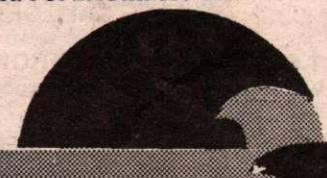

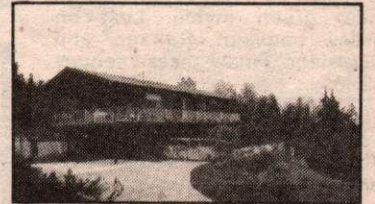

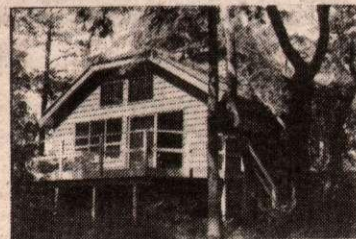

# Down Through the Years with Driftwood

## Twenty Years Ago

With voting on the school-expansion referendum set for Saturday, *Driftwood* ran the final front page editorial on the need for taxpayer approval of the scheme. If the vote is affirmative, a new high school would be built leaving the current school to become an elementary school.

**Harbour House Hotel** in Ganges had been sold to a group of businessmen from Vancouver. The Salt Spring landmark had been in operation since 1916. Col. D.G. Crofton would remain as managing director. Expansion of the facility was planned.

The school property at Ganges would grow by 7.1 acres if the school board got the go-ahead from voters. The added property was needed for location of the new high school plus expansion of the playground. The school board held options on the four properties which comprised the 7.1 acres.

**Qualifying rounds** for the Matson Cup at the Salt Spring Golf Club had been played and eight golfers qualified for the championship round. Mac Mouat took the Morris Cup and won the qualifying round with an 85 (net 73).

The **Fulford-Ganges competition** continued but this event was played on a snooker table. Grant Cruickshank and Nels Westin defended the honour of Ganges against Alex McManus Sr. and Thomas Duncan of Fulford. The combined age of the four pool players totalled 292 years.

## Fifteen Years Ago

**Island residents** were concerned about shortcomings in planning and zoning controls. The Capital Region was being petitioned to offer assistance to Salt Spring, North and South Pender as well as Mayne Island to draw up community plans so that planning could be controlled locally.

**Kanaka Road** would stay. The Gulf Islands School Board had asked the department of highways for permission to close the Salt Spring road which separated two parts of the school playground. When residents of the area complained, the proposal was turned down.

The **community hall** at Port Washington on Pender Island was the site of a delve-in. The event depicted the history of the Gulf Islands and children from the Pender school presented various displays. Winners of the ship drawing contest were Philip Derksen and Patti Long. The best nature exhibit was prepared by the team of Lorrie Ames, Lynette Kent and Eileen Grimmer. The best of the research collections belonged to Debbie Moore while Randy Moore and Debbie Auchterlonie had the best junior collections.

The **Mayne Island fun-walkathon** organizers received the first entry form. MP Tommy Douglas was the first to sign up for the competition.

## Ten Years Ago

The **Capital Region** bought 1.75 acres of land adjacent to Lady Minto Hospital on Salt Spring. The plan was to construct an intermediate and personal care facility for seniors. The proposal called for a 40-bed unit and the CRD would check costs before making a decision on the matter.

The **birthday party** marked the lady's 95th year. Sophie King had been born on Salt Spring in 1879 and three of her children joined in the celebration.

**Papajohn** reported from Saturna that the hall renovation crew, with a busy week behind them, would be pouring cement the next week. Tracy Pillsbury had drawn up the plans for the remodelled kitchen.

**Yvette Valcourt** of Salt Spring, was elected president of the Victoria diocese Catholic Women's League. She had gone to Fort Nelson to represent the diocese at the annual provincial convention.

The school at Mayne Island would get a flagpole. The Legion on that island had commented on the lack of the pole and the Lions Club looked into it. When school trustee Pearl Brau brought the matter to the Gulf Islands School Board, chairman Charles Baltzer agreed that a flagpole should be there.

**Sabot races** for children 13 years and under were run in Ganges Harbour. There were nine competitors representing five sailing clubs and Robbie Cannon of Salt Spring was the winner. Runner-up was Bobby James of Maple Bay while Alex Neish of Salt Spring came third.

The office of *Driftwood* moved again. The staff of the Gulf Islands weekly newspaper moved to the end of the yellow dirt road behind the Ganges liquor store. The first office had been on Fulford-Ganges Road

but had moved next door into the old liquor store. It remained there until the current move.

## Five Years Ago

**Greenwoods** had a piano, thanks to the volunteers of the Salt Spring Fire Department. A dozen of the firefighters delivered the piano and stayed to listen to various residents of the seniors' home play music on it.

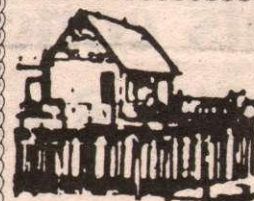
The **new fishing boat** in the Gulf Islands belonged to Harry Baines of Galiano Island. The 42-foot fibreglass vessel was launched earlier in the month. The troller-packer would join the Baines fleet of fishboats for the summer seasons in northern waters.

The **Saturna Island Lions Club** had finished work on the tennis courts at the school on that island. The courts could double for use in basketball, badminton as well as tennis. While the men worked, the Lady Lions supplied refreshments and food.

**Mahon Hall** on Salt Spring was spruced up. Ernie and Elma Rubright joined Hugh Cummings to paint and scrape and fix. The paint had been purchased by the Community Arts Council and the facelift was done in preparation for *Arcraft* 79.

The **Red Cross fund-raising drive** on Pender Island drew in \$1,095, reported co-ordinator Jean Hinton. She had nine canvassers going door-to-door to collect money during the drive.

The **industrial arts class** at the high school on Salt Spring would be constructing crow-proof garbage containers for Ganges. The Rotary Club had approached Lawrie Neish with the idea and he put the students to work making the aggregate concrete containers. There would be 16 of the containers at various places in the village.

# Saturna parents concerned over loss of teacher in September

Restraint translates into fewer teachers for Outer Islands schools in September and Saturna Island parents are concerned about the loss of a teacher.

There are currently three teachers at the 16-pupil school but one of them, classified as .3 full-time equivalent, goes on leave after the current school year ends and will not be replaced in September.

The other two teachers are classified as .7 fte and one fte. The one fte is the principal, Melanie Gaines, and she spends half her time on administrative duties.

Parents of Saturna children came to the meeting of the Gulf Islands School Board last week to express their concern.

The school contains classes from

kindergarten to Grade 7, but for most of the day one teacher handles all the classes. The loss of the .3 fte teacher means the loss of the music class as well as French lessons and a mathematics teacher.

Mike Marshall, superintendent of schools for the district, told the parents that Saturna was one of the few kindergarten to Grade 7 schools left in the province. Under the restraint program, many of the small schools such as Saturna have been closed.

He said he would be concerned if the teaching staff was only one teacher but it will be two teachers with help from parents. He also told the parents that he could not accept that the loss of the .3 teacher "would devastate your school."

Marshall has spent time with principals of the various Gulf Islands schools to determine the needs for teacher staffing in September. The four Outer Islands schools have a projected enrolment of 207 children for the next school year. Currently, there are 193 children enrolled.

The staffing for those schools has been set at 15.9 fte teachers compared to the 17.9 fte teachers now in classrooms. The biggest loser will be the Mayne Island school, which covers kindergarten to Grade 9, when the teacher complement will be reduced to five fte from 6.2 fte teachers there now.

On Salt Spring, meanwhile, the situation is reversed. Enrolment has been estimated at 506 pupils. The main difference will be the addition of the new school in Fulford plus two additional rooms at Fernwood School.

At Salt Spring Elementary, the enrolment is estimated to be 290 pupils with 16.3 fte teachers. Fernwood will have 188 pupils with 9.7 fte teachers while Fulford will house 130 pupils and 7.3 fte teachers.

Currently there are 22.6 fte teachers at Salt Spring Elementary and 8.3 fte at Fernwood. In September there will be 33.3 fte teachers at the three Salt Spring schools compared to the 30.9 fte teachers at the two schools now.

Enrolment across the district is estimated to rise to 1,175 pupils from the current 1,125. There are 75.95 fte teachers but staff across the district will be reduced to 73.3 fte teachers for September.

Gulf Islands Secondary School will grow to 360 pupils with a teaching staff of 23.7 fte from 343 now enrolled with 24.15 fte teachers.

# Police busy

While islanders on Salt Spring enjoyed Sea Capers weekend, Ganges detachment RCMP were busy.

The police patrols made 10 liquor seizures and one marijuana seizure. Several charges were laid against under-age drinkers and one individual was charged with drinking in a public place when he insisted upon consuming a beer in front of a police officer.

In addition, the patrols, in stopping vehicles, suspended the drivers' licences of four people for the 24-hour period.

# Grade 8 class to stay at Pender School

The Grade 8 class will stay at the Pender Island school.

The trustees of the Gulf Islands School Board agreed last week that the Grade 8 class should stay on the island. Parents of the children had requested the school board to allow the children to travel to Salt Spring for classes.

The facilities at the Gulf Islands Secondary School were considered by the parents to be better for the young scholars than were offered at the Pender junior secondary school.

But lack of space on the water taxi

which would bring students from the Outer Islands to school on Salt Spring ruled against the move.

Mike Marshall, superintendent of schools, said in explanation of the decision, "It is one of the thornier issues we have dealt with."

A year ago, the trustees had ruled that the Outer Islands junior secondary classes, Grades 8 and 9, would be centred at the Mayne school. Pender parents at that time threatened to send their children to Parklands secondary in Saanich rather than have them travel to Mayne.

When the school board announced earlier this year that a daily water taxi service for Outer Islands students to Salt Spring would begin in September, the parents had a change of heart.

Marshall noted, however, that a couple of the students were "exceptional" and efforts would be made to allow them to attend GISS. He said that each student requesting a transfer to GISS would be considered on an individual basis.

Meanwhile, efforts will be put into improving the Grade 8 course at the Pender school, he said.

# Water taxi

Charles Hingston, chairman of the school board, declined to reveal what was discussed.

The contract for water taxi service beginning in September was awarded on how the proposed service and schedule fit with the plans of the school district, superintendent of schools Mike Marshall told the meeting.

The school trustees wanted to have the secondary students ferried to and from Salt Spring Island each day. They were concerned about students from such islands as Saturna having to face a long day.

Jack Hughes of Gulf Islands Water Taxi, based in Ganges, won the contract with a bid of \$139,200. George's bid came in at \$118,500.

Hughes proposes to use four vessels to transfer children between islands. He based his tender on having the Saturna students leave Lyall Harbour at 7 am and return home at 3:15 pm.

George set his bid with times of departure from Lyall Harbour at 6:35 am and return at 3:50 pm. He proposed to use two boats for the service.
