayne Islanders** decided to donate \$1,000 to furnish a room at the new personal care facility on Salt Spring. The Mayne Island Agricultural Society, in general meeting, approved the donation. They also gave \$1,500 to several other island projects.

**The meeting** had been attended by a resident and a Driftwood reporter. The Islands Trust members spoke to an almost empty room. The reporter and the resident noted that one of the people at the meeting had fallen asleep.

**A Vancouver motorcyclist** was killed when he ran into a motor home at the top of Lee's Hill in Fulford. Police said he was apparently on the wrong side of the road when the accident happened.

# Salt Spring dump to be tightly controlled until new area found

Tight control will be maintained on the Salt Spring Island garbage dump and burning will be strictly limited. The Capital Regional Board will be invited to help in finding a more suitable location.

Following complaints from various island residents the Salt Spring Island Trust Committee had called on the ministry of the environment to require that the operation of the dump conformed to the terms of the permit.

Resulting from the letter was a meeting on May 6, when Norman Twa, of the Salt Spring Island Garbage Service; Ken Austin, Waste Management Branch; Richard McKellar, Islands Trust and Craig Sommerville and Bob Warman, of the Capital Regional District examined the procedure and the complaints.

The region will pay an invoice of \$3,500 to Norman Twa to settle the account to May 1.

Sommerville explained that islanders pay a levy which was \$7,521 in 1982 as a subsidy of the operation. Part of this is returned to the island as a subsidy for recycling and part is paid to the garbage service.

### OTHER ISLANDS

It was noted during the meeting that two other islands contribute a small quantity of waste to the Salt

Spring landfill. One load a week, of approximately 20 cubic yards, comes from the contractor on Mayne Island and other islanders, notably on Pender, bring individual discharges.

Ken Austin explained the waste management branch seeks to keep the working face as small as possible and covered once each week. No burning is allowed other than those materials specified on the permit and unauthorized fires must be promptly extinguished.

Twa explained that it is a matter of dollars and cents. There is not enough revenue to meet the cost of conforming to the terms of the waste management permit.

Increases in tipping fees or an increase in the subsidy were discussed. If the operator wants an increased subsidy he would have to discuss it with the island director, it was noted.

The meeting also considered concerns of local residents as well as other options for solid waste disposal.

There was some discussion of relocating the operation, but no conclusion was reached.

### SUMMARY

Planner Richard McKellar summarized the report when he suggested that the basis of operation should be changed to keep the working space as small as possible and to keep it promptly covered. Only materials to be burned are those which burn readily.

Chairman Mike Humphries was concerned with the complaints expressed by Sid Filkow and others.

While it was generally agreed that a dump is a dump, said McKellar, it was also agreed that it could operate better. The waste management branch and the regional district, as well as the operator, are all aware of the complaints of local residents, he added.

Bev Unger was concerned that garbage was coming from Mayne and Pender Islands. Was it in keeping with the permit, she enquired.

The Outer Islands people find it cheaper to come to Salt Spring Island than to go to Swartz Bay, said the planner.

### NOT ENOUGH MONEY

The report tells the story, said Gordon Wallace. He's not getting enough money.

"Unless the waste management prevents it he must take anything to get the revenue."

The niceties of operation were skipped by Nick Gilbert.

"The fact remains," he reminded the committee, "it is in a watershed. The need is for an alternative site."

The former trustees searched for a site and found nothing, recalled Unger.

On the motion of Gilbert, the committee will call on the CRD to co-operate in the appointment of a committee to come up with a solution that has so far not been found.

## Weekend keeps police busy

The holiday weekend kept Ganges detachment RCMP busy.

There were several complaints of noisy parties late in the night from residents of Galiano and Salt Spring Islands.

The police also reported infractions of the Motor Vehicle Act. Several motorcyclists were charged for not wearing a helmet. Other drivers of vehicles were charged with not wearing seatbelts.

There were charges involving expired license plates. The charge brings a mandatory \$300 fine for driving an uninsured vehicle.

At least two disturbances in provincial parks on Galiano brought about evictions of several exuberant campers. The park ranger and RCMP were called to deal with the incidents.

A fight at Sturdies Bay on Galiano resulted in one of the participants suffering broken ribs. The altercation occurred at 1:30 am Sunday. A Vancouver man and a Galiano resident were involved but no names were released while the investigation of the incident continues.

## Plan review begins

Ron McQuiggan, school district representative on the APC, noted that the process could take up to a year. He spoke against a request for a zoning freeze which came from the community planning association.

The request was brought by Arvid Chalmers who represents that group on the APC. Chalmers said the planning association had been concerned about any changes in zoning density being allowed while the community plan was being reviewed.

McQuiggan said such a freeze would be unfair to property owners.

Bev Unger, Islands Trust representative for Salt Spring, said she doubted if the process of review would take more than six months. She noted that the most contentious issue would be the waste disposal problem in Ganges.

Russ Lazaruk, APC chairman, pointed out the need for the protection of a healthy economy. He gave as an example the attempts to close the log dump in Ganges Harbour. Logging employs up to

100 people on Salt Spring, he said. "Our economy doesn't exist on arts and crafts and real estate deals," he said.

Unger wanted a statement concerning zoning for seniors added to the plan. But Islands Trust planner Richard McKellar said zoning could be used to control the usage of land but not the users of the land.

The group agreed to change one of the goals in the preamble to the plan to include reference to age and the special needs of the retirement population.

Ganges, Fulford and Vesuvius will be recognized as commercial and residential centres for the island and Ganges will continue to be the main centre.

Members of the APC will discuss possible changes to the plan but no specific changes will be made as yet. Any changes will be agreed upon in principle by the meetings and held until the entire plan has been discussed.

The next meeting of the APC to talk about the plan will be June 14.
