

# Triangular pattern has great impact

The number "three", as far as I am concerned, is the most cosmic number of all. It is deep within us and consequently reflected as such in almost all our religions and esoteric teachings.

Just how deep and basic this number is ingrained in our very existence may be seen by the example of our life experience. We come into life in the triume relationship of father, mother and child. Although there is usually more than one child, we personally grow into our own lives as an individual entity with one father and one mother.

My father, my mother and myself! And my brother and my sister see themselves the same way. Later on in life we shift positions in the triangle of life to myself, my wife and our child, or children. Hence it is no wonder that the number three has such a deep appeal to us.

Unless you have come to know my inclination and my little tricks, you are probably wondering right now where this article on gardening is going. And indeed so am I. For it would be so easy to consider other triangular relationships, such as the sun, the earth and all life.

### PERCEIVED AS RIGHT

However, let this be sufficient evidence of our fascination with this most cosmic number, its ramifications and implications, and let us accept it as symbolic of a relationship which is perceived by us as 'right' and deeply satisfying.

This deep sense of rightness, wholeness and fruitful completion inherent in the cosmic triangle may be transferred to our surroundings simply and most satisfyingly by planting our shrubs and trees in triangular arrangements of three.

Hence, three rose bushes planted in a triangular relationship have a far greater impact on our senses than any other number of rose bushes. Similarly three clumps of bulbs of the same kind have the same wholesome effect if planted in a triangular relationship. And interestingly enough, individual clumps of bulbs look best to us if they are of an odd number. Three, five, seven or nine bulbs in a clump always look nicer somehow than an even number of bulbs. Two, four, six or eight bulbs in a bunch just don't seem to hang together somehow. However, with greater numbers, any differentiation disappears in the numbers and a great drift of daffodils is glorious no matter if its number is odd or even.

### BEST WAY TO PLANT THEM

This then is the best way to plant bulbs, either in discrete odd-numbered bunches in triangular relationships, or in great drifts. The same holds true for anything you might wish to plant. Even three rose bushes planted close together just make a smaller triangle.

If the same principle is followed in the layout of flower beds or in the arrangement of shrubs and trees, a beautiful and satisfying sense of rightness will become apparent, more so if the three sides of any

triangular relationship are of unequal length. Two rose bushes fairly close together with the third one noticeably farther away will appear as perfect to us.

The least satisfying arrangement we can make in our surroundings is to plant single specimens all over the place. Somehow something seems to be missing in such an arrangement although it might be difficult to say exactly what.

If you have inadvertently happened upon such a situation it is quite easy to change it to a very satisfying one. The first step would be to select one outstanding specimen and keep it that way, or else enhance it by isolating it. This is the value and appeal of a singular, unique event or specimen, just as you and I are singular and unique as individuals.

With a single specimen we make a very personal statement, that of the uniqueness of our individuality. A single rosebush in a flowerbed makes a definite statement of uniqueness.

### TRIPLE UP

Step number two would be to triple up on everything else, keeping in mind the creation of triangular relationships with unequal sides for the most satisfying results. However, unless such perfection should prove unbearable, introduce a joker into the deck.

Life always provides us with another avenue; there is always one chicken which refuses to roost with all the others, the fool or the wise man who marches to the beat of a different drummer, thus we avoid stagnation.

Two of the same kind are to be avoided at all costs. Two rosebushes in a flowerbed set up a feeling of tension and limitation between them. Our attention bounces back and forth between the two, without rest and without a way out. Our nuclear dilemma on the global scale and our sewer dilemma on the local scale demonstrate the tension two of the same kind can create between them.

However, if there be a path or a gate between the two, then the tension is resolved into an attractive invitation to pass between them. If there is no gate or path, though, we must add a third specimen of the same kind to relieve the tension and create the lacking harmony.

Four of the same kind create tension again as they tend to delineate into two pairs. Five is good, it just imparts a sense of change or flux. But now we are heavily into numerology or the principles of the I-Ching. Yet these too are based on the observation of the principles of life and as such are eminently applicable even to landscaping.

Who knows, perhaps we may have stumbled onto something here with our cosmic approach to landscaping and other problems. Or else the ravages of the flu have robbed me of the last shreds of my sanity, in which case I hope to be back to normal next week.

## Motorcycle accident

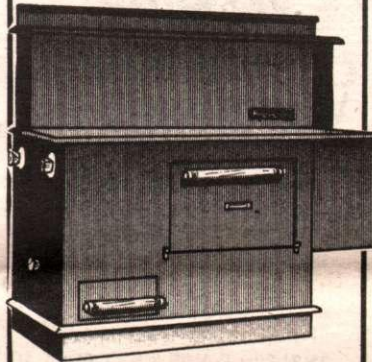
Two motorcycles collided Thursday and both drivers were injured.

### Swift continues drive for 'correct' spelling

The map for the official plan names Salt Spring Island and Stowe Lake.

The official plan sits in a file at the parliament building in Victoria in the office of the surveyor-general.

Phil Swift, in his latest efforts to have the name of the island spelled as three words, came across the map. He also uncovered a land grant to Joseph Tahouney from King Edward VII.

The grant covered 160 acres of the southeast quarter of section 60 on the official plan or survey of the south division of Salt Spring Island, Cowichan District.

The accompanying map shows the location of the grant to be near "Stowe L."

Swift has written to the surveys

and mapping branch of the provincial government to find the answers to several questions.

He wants to know if there is a registry of official place names and if the authority is federal, provincial or both.

Swift is also asking if the province has precedence for legal descriptions.

Many maps he has studied in his work as surveyor contain misspelled names and he wants to know how the names can be corrected.

In a letter to the Islands Trust, Swift requested that the names be spelled correctly.

"I ask the Salt Spring Island Trust Committee to advise their staff to refer to Salt Spring Island as three words and to call Stowe's lake by the correct name, both in their typed documents and on the maps they distribute to the public."

### Trustees want sidewalk

Children walking down Ganges Hill to school face dangers from traffic and the Gulf Islands School Board wants something done about it.

School trustees agreed last week to find a way to have a sidewalk built on the hill to reduce dangers to the children. The request will be sent to the department of highways in the "strongest terms", said school board chairman Charles Hingston.

Jeannine Dodds, trustee from Mayne Island, suggested that the school board enlist aid from other Salt Spring groups such as the parent advisory committee for Salt Spring Elementary School, the various service clubs and the Chamber of Commerce.

At least 14 children from the Charlesworth Road area have to make the walk down the hill this year. In previous years, they were picked up by the school bus even though they lived within the ministry-set walk limit.

The buses are crowded this year and the children must walk. Parents can form car pools to take the children to and from school, suggested Hingston, but he and the other school trustees see a sidewalk as the best answer to the safety problem.

### Expansion plans are under way at Fernwood

Fernwood School is to expand with the addition of two classrooms.

Trustees of the Gulf Islands School Board agreed to send working drawings of the proposed expansion to the ministry of education for approval. The two new classrooms carry a price tag of \$135,000.

The money came from the difference between the contract price for the Fulford school and the original \$1.5 million approved by the ministry for expansion plans for Salt Spring schools.

When approval comes back construction of the classrooms will be carried out under board management, said school board chairman Charles Hingston.

# Down Through the Years with Driftwood

## Twenty years ago

**The election was over** and Social Credit won. But in Nanaimo and the Islands, Dave Stupich of the New Democratic Party edged out Earle Westwood by 30 votes. The vote in the islands gave the nod to Westwood while the Nanaimo end of the riding went for Stupich.

**The night was dark** and the driver drove the car over the curb where it stalled. He got out to see what the matter was and stepped into the sea. The curb was at the dock and the front end of the car was wavering over the water while the back end sat on dry land.

**The ladies group** set out to furnish the parsonage. The new kitchen range cost \$24 and a lounge was priced at \$4. The information came from the minute books of the Methodist Church Ladies' Aid. The date was 1913. The ladies were to furnish the parsonage for the minister, Reverent T. G. Griffiths and his wife. The church was located in Fulford.

## Fifteen Years Ago

**Flying service** between the islands and Vancouver or Victoria had been reduced for the winter months. Islanders could get to either city on two flights per day instead of the three flights which served customers during the summer. Customers were advised to check with Victoria Flying Service because the flight times posted were not necessarily when the planes flew.

**Vehicles parked** at the top of the hill at both Mayne and Pender had some islanders worried. The residents were concerned that the brakes might fail and the vehicles run down hill to endanger those using the ferries. Local MLA John Tisdalle had another worry. He had looked at some of the vehicles and had decided they might not be roadworthy.

Flowers graced Fulford Hall as the Salt Spring Garden Club held its fall showing. J. Wallis won top place in the show with four trophies. The trophy for dahlias, the T. W. Mouat Perpetual Challenge Trophy, was won by T. W. Mouat.

## Ten Years Ago

**Agricultural land** would be the subject of a public meeting in Ganges. Legislation setting out what was farm land and what wasn't had stirred up a debate and the Capital Regional Board decided to hold the meeting to air differences of opinion on the subject.

**The travellers** had returned. Art and Bob Simons returned to Salt Spring from a bicycling trip to Halifax. The journey took 40 days and required more than 1,152,000 turns of the pedals on their bikes. When asked why they made the trip, Art replied, "Why not?"

**Arctcraft '73** had attracted 2,564 paid visitors to Mahon Hall for the annual display of the handiwork of island craftsmen. The money gathered from the admission price was divided among the groups which make up the Community Arts Council. Plans for various events during the winter months were also being prepared.

**Warnings** that islanders would lose the right to guide their own destinies came from Capital Regional District chairman Jim Campbell. He was referring to the province's efforts to set up an islands trust to look after land use in the Gulf Islands. He urged people to protest to the government about the plans.

**The ladies** of the Pender United Church met for a meeting. They voted to send a \$50 donation to the Biafra food relief fund.

## Five Years Ago


**The Vesuvius-Crofton ferry** would take a rest while float

pontoons at both ends of the run were being replaced. Travellers would get from one island to the other by water taxi. Meanwhile, on Mayne, Village Bay would be closed to traffic for three days while the wharf was being repaired. Mayne Island travellers would have to take a water taxi from Miners Bay to Sturdies Bay on Galiano Island to get any place.

**A by-election** to fill the vacancy on the Capital Regional Board by the death of Salt Spring director Jim Bryce had been called for the end of November.

**The Queen of the Islands** would replace the *Bowen Queen* on the Fulford-Swartz Bay route. Travellers would have to adjust their pace due to the limited capacity of the *Queen of the Islands*. The ferry company was considering a stretch job on the *Bowen Queen* to increase the number of vehicles it could carry. The small boat would be in service for 30 days at least and could be on the run for up to six months.

# Wrong owner receives legal action threat

A mistake in identifying the owner of a property on Salt Spring Island almost led to legal action against a local resident.

Patricia Pierrt, 500 Mt. Belcher Heights, was informed in writing by building inspector J. Huntley July 26 that a stop work order had been placed on her property for carrying out construction without a valid building permit.

That letter was followed by one from Pearlman and Lindholm, solicitors for the Capital Regional District, advising that a mobile home placed at 529 Mt. Belcher Heights contravened the zoning bylaw and that facilities had been constructed without a permit.

The letter threatened legal proceedings if the mobile home had not been removed within one month.

It wasn't until nearly a month later that the authorities discovered they had the wrong property owner. Neither the legal description nor the street number belonged to the property on which Pierrt resides.

She had written to a number of officials, including MLA Hugh Curtis, to explain that the legal description was not on her property. It was Curtis who looked into the matter and confirmed that someone had slipped up.

Pierrt's letter pointed out that she had lived at the same location for three years and that "the only construction of any note was driving picture hangers into interior walls."

"...it behooves me to point out my contributing tax dollars could be better spent chasing rainbows for the proverbial pot of gold than having a junior bureaucrat spending upwards of \$5 a piece sending out six copies of a letter which imparts incorrect information," she wrote.

In a letter to *Driftwood* this week, Pierrt said she had appeared before a committee of the Capital Regional District early in September. One member, she said, suggested she had no right to bring a personal problem before the committee.

As the problem was the board's, she said, "where else would he

suggest I go?"

She said it was Curtis who first informed her that she wasn't to be removed from her home and that a letter apologizing for the mistake had later been sent to her by the regional district lawyers.

But, she noted, they were the only ones to contact her.

"What's with the manners of the

others? Common courtesy even in business is expected of public servants.

"These are not the people asking we taxpayers to support their position and petition, or are they?"

Pierrt said she hoped the information would assure Salt Spring Islanders that she was a law-abiding citizen.

## Marshall to replace McLeod

Mike Marshall, superintendent of schools for the Gulf Islands, will add another title to his office door.

Marshall has been named secretary-treasurer for the school district to replace Amy McLeod, whose resignation takes effect October 31.

The appointment entails a restructuring of the senior administration of the Gulf Islands School District.

"We're looking at hard times for administration costs," said school board chairman Charles Hingston last week. The double duty for Marshall is looked on as a means of cutting the administration costs of the school district. Those costs, in the Gulf Islands as well as elsewhere in the province, have been looked at critically and closely by the education ministry.

Under stipulations of the School Act, a school district must have a superintendent of schools and a secretary-treasurer. But nothing in the act says that the two positions cannot be held by the same person.

The appointment of Marshall to

both posts is being watched by other small school districts of the province, said a board official.
