

Soil's organic content should be seven to 10%

Last week's column was dedicated to VAMS, or vesicular arbuscular mycorrhizae, a fungus which lives inside the root hairs of most plants in close symbiotic relationship.

It supplies the plant with phosphorous in return for carbohydrates. So here we have nature's supplier of phosphorous to the green life.

We have long known about the nitrogen-fixing value of the leguminous plants, such as clovers, peas and beans. Again, this is brought about by a symbiotic relationship, this time with a bacterium, the rhizobia, which absorb nitrogen from the air.

The bacteria, which form nodules on the roots of leguminous plants, supply the plant with nitrogen in return for carbohydrates.

NATURAL SUPPLIERS

Together, we have here the natural suppliers of the two major nutrients to our plant life. We do not know yet how the third major element, potash, is supplied. But it stands to reason that nature has found a way to supply this, otherwise we would not be here.

At this time, all I can say is that potash is being supplied. Both the rhizobia and the mycorrhizae are microbiotic life forms which will thrive only in soils free of poisons.

Fungicides and other poisons destroy these life forms, with the result that we have to provide what they supplied.

Since the mycorrhizal fungi also inhibit nematodes and nematode-carried virus diseases, we then need to fight these with more poisons, which leads us further and deeper

into the cycle of poisons.

ANOTHER WAY

There is another way which requires neither artificial fertilizers nor poisons. I have described this with the pea, bean, winter crop rotation, which will supply all the fertilizers, yield three edible harvests in one season and improve the soil quality and the quantity of beneficial soil life, such as the bacteria and mycorrhizae.

The winter crop is especially valuable as a host to the mycorrhizae, assuring their survival and proliferation and their abundant presence for our next gardening season.

When Sir Albert Howard first started applying compost to various crops, he noted that the improvement of plant health and vigour was far out of proportion to the minimal amount of applied compost. He traced the dramatic improvement to the presence of the mycorrhizal fungus, derived from or enhanced by the applied compost.

Since compost consists mainly of semi-decayed plant and manure

materials, it follows then that soil high in semi-decayed organic materials, and free of poisons, provides a beneficial environment for a thriving microbiotic soil population.

SEVEN PERCENT

So all we really need to do is bring the organic content of our soil up to about seven percent and keep it there. When your soil feels a bit "springy" and gives a bit as you walk over it, you are near the seven percent mark.

If it starts to get "mushy" you are above the seven percent mark by a fair bit. Between seven and 10% is about optimum. To maintain top fertility and healthy soil life, it would be best to grow the pea, bean and corn salad succession in one-half of your garden, all your other

vegetables in the other half and to switch sides every year.

It also helps to grow a white clover ground cover between your cabbages, cucumbers and tomatoes for all the previously mentioned benefits. Shear this to two inches high when necessary.

GROW MARIGOLDS

And grow some marigolds in your garden. According to new findings at UBC, the marigold, mushrooms and golden rod all contain polyacetylenes, a phototoxic compound as described in the June issue of *Organic Gardening*. As a leaf-eating bug, the kind we do not like, takes a bite of the leaf, the dormant phototoxic compounds are exposed to light, become highly energetic, excite oxygen molecules,

which then destroy tissue, killing the bug which ate them.

Keep up the level of all 60 trace elements. Plants cannot manufacture deterrents against insects and diseases if they lack the raw materials.

We do not know which elements are required to manufacture phototoxins, tannins and other defensive compounds, but be assured that nature has provided them. Every element of the earth eventually finds its way into the sea and is there absorbed into the weed of the sea.

Use it to maintain your full spectrum of trace elements, that is what it is there for, and let nature take care of herself and us, as she has done for millenia.

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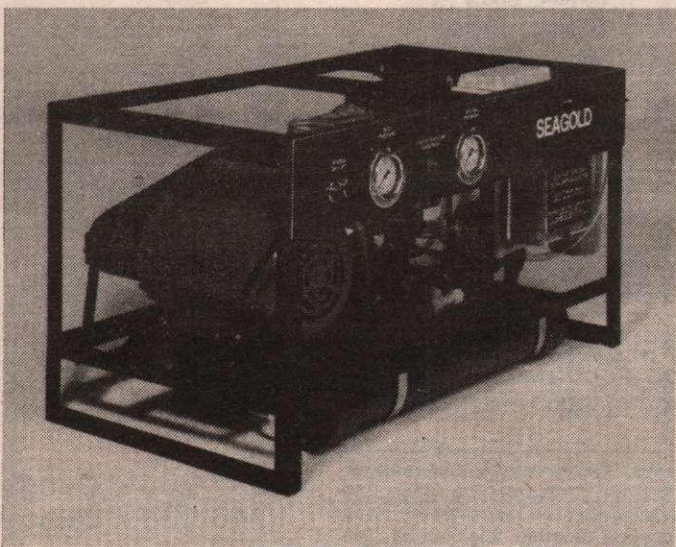
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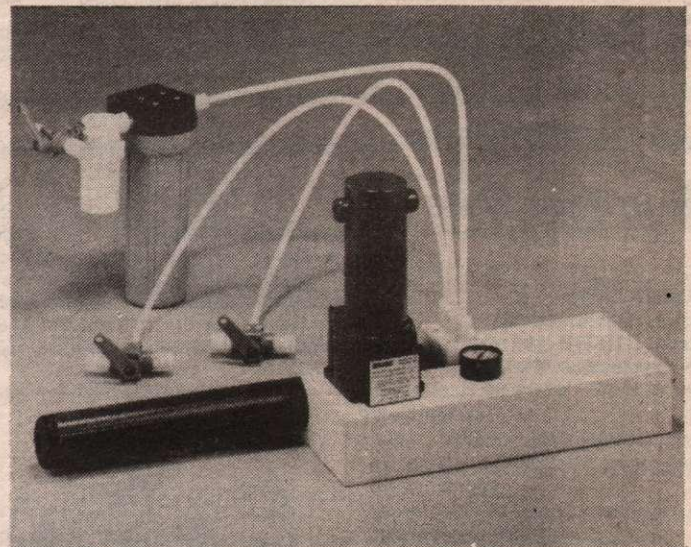

SATURNA SCENE

Gardening chief occupation for most at present

Gardens are the primary source of activity for Saturna people this time of year.

In answer to my question, "Any news for the paper?" the customary answer is, "Nooo, can't think of any right now. How's your garden?"

I've visited some interesting gardens lately and traded some swell plants. Jim Money grows his gardens in raised boxes all around his house. He also has a hothouse packed with tomatoes, honeydew melons and peas.

Several people built greenhouses this year and got right to growing things in them. Karen Boser has a beautiful crop of English cucumbers on one side of her hothouse and the other side is a hedge of large-trunked tomato trees. They have been having tomatoes off their "cheater bushes" (nursery-bought plants) for a few weeks now.

Lil Cunningham has an old-fashioned glass house that she is considering moving into! Asparagus is her specialty. She has a box full of heavy producers and tells of many meals featuring the vegetable.

The eggplant prize goes to Karen Muntean. She has several beauties growing in her glass enclosure built with warm air access to their kitchen. Eggplants prefer a temperature of about 90° with lots of water, so this is quite a feat.

Tom Davidson's gardens are lovely with lots of old perennials and annuals started in his deluxe, temperature-controlled greenhouse. Tom believes in lots of tomatoes and

has well over 100 planted.

Last Thursday the school kids walked to Taylor Point from Narvaez Bay and stayed overnight. Taylor Point is a grand beach for forts. The kids went off into groups and were immediately hard at it. Each group had a different kind of place, some with tunnel entrances, or gun turrets, some half buried, or with doors and soft floors.

The one major concern with all the children was a watertight roof because, of course, it was raining!

One way to keep dry is to eat a lot apparently. The kids consumed giant amounts of food and had a splendid time. There were no whiners, no complainers—they were a very good-hearted group. Jesse Guy came along and celebrated her first birthday with the kids.

Awards day was at the hall this year. Bea Carpentier and Debby Graham arranged for the groaning board and the kids and teachers did the program. Books are the prizes at our school, books chosen with each individual child's interests in mind.

Each child received recognition for individual achievements. Michael Jacks was roundly thanked for his extensive practical knowledge and willingness to use it at school. We have many good athletes at school who won medals at Sports Day and the two with the most points, Christine Fisker and Wesley Paulin, won cups presented by the Lions Club.

Trevor, Michael, Desiree and Ingrid were awarded attendance awards by Carol Money. Taimi

Hindmarch was, of course, present in the audience and Larry Holbrook, a long-time friend of our school, also came for the ceremony.

The music presented by the children and teacher Dawne Milligan was superb. Our Motley crew was so sleek, so co-ordinated in the two songs they played, (with tricky variations in harmony) That we were all delighted. Kimberley Graham was present at awards day. Kimberley has been on correspondence for the last few months and is doing splendidly.

Our Mayne Island children did very well at their awards ceremony. Michael Fisker achieved the citizenship award. This award is voted on by the kids and teachers of the school. Cindy Hogg won the girl athlete sports award.

Taimi reports that it was a lovely affair. Our graduating students are Kaliya Muntean, Corey Boser, Mike Fisker and Cindy Hogg.

Daisy and Walter Bavis are visiting Ann Bavis for a few days. They came to Monday night's Community Club meeting and it was just like old times. Many times Walter has chaired the meetings.

Ann also had Stacy, her daughter visiting from Prince George, and son Gordon.

The lamb barbecue takes place Friday. The work bees have been working along and lots has been accomplished by many people. Much float work has been done, repairs and new ramps and docks. Everyone seems satisfied with the progress.

The whole community is welcome to participate in these working get-togethers. The day before the barbecue is an all-day work bee and, of course, the day after is the clean-up bee. It's always nice to have lots of hands for that one.

The Community Club met recently. We now have 94 members, the largest ever. Jacques Campbell, the treasurer, figures it costs about \$6,000 a year for our hall—this is minimum upgrading and regular maintenance. This year we will be a bit short on funds due to a steady outgo.

Polly Howarth is resigning from the health group, in terms of her administrative duties. Margaret Fry will replace her. Polly gave a lively

and detailed account of the present state of the group and made several requests of the community club which were handled with success and humour.

Bob Forrest, the new island doctor, and his wife Karen and son Johnny were there to see the community in action and to further acquaint themselves with Saturna people.

Discussion was held on an activity centre that some islanders are interested in promoting. The community seems anxious to know how it could be funded if it is needed and who it would serve.

The question of regulation of hunting on the island came up. The group in charge of consideration was given further support to come up with recommendations to be presented to the community.

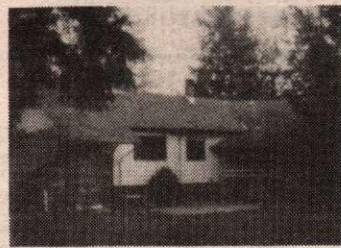

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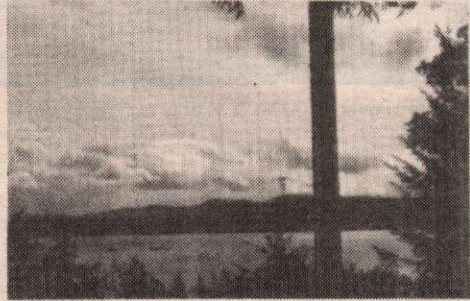

No more money for employment program

A government-funded program to encourage employers to hire students this summer has run out of money.

The provincial government allotted \$10 million to the ministry of labour for a student employment program to aid unemployed students and to encourage small businesses to hire students.

But the ministry now reports that all applications from businesses received after May 13 could not be considered by the ministry because the money had already been allocated to earlier applicants.

The government offered to pay half the employee's hourly wage to a

maximum of \$2.50.

"About 150 applications were turned down," program training consultant Pam Campbell explained from the Victoria offices of the ministry of labour, "Everyone applied for the help this summer because of the poor economy."

Campbell explained that the response was "incredible."

Reports from island businesses suggest that students are being put to work but few have used the student hiring program. Ganges Pharmasave hired a student but without the government program, along with Fulford Inn, which hired two students.

Foxglove spokesman explained that the quiet time for Foxglove was in the summer and no new staff were necessary.

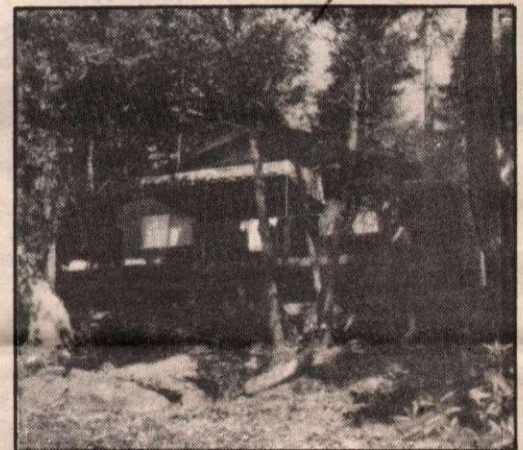

Toomey was issued a traffic violation notice for driving too fast for road conditions.


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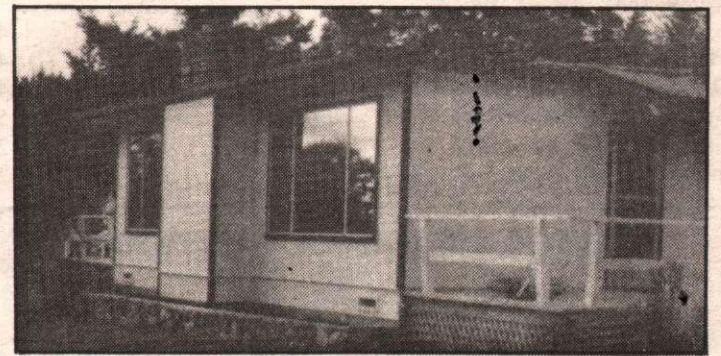

Down Through the Years with Driftwood

Twenty years ago

The referendum concerning expenditures for an auditorium-gymnasium and science room on Salt Spring as well as a new teacherage on Galiano failed to gain the required 60% support. 53.6% of the Gulf Islands voters supported the proposal. School district officials would determine if the question would be asked again.

Work on the harbour in Ganges had been put to tender. A Vancouver firm was successful bidder for the project which would see a breakwater put in place and floats constructed to form a small boat basin.

Graduation ceremonies at Gulf Islands Secondary School were held with 19 students taking part. The ceremonies included granting of awards for various scholarships and certificates recognizing the achievements of members of the graduating class.

Daily service between Long Harbour and Tsawwassen would commence on July 4. The Queen of the Islands would make two round trips daily. The ceremonies to kick off the service were to be held in Ganges with special guest Premier W.A.C. Bennett.

Renewals of the annual membership in the Lions Club ambulance family plan were publicized. The fee had been set at \$5 per year per family and new members were being sought and welcomed.

The founder of Driftwood, E.V. Woody Fisher, and his wife Bobby were leaving Salt Spring to live in Vancouver. The couple were guests of honour at a farewell party put on by friends.

Softball games and horseshoe pitching were part of the fun at the basket picnic held on Salt Spring by the local Social Credit League. Guest of honour Earle Westwood spoke at a public meeting later in the evening.

Fifteen years ago

A tempest in a flower pot blew up in Fulford when a rumour started that the flower boxes near the ferry terminal were to be removed. When the story had been tracked down, no confirmation of the rumour could be found and the flower boxes, tended by Fulford residents, were to stay.

The department of highways crew were widening the road between Pioneer Village in Ganges and the stores in the village. The Chamber of Commerce had wanted a sidewalk but the highways officials

decided to widen the road.

The sheep farmers of Salt Spring joined together to form an association. A meeting in Fulford Hall attended by 17 decided to set up the Salt Spring Sheep Breeder's Association with membership open to all persons with an interest in promoting and developing the sheep industry on the island.

School taxes in the Gulf Islands went up and residents weren't happy. The chairman of the school board, George Heinekey, explained that all school districts in the province shared school expenses according to size. The provincial average mill rate for school costs was 31.21 mills with each district kicking in 24.3 mills on average for the basic costs. The Gulf Islands levy stood at 30.45 mills and had increased only 4.63 mills compared to the average provincial increase of 8.2 mills, he explained.

Repairs to the government wharf in Fulford Harbour were under way. The superstructure of the wharf would be repaired and a nine by 120 foot float would be added. The price tag, under tender from a Victoria firm, had been set at \$33,447.

The garden tea netted \$147 for the Order of the Eastern Star. The money would be used in the charitable efforts of the group in various projects. Much of the money raised by the local group and the provincial organization was slated for cancer research. The combined provincial groups had set a target of \$40,000 to be raised in the year.

Ten years ago

Renovations to the high school and the elementary school in Ganges proceeded. Students at the high school went for an early summer vacation while the elementary pupils moved out of their school and up the hill. The elementary school had been stripped to the framework of the original structure which had been put up 30 years previously.

Artcraft '73 opened in Mahon Hall for a two-month summer run. Art displays as well as demonstrations of various crafts would be open from noon to 6 pm each day until the end of August.

The Saturna Island lamb barbecue would attract interest from many places, organizers hoped. Special carver for the day of festivities would be Lieutenant-Governor Walter Owens.

The hotel at the head of Ganges Harbour had burned but workmen were busy replacing the building.

Local Initiative Programs ended

in the Gulf Islands. Five projects on Salt Spring were part of the program. The work on the island included construction of a breakwater at Drummond Park and a softball diamond on property leased by the Parks and Recreation Commission in Fulford.

Five years ago

Graduation ceremonies at Gulf Islands Secondary School involved 57 students of the Grade 12 classes. Guest speaker for the occasion was Tommy Douglas, popular MP for Nanaimo, Malahat, The Islands.

Pender Island Silver Threads received \$3,736 from New Horizons to expand their program to include shuffleboard, billiards and other indoor games.

The public would be encouraged to participate in school board matters. The Gulf Islands School Board passed a policy motion to encourage the public to attend meetings of the board. A question period would allow the public to express opinions and ask questions on school matters.

The CBC recording crew came to Salt Spring Island to catch the music. Sylvia Tyson brought the recording gang to the island to tape Valdy. Kathy Stack and Marianne Grittani were also part of the taping session for a radio program to be broadcast in the fall.

The meeting on Pender Island drew more than 100 guests from Vancouver Island. The occasion was a meeting of the South Vancouver Island Zone of the Royal Canadian Legion.

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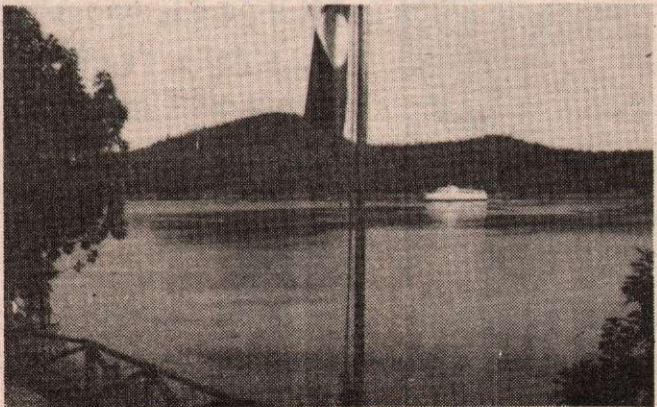

Hovermarine rides like a float plane

The Hovermarine lies off the dock and rolls gently with the movement of the water. It lies on the water and resembles no other vessel. Perhaps it is most suggestive of a very large houseboat.

The skipper sits up in the cockpit and starts the twin 400 diesels. There is no significance to the motors running. They make a little more noise than in some conventional vessels, but they are not offensive.

contention that there is no intention of competing with the ferries.

A FASTER SERVICE

The plan is to give the islands a faster service, he added.

John Norton, of Seaspeed, explained that it is hoped to go into operation at the beginning of August. In response to a question, he agreed that Transport Canada had not initially approved the vessel for the service, but he explained that it was largely because the west coast officials had not previously seen a Hovermarine.

The Hovermarine, suggested Norton, is the "leading edge of water transportation".

The original plans called for a terminal at Swartz Bay, reported Curtis, but during discussion with islanders, this plan was questioned.

Dale Codd, president of Salt Spring Island Chamber of Commerce, felt that the project had merit, but that if it brought tourists to the island, then it would be an invaluable service to the island community.

The Hovermarine is manufactured in Southampton, England. The company has been established since 1966 and has sold more than 100 craft to 28 countries. Largest single user is the Hong Kong and Yaumati Ferry Company which runs 28 Hovermarines.

As Curtis commented at the close of the demonstration, "That just might be the thing for the islands!"

At that point the skipper opens the throttles and the boat starts to move. The front half of the vessel rises a foot or so and it slowly moves out from the wharf. Once clear of the wharf, the throttles open and the Hovermarine comes up on its cushion of air as it gathers speed. Within a few metres of opening the throttle the vessel is skimming along the water at its top speed of some 35 mph.

The sensation is neither that of a conventional vessel nor of a flying machine.

The noise is slightly greater than

that in a familiar ferry vessel and the sensitivity to waves and ripples is not unlike the effect of travelling at speed in a water taxi. The ripples on the water give rhythmic vibration to the ship and variations such as a swell or a wake give a slight pitching or roll to the Hovermarine.

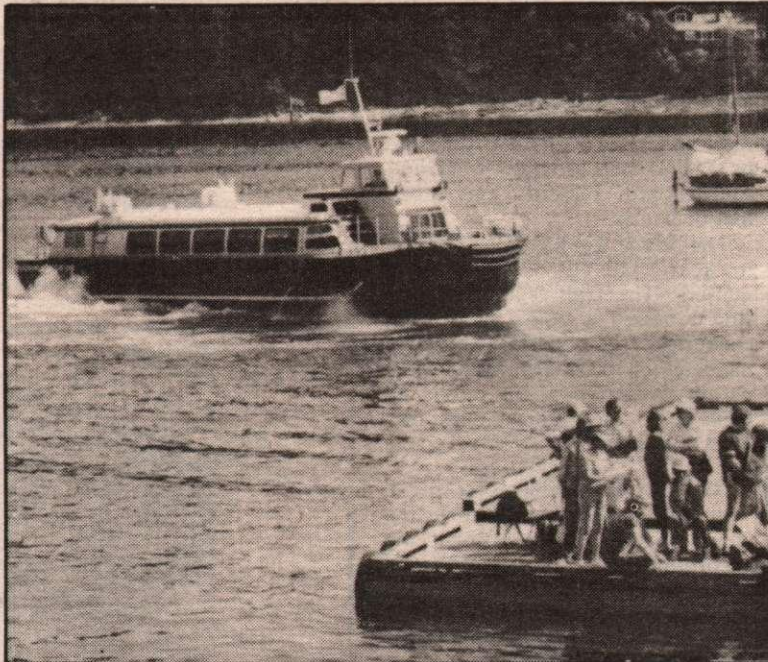
LIKE THE TAXI

It rides steadily over the water and when there is a heavy swell the effect is remarkably like the water taxi, with the ship gently rising and falling to shower a spray of water from the prow over the cabin.

The nearest approach to the

sensation and sound of the Hovermarine at high speed is being in a float plane and rushing over the water in the frantic haste to get off the harbour and into the air. Only difference is that the Hovermarine stays on the water and rushes off to the next port of call.

It was the demonstration run on Monday when the Hovermarine was introduced to the islands. In August it will come to the islands for a two-month trial period sponsored by the provincial government in order to assess the value of such a vessel for a high-speed, passenger-only service among the islands.
