

Fred Gilman hangs up scissors after 39 years

After 39 years of cutting hair, Fred Gilman has hung up his scissors for a different pursuit: "I intend to enjoy life," he said in an interview last week.

And that's what he and his wife, the former Nellie Schwagly, have been doing. The Salt Spring couple just returned from an ocean liner trip through the Caribbean and are making plans to tour north to Alaska.

Gilman began his snipping career in Vancouver when he took a course in barbering through the department of veteran's affairs in 1945. He returned to Duncan to work with his father and brothers in a barbershop there. But 15 years later, in 1961, Fred packed his tonsorial tools and moved to Salt Spring.

He opened his first barber shop in a small building close to Fulford-Ganges Road in Ganges. It stood on property which Salt Spring Lands now occupies. When the boat launching ramp was put in place, Gilman had to move because his shop was in the way.

The small shop is now behind the gas station and is used as a storage shed.

Over the years, Gilman occupied three other shops including the last one at the rear of the Valcourt Centre.

Gilman stopped counting the number of haircuts he has given but he estimates that in the first five years on the island, he snipped at 30,000 heads of hair. But since that time, the business has slowed down.

Gilman expressed appreciation for the loyalty of his customers

through the years.

"There's still a few around I used to do when I first came here," he explained. Included in that category is one individual who first went to Gilman for a haircut at the Duncan shop.

He reminisced about playing baseball on Salt Spring between 1930 and 1935. He played for a team from Sidney which came regularly to the island to go nine innings with the Salt Spring team.

Gilman paused and considered 1930. "It makes you realize somebody's getting older somewhere."

In the beginning, the cost of a haircut stood at \$1.25. Over in Duncan the cost was \$1.50. The price rose gradually with the passing years and he has been charging \$5 per cut for the past five years.

Gilman remembers another change brought on by the passage of 23 years. When he retired, his barber shop was the only business from 1961 which was still around or still

under the same ownership.

"I'm the last survivor," he said in reflection.

But even that has changed since Fred Gilman hung up his scissors.

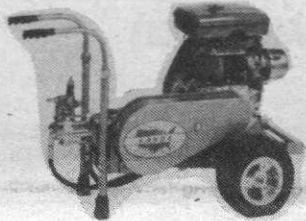

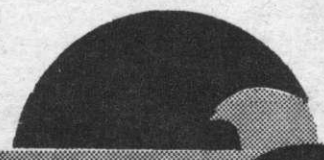

The engraving is the work of Galiano artist Renaldo Norden. The first print in the series was presented to Spanish King Juan Carlos, who has since agreed to be the patron of

the Galiano society.

The society presented the enlargement of the engraving to B.C. Ferries on June 15 to mark the beginning of the ferry corporation's 25th year of service to B.C.

As a followup, the society will be commissioning the construction of a replica of the *Sutil II*. Society president Edrie Holloway said that tenders for the project will be called soon.

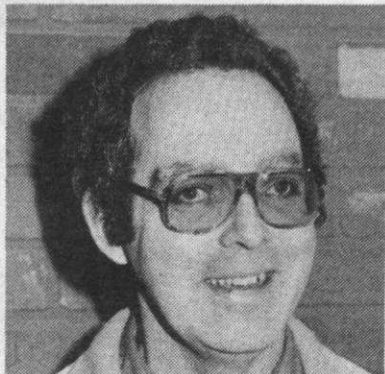

Down Through the Years with Driftwood

Twenty years ago

The voters of the Gulf Islands approved the high school construction referendum by a 71% majority. The vote also included a request to build a teacherage for Galiano Island. The referendum had been turned down twice by islanders before it had received approval in the latest vote. School board officials expected the high school construction in Ganges to begin shortly with a finish expected during the coming school year.

A Centennial Committee for Salt Spring's celebration of Canada's 100th year was chosen. Col. M.F. Peiler would head the committee with W. Thorburn as vice-chairman. The secretary would be M. H. Holmes with B. Lukas as treasurer. The committee would have about \$8,000 to spend on a project and called for ideas from island residents.

The 1964 graduates from the islands' high school posed for a class picture. Graduates included Terry Slingsby and Alan Gear. There were 30 members of the Grad 64 class.

The Lions Club installed its new executive at a dinner meeting held at the United Church Hall. Walter Mailey would be president for the year. District governor of the Lions Club, Nels Foster, led the installation ceremonies.

The Guild of Sunshine donated two books to the children's section of the Salt Spring library. The women's group also gave the library \$25 to help cover expenses.

The Gulf Islands School Board issued a financial statement for the previous year. The trustees had spent \$263,581.45 on education in the islands and showed a surplus of \$3,729.55.

Lady Minto Hospital joined three other hospitals in the area to form the Cowichan, Newcastle and the Islands Health Council. H. Hoffman, administrator of Lady Minto, was selected as secretary of the organization. The council was formed to co-ordinate hospital activity and planning on a regional basis.

Fifteen years ago

Fulford ferry wharf should be moved to Isabella Point, said the Salt Spring Chamber of Commerce. The highways department planned to repair the facility but the chamber urged relocation. Opinion was that the usefulness of the wharf at Fulford was limited.

The flags in Centennial Park in Ganges had been stolen again. In the previous two years, the flags had gone missing five times.

Walkers were invited to Mayne Island for a fun-walkathon. The course had been designed for a 10-mile hike and walkers would carry money pledges for each mile completed. The money would be used to aid the Mayne Island Fall Fair.

Papajohn reported from Saturna that the floor of the Community Hall was cleaned and waxed. The

project had been put off several times until Walter Warlow and Rev. J. Dangerfield decided to do the job.

The Galiano Ladies Service Club ended another season of community service. President Mrs. I.A. Murphy hosted a tea party for members at the Galiano Hall. The final meeting of the season was held at the home of Mrs. Flo Bellhouse.

The Hotel Vesuvius was the scene of a 25th anniversary dinner for the Catholic Women's League on Salt Spring. President Mrs. L. Yzerman welcomed guests from the provincial and diocese organizations. Tribute was paid to Mrs. George St. Denis and Mrs. W. Jameski who had been with the CWL since its beginning.

Mouat's Trading Company was planning to fill a section of foreshore near the store in Ganges. R.M. Toynbee explained that the area, from behind the store and the bank towards Lower Ganges Road north of the restaurant, would be developed for commercial use and also for a parking lot.

The road from Fulford to Vesuvius on Salt Spring Island would be reconstructed. The province had allocated \$200,000 to bring the highway up to standard after the severe winter had done its damage.

The annual July 1 lamb barbecue at Saturna Beach on that island was in the final stages of planning. Organizers were planning an active day for the 20th year of the event.

Ten years ago

The proposed international park, which would include the Gulf Islands in Canada and the San Juan Islands in well as Point Roberts in the U.S., was put on hold by the Canadian government. B.C. was in the process of creating the Islands Trust for the Gulf Islands and the international park was premature, stated the office of the prime minister.

Hugh Curtis, Progressive Conservative representative for Saanich and the Islands, announced that he might join a united opposition party to defeat the New Democrats under Premier Dave

Barrett. Another option open to him, said Curtis, was to join the Social Credit. There were only two P.C.'s in the provincial legislature.

An all-candidates meeting in Ganges drew the four candidates for the federal election. Tommy Douglas of the New Democrats, Liberal Ray Kane, Progressive Conservative Don Taylor and Ernie Knott of the Communists addressed a meeting of 75 islanders. Each was seeking the seat for Nanaimo-Cowichan-The Islands in the July 8 federal vote.

The Mayne Island Wine-Arts Club held a seasonal wind-up party at the home of Al and Joan Drummond. Chairman Roy Crispin organized a smorgasbord committee to feed the members who attended.

Two young men lost their lives while swimming in Cusheon Lake. A third youth was pulled from the water and rushed to Lady Minto Hospital for treatment. One of the victims was from Vancouver and the other came to the island from Toronto.

Five years ago

A Salt Spring couple were taken to Lady Minto Hospital suffering from burns after their 22-foot boat exploded and burned at Vesuvius Bay. Mr. and Mrs. Art Hanson had their boat, the Rambler, tied to the dock while trying to correct problems with the engine. When they cast off and were about 100 yards from shore, fire broke out. Rescuers were Carl Scott and Doug Wilson, both of Crofton. Their boat had been tied to the wharf and they went to help as soon as the fire began.

B.C. Ferries apologized for delays and schedule foul-ups on the Swartz Bay to Fulford run. The Bowen Queen and the Mayne Queen had been stretched to increase capacity but were experiencing problems. Ferry company spokesman Bill Bouchard explained that many of the problems had been sorted out and things would be back to normal as soon as possible.
