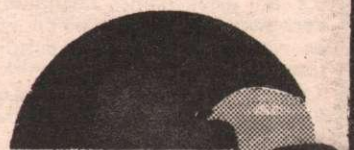

# Down Through the Years with Driftwood

## Twenty years ago

Fire gutted a lumber yard in Fulford on Salt Spring. Vic Ames was awakened in his home across the road from the lumber yard by the glow and noise of the flames. Prompt action by the volunteers of the fire brigade kept the flames from spreading to St. Mary's Church. Fire Chief Fred Donaghy said everything in the lumber yard was lost in the fire.

The gathering of people at Harbour House honoured Reta Oulton. She was retiring after teaching at Salt Spring schools for many years. Oulton began to teach on the island in 1938 at the Divide School. Invitations had gone out to 1,197 of her former students.

The Beaver Point bean supper had been cancelled earlier in the year because many of the lady organizers had been suffering from influenza. But with everyone in good health, the bean supper would be staged July 25, but as a picnic. If the weather did not co-operate, the supper would be moved indoors at Beaver Point Hall.

Lawn bowling was being organized on Salt Spring. Ed Stephenson of Ganges had been given 16 lawn bowls and the Fulford Athletic Club was in the process of setting up the games. An ordinary lawn, bumps and all, would suffice if the area measured 100 by 15 feet.

Plans for the Fulford beef barbecue were being made by the Fulford Athletic Club as well as the Fulford Hall Committee. During the meeting when plans were discussed, Jack Roland was re-elected president of the Athletic Club. Other members of the executive would be Gavin Reynolds, vice-president; Rosemary Brigden, secretary; and Mrs. A. House, treasurer.

The Coast Guart boat Racer raced up Ganges Harbour and the large wake caused damage to several wharves. Jim Hedgecock, the BA agent, was fueling a boat at the time and the waves knocked the float out of position. Fred Howard was booming logs but the wash mangled his efforts.

## Fifteen years ago

The May Queen of Salt Spring Island, Nicola Toynbee, would be going to the Pacific National Exhibition in Vancouver. The island's chamber of commerce would sponsor the young lady in the Mis PNE contest. Secretary of the chamber, June Knowles, would accompany her to the big event.

The volunteers of the Salt Spring fire brigade were called to two fires during the week. Fire destroyed the home of Phil Marcoux despite the efforts of the firefighters to contain it. The second fire, in Valcourt's lumber yard, was quickly brought under control.

Telephone service to Saturna Island was disrupted. When the emergency crew checked the underwater cable from Mayne Island, they discovered a break in the line. They spliced an additional 150 feet of cable to the line and service was restored within two days of the breakdown.

Papajohn reported from Saturna that July 12 had been celebrated "well but not wisely". He listed visitors to Saturna including Eddie Albert (Mr. Green Acres) and his wife, mignon Margaret. The Alberts had chartered a boat with the hope of catching some fish.

The Community Club on Pender Island met at Jack Orton's home to talk about a problem. Some people were dumping garbage over South Pender bluffs. The department of highways covered the mess with fill

but the dumping continued. A "No Dumping" sign which had been posted at the spot was also dumped.

Galiano Island golfers won the Bambrick Inter-Island Cup. The final round of the three-round competition had been played on Galiano and the island team ended the series with 57 points. Second place went to Pender with 49.5 points. Salt Spring trailed with 36.5. Glenn Woodley of Salt Spring presented the trophy to Arthur Plett of the Galiano team.

## Ten years ago

Small fish came to the salmon derby on Salt Spring sponsored by the Rod and Gun Club. Marshall Heinekey took top spot with an eight pounder while Carol Jackson was first in the women's section with a 2 lb., 14 oz. salmon. The junior section was taken by Keith Winter with a 1 lb., 9 oz. fish.

The Fall Fair on Mayne Island would be officially opened by B.C. Premier Dave Barrett. The exhibits, games and other events would be held August 17.

Papajohn reported from Saturna that island voters had to use the back door to the Community Hall to cast a ballot. Workers were repairing things at the hall and Harvey Jensen and his crew directed people to the rear entrance.

The Garden Club of Mayne Island hosted a smorgasbord for Jack and Dorothy James of Salt Spring. The two well-known gardeners were on Mayne Island to offer hints and tips to gardeners.

A one-man art show at Central on Salt Spring had grown. Pat Wright, the wildlife artist, was displaying her work when Charlotte Keeping joined the show. Another island artist, Emily Crosby, later joined the first two in the project.

The Fire Hall in Ganges neared completion. Lyle Brown was cleaning up the site and installing a garden. The paved traffic area was being finished with curbs.

The Anglican parishioners on Salt Spring would be putting on their annual Country Fair. The event would be held in the courtyard of the high school and would feature the sale of goods, an orchestra as well as contests for domestic skills.

The Lions Club of Salt Spring welcomed four students from Japan who would be on the island for six weeks. The students, chosen for the trip by Lions Clubs of four Japanese cities, would be living with families while on Salt Spring.

## Five years ago

The lottery grant of \$75,000 to the Salt Spring Golf and Country Club to pay for an irrigation system was causing questions on the island and in the provincial legislature. Eileen Dailly, NDP, asked local MLA and provincial secretary Hugh Curtis to reconsider the grant. Ellen Bennett of the North Salt Spring Waterworks said the Golf Club officials had not approached the water district about the scheme.

Visitors to Salt Spring were on the increase. Mabel MacPherson of the tourist bureau in Ganges reported that more than 1,700 visitors had signed the guest book. That figure was up by about 600 from the previous year, she said.

Magic Lake on Pender Island contained Eurasian milfoil and residents of the area were worried. Doug Kenyon, president of the Magic Lake Estates Property Owners Society, told a meeting of the group that Buck Lake, prime source of water for the subdivision, was not polluted but the situation required constant attention.

Lady Minto Hospital Auxiliary gave \$500 bursaries to two graduates of Gulf Islands Secondary School. Auxiliary president Margo Laing presented Elaine Patterson and Donna McFadyen each with a cheque to help further their education in health.

The John McMahon Playground was opened on Saturna Island. Marie "Granmarie" McMahon cut the ribbon to open the playground named for her husband, Papajohn. The Saturna Lions Club had built the play area and president Don McLellan thanked everyone for their contributions to the project.

Lady Minto Hospital was in good financial shape, said administrator Malcolm Pinteau. The Gulf Islands health facility had rung up an \$80,000 deficit for the previous year and would need at least \$55,000 from the province to cover it. Health minister Bob McClelland had announced that the province would pick up deficits to help hospitals make ends meet.

The meeting devoted most of its time to the organization of a campaign and the naming of duties.

The new candidate started out immediately on his campaign. He spoke at a meeting in Crofton on

Saturday evening.

Coleman is the president of the riding Liberal association. He and his wife Barbara make their home in Duncan with their three sons.

## 70 turn up for hospice meeting

A hospice program helps the terminally ill cope with dying and the living cope with death.

### Beaches for people not dogs

Dogs at the Cusheon Lake beach are a danger to swimmers and a hazard for what they leave behind, a Salt Spring woman claimed last week.

She explained that while her daughter was swimming at the beach recently a man appeared accompanied by a dog. The man entered the water and called for the dog to follow. But when the man ducked under the water, the dog became confused and began to approach other swimmers in the area looking for its master.

The 10-year-old girl was one of the swimmers and when the dog approached her, it scratched her on the leg.

The woman also complained that the dogs would relieve themselves on the beach and no one would clean up the mess.

Cusheon beach is a pleasant place to swim, she said, but dog owners who bring their pets to the beach are making it less than pleasant.

Under a Capital Region bylaw, dogs are not allowed to run at large. The bylaw describes a dog to be "running at large where it is not under control by being in direct or continuous charge of a person who is competent to control it; or securely fastened so that it is unable to roam."

On Salt Spring, 70 people gathered at St. George's Church Hall last Wednesday to hear about the Bessie Dane Hospice Memorial.

The program is in place and the meeting was called to find volunteers for it.

Bessie Dane died in January. During her last months, friends sat with her and talked with her just as she had done for others when they were dying.

Pat Desbottes, Brenda Davies and Nell Bushby were the friends and Dane urged them to help others who were dying alone.

Here estate went to the Bessie Dane Fund and the hospice on Salt Spring was under way. The three women went to Victoria to check on the hospice there to determine what parts of it could be modified for Salt Spring.

One of the speakers at the meeting last Wednesday was Jo Dixon of the Victoria Hospice. She explained that the hospice was composed of many people: the doctor, the nurses, a social worker and the volunteers.

Hospice, she said, was active compassionate care for the

terminally ill when that illness has gone beyond control. It involves the hospice team, relatives of the patient and the community.

The hospice on Salt Spring currently has one trained volunteer working with the dying. To date 20 volunteers have come forward to be trained to help begin the program. Each training session lasts eight hours.

Support for the program was expressed by Diane Horovatin, director of nursing at Lady Minto Hospital, and Dr. Jerry Nestman speaking for the physicians.

Paul Jones of Goodman Jones Funeral Home explained the need for help for the family of the dying as part of the hospice program.

People often need help to cope with the death of loved ones, he told the meeting, and that need can last for up to two years after the event.

By the end of the meeting, the enthusiasm of those in attendance marked a solid development for the Bessie Dane Hospice Memorial. Anyone interested in joining or contributing a donation should contact one of the three organizers.
