

# Society helps handicapped reach potential

There are 31 special people on Salt Spring. They are special because they are a small minority. They are the mentally handicapped people who are helped on a daily basis by the staff of the achievement centre, one of the major programs of the Salt Spring Community Society.

Under the leadership of Louise Ducet, 10 full-time and part-time employees, as well as a corps of dedicated volunteers, spend many, many hours on a one-to-one basis helping the handicapped to live more meaningful lives within their individual capacities.

"They are a dedicated staff who, in addition to their daily work hours, give much of their spare time to their tasks," said Ducet. "And without the tremendous effort of the volunteers we wouldn't be much more than a baby-sitting agency."

One of the facets of the work of the achievement centre is the tutoring program conducted by six volunteers. At the moment they have seven students, some of whom are learning to read and others are being taught how to count money. Learning about personal hygiene is also part of the tutoring.

"It is educational, with a practical application to help improve individual lifestyles," Doucet explained. "As an example, when teaching about the value of money and counting it, the student is given a specific budget figure for an imaginary shopping trip. Then, assisted by using food store advertisements, (he or she) selects the items required, determines the cost and at the same time stays within the budget figure. It takes a lot of time and a lot of patience but the reward is in the light of delight and understanding of the expression of the student."

When individuals first come to the centre, a program is worked out for them in consultation with their parents, relatives or guardians, and they are integrated into the overall operation of the centre in the program which is best suited to them. The programs run from 10 am to 3 pm five days a week, and transportation is provided to and from their homes, if required.

Four years ago the Achievement Centre introduced an eight-month training program for people interested in working with the mentally handicapped. The course is limited to three participants. To date nine people have graduated from the course and all have found employment — most of them with the local achievement centre.

One of the graduates of the training program is Don McEacher who supervises the woodworking shop at the Community Society's home for handicapped on McGoldrick Place. Each day, he spends five or more hours helping and guiding an enthusiastic — if small — group of handicapped people in the basics of woodworking with both hand and power tools.

As in all the projects of the centre the objective is to give the individual a sense of accomplishment, and of being part of a meaningful program.

Many of the articles produced in the workshop — such as hanging seats for children, puppets and walking canes — are sold through the centre's Clothing and Craft Store which opened last spring in Ganges.

"It is a moment of intense pride for the individual when his work is

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# Concerns

Sir,  
About 225 residents of the Duncan area attended the meeting last week concerning the Crofton mill, with a panel of experts who repeated much of what was said here last May. Renate Kroesa of Greenpeace was back from the European conference on dioxins and gave details on how the European markets are switching to support a dioxin-free environment. The industry rep just waffled on remarks and questions; the federal rep didn't show up.

Questions from the floor reflected a wide variety of genuine concerns. The five women sitting behind me were there because each had lost a baby or relative from cancer and were wondering what

the connection was. (Apparently 20 people living within two miles of the mill have died of cancer.) Efforts are being made to study their situation.

The following day, the overall pulp and paper mill situation was discussed at a coalition meeting in Vancouver. It seems there are two types of mills; type A empties into fresh water lakes and rivers; type B, the coastal mills just dumps everything into coastal waters.

Jacques Cousteau apparently predicted that this whole area, with six mills emptying into it, was

destined to become 'like a sewer.' Terry Jacks, advocate for West Vancouver and the Squamish area said that on a given day you'll find 60 fishermen fishing for Vancouver restaurants in Howe Sound, off the outfall from the Port Mellon mill, which registers 33 times the safe level of dioxin. And the Department of Health and Welfare posts no signs.

This also raises the question of the Vietnamese, who clean these dioxin-filled beaches for clams for their restaurants, with no enforcement.

At the end of the month, the pulp and paper mill industry will be meeting in Vancouver. We'll see what transpires.

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## your garden

by chris schmah



It's almost too good to be true, but the weather over the past week has been more reminiscent of early September than the second week of October. With Thanksgiving happily tucked under our belts, and the autumn colours just starting to show, we still have plenty of sunshine and warm temperatures to make working out in the garden a truly pleasurable event.

Last week's article focused on aspects of the care and cultivation of fall bulbs, and this time around I would like to offer some suitable bulb selections for various special sites, or problem situations.

The first and most problematic bulb selections are the deer-proof or deer-resistant choices. The Alliums, members of the onion family, have a disagreeable flavour for deer, and are represented by a few blooming beauties including: *A. moly luteum*, with its late spring, golden yellow blossom head; *A. Karataviense*, showing a rich pink coloration; *A. neapolitanum*, presenting creamy white blooms; *A. giganteum* with its three-to-four-foot-high ball of small mauve flowers; and several others worthy of consideration, too.

The fall-blooming colchicums, which look like crocus flowers, have been in bloom for several weeks, and come in singles and doubles with shades of pink or white being available. Colchicums are poisonous, so they have a built in deer repellent. Glory-in-the-snow (*Chionodoxa*), in all of its species and colours, puts forth its delicate, starry blooms early in the spring and naturalizes well in rockeries, borders, under trees and shrubs in sun or partial shade. *Camassia cusikii* and other species will bear their rich purple and blue flower spikes in inhospitable clay soils that are saturated with water all winter, and dried hardpan all summer.

All Crocus species and varieties are deer-resistant, sometimes being sampled, but their early, delightful showing is worth taking a chance for. The yellow-blossomed winter aconites (*Eranthis*) will give a cheery showing in February and early March, doing especially well in woodland or orchard settings. The Fritillaria genus with its *F. imperialis* giving golden or orange flower clusters in early spring, *F. persica* with its blackish purple bloom spike, and *F. meleagris* with its purple and white checkered, nodding blooms, all contain something disagreeable which repels deer.

Snowdrops (*Galanthus*) in single and double forms give a delightful showing so early in the spring that they often push their way up through the snow. Later in the season, the summer snowflake (*Leucojum aestivum*) gives a taller, but similar-looking blossom which is also deer-resistant. The grape hyacinths (all *Muscari* species) and the *Scilla* genus (bluebells) are all deerproof and delight the eye when planted around the bases of trees and shrubs, or set out in woodland settings to naturalize in drifts.

Another bulb, actually planted out in the spring but also considered deerproof, is the Mexican shellflower (*Tigridia*). The final, largest and undoubtedly most-used group is the *Narcissus* genus including both narcissi and daffodils, with its wide range of blooming times, heights and colours in various combinations, flower styles and with fragrance too. While there may be an addition or two, and a couple may fall victim to deer sampling, that essentially is the deerproof list.

Another list which needs to be dealt with is one of bulbs for moist or seasonally wet soils. A good one for naturalizing along stream margins and heavy-textured soils is *Fritillaria meleagris*. For more open areas, *Camassia cusikii* is suitable, as is *Narcissus "Fortune"*. For the wet rockery and small scale, *Narcissus bulbocodium* will give a delightful showing in mid-spring. Summer snowflake will also do well in seasonally wet soils, both in sun and partial shade. Many of the narcissi and colchicums will tolerate a wet, heavy clay soil which stays saturated most of the winter, but dries off in summer (provided the water isn't stagnant).

For dry soils which won't get any irrigation during the growing season, a few selections are worthy of consideration. Aconites, anemones (blanda and St. Brigid), colchicums, crocus, cyclamen, daffodils, *Galanthus* (snowdrops), bluebells (*Scilla*), Oxalis, Iris (rhizome and bulbous types), hyacinths, tulips and narcissi will all flourish and flower provided they receive sufficient water during the spring growing and blooming period.

For shaded locations the list is as follows: anemones, cyclamen, crocus, erythronium (fawn lilies and trout lilies), summer snowflake (*Leucojum*), *Zantedeschia* (calla lilies), oxalis, chionodoxa, winter aconites (*Eranthis*), snowdrops (*Galanthus*), bluebells (*Scillas*), some narcissi, lily of the valley (*Convolvulus*) and for high shade situations with lots of room, hardy lilies (*Lilium*).

For all situations and problem areas, a selected bulb should be planted on a trial basis, and if blooming and growth continue then further plantings may be considered. If, on the other hand, the bulb fails to make a showing of flower the second year, or if growth slows, and vigour drops, then lift and move the bulb during its dormant season to a less severe location.

## Education value eyed

The scope and direction of teacher education should be studied in B.C., the Gulf Islands School District says.

Meeting on Saturna Island last week, trustees responded to a recommendation by the Royal Commission on Education in B.C. by calling for a study on the value of training given to teachers.

The Royal Commission study recommended that all teachers in the province hold a bachelor's degree. Local trustees, however, noted there is no evidence outlining what the degree accomplishes, and nothing that says holding one makes a person a better teacher.

Board chairman David Eyles told *Driftwood* there is even some dissatisfaction among teachers — and student teachers — about the value of the training they received en route to earning their degrees.

"So we feel a study should be done, to make it clear what is being accomplished and how valuable the training is," Eyles said.

The school district will ask its provincial body — the B.C. School Trustees Association (BCSTA) — to propose a study to an education ministry council following up the recommendations of the Royal Commission report. The BCSTA is a member of that ministry council.

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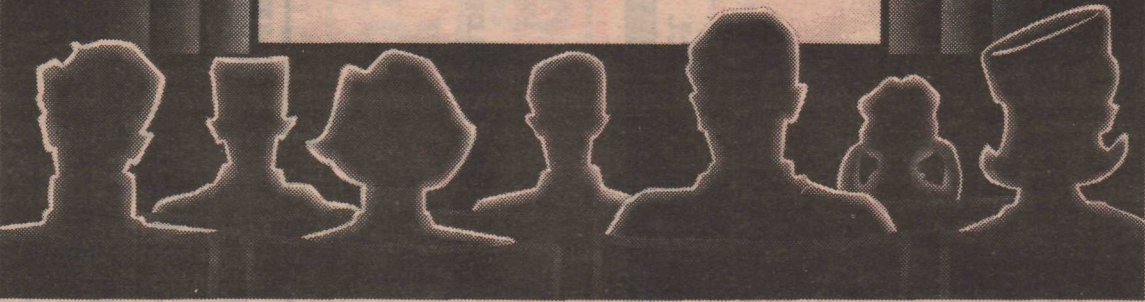
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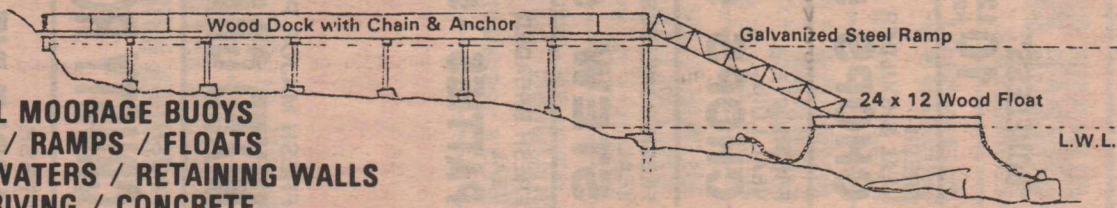
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# Atlin visit gives view of northern settlement

 An island of water entirely surrounded by land. That's Atlin, British Columbia, so far north that you never clearly establish in your mind whether you are in B.C. or the Yukon. Not that it matters too much, for they have a lot in common.  
 Atlin was the golden magnet that drew many a miner and many a prospector from the rich creeks of the Klondike. And again, like

the Yukon, modern methods of delving for gold have taken over and in both segments of golden Canada only the Cat is King.  
 I was in Atlin for a brief holiday to mark the end of summer. With two companions I meandered through the town that is striving to shed its burden of ghosts and gold rush and to find a new prosperity.  
 Everybody has heard of Atlin. Politically, it is a tale of tragedy. Disappointment and death have

haunted its political life. Within a decade the small northern community has been represented in Victoria by a native Indian, Larry Guno, and by a man who crossed the floor from the New Democratic opposition benches to the warmth of the government side, Al Passerall. The tragic death of Passerall established the constituency in the minds of British Columbians who might well have otherwise believed the

community a part of the Yukon. Historically, it burst into fame and fortune when gold was discovered, at the close of the 19th Century, among the nearby creeks. The discovery gave its name to a prosperous town, Discovery, a few miles from Atlin. All that remains of that prosperous town are one or two derelict shacks and an impressive monument of bare gravel. Discovery was born of Pine Creek gold and when Pine Creek

yielded no more, Discovery lived no more.

Tribute to that forgotten town may be found among the buildings of Atlin, where a number of homes and stores were brought and set up.

Why go to Atlin?

Some years ago the Government Agent at Duncan was Lyman Sands. After making various moves, from agency to agency, he was stationed at Atlin. Its remote

location and its struggle for survival were familiar to Sands. He was born in Atlin and it was like coming home.

We were all linked to Atlin by its former government official. For several years I was in the habit of having lunch with Sands on Wednesdays in Duncan. My old air force "oppo," George Jessup, worked with Sands as assessor and at one stage of his career Lyman was agent in Fort St. John, where

my brother, Laurence, has lived for a quarter of a century. And we all wanted to find what made him tick so far away from at least two of us.

Driving in from Skagway, in Alaska, you turn right at Jake's Corners and you drive about 75 kilometres along a largely dirt road before you reach a vast lake with a mountain rising from its waters. That's Atlin.

Having driven in on that road

you study the route because it's the only way out. It is the Atlin Road, for it leads to no other place.

There are no paved streets in the community, but it has never known such highways. Road repairs are strictly by grader. Winter snows are cleared by the same machine and summer dust is laid by water tanker.

A visitor might start by listing what Atlin doesn't offer. The list would be extensive, but a

community of some 500 people does not merit too big a list of amenities. After all, you can buy all the food you could need and most of what you might want. General stores are available and clothing is right there on the shelf. And if you need something that isn't stocked in the community, you tear up the dirt road as far as Whitehorse, which is the local big town.

# Insight into mining history found in Atlin

Then the visitor would have to start listing what Atlin does offer.

It offers the lake which gave the town its name. The native Tlingit Indians called it "Great Water" and the name has stayed.

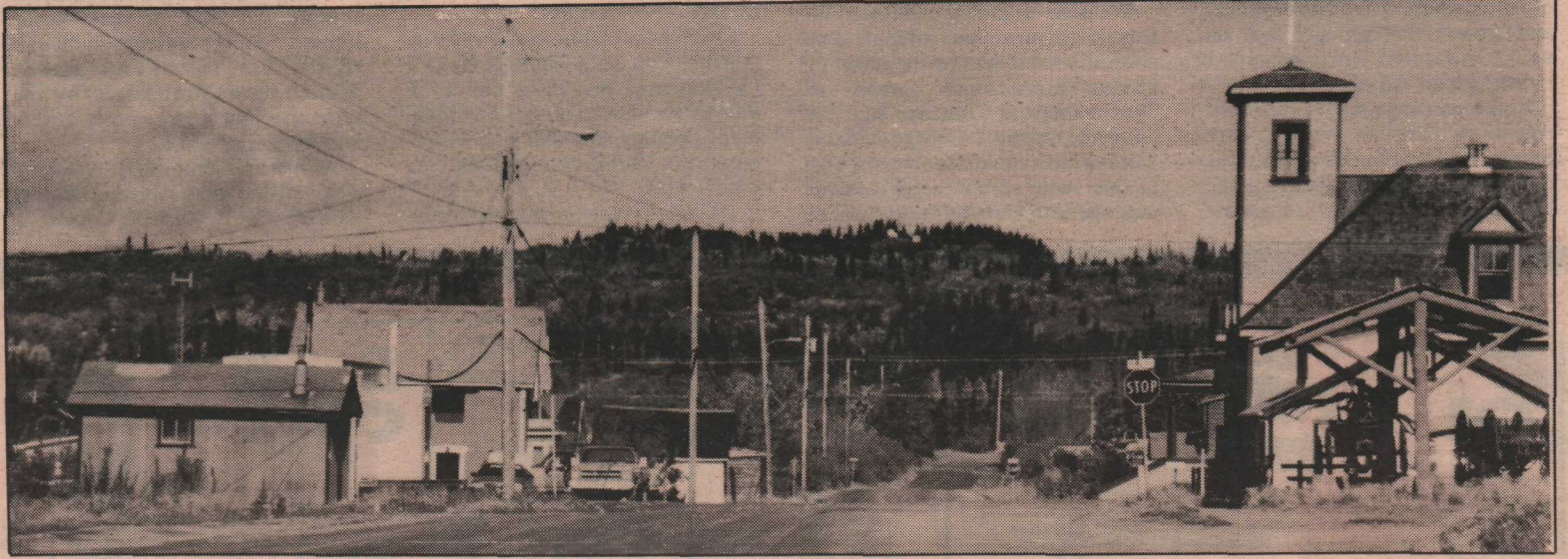
Its main traffic until the end of the last century was that of the Tlingits hunting caribou. The change came with a party of prospectors, headed by Fritz Miller in 1899. Miller had already found gold in Pine Creek but had run out of supplies and returned to Juneau. He later told the Atlin *Claim* newspaper that he had taken \$120 in gold the first day he operated his sluice box.

The lake, today, offers fishing and boating. The country provides for hunting and the short summer will produce a wide range of crops. Incidentally, we found rhubarb growing everywhere. It's a weed!

Most interesting was a visit to the gold mines and to an insight into mining history. Where once a lone miner was digging a shaft down to the gold-bearing gravel, there are giant bulldozers working in teams to take off the overburden and reach the precious metal which has lain hidden for countless years. The golden gravel is loaded onto belly dumpers and hauled to the processing equipment at a central point.

We watched the great shovels moving a creek bed and we watched two of a dozen belly dumpers lumbering over the ground. It was a small mine but it employed a lot of people and a pile of equipment.

The most interesting from the standpoint of an onlooker was the "glory-hole" where machines had dug down to the gold. One side of the deep hole was almost vertical and in the wall could be seen the shaft of a mine dug nearly a century ago when gold was won only by the sweat of the brow.



*Atlin retains historic flavour*

Never had that early miner imagined that one day his handiwork would lie open to the light of day.

I learned, in Atlin, the meaning of a "placer" mind. It is a Spanish term which has been lawfully anglicized by its use in the United States mining regulations. Placer gold is found in the form of metal. It is not dug as ore and requires no smelting. I expect every reader knew that, but I didn't.

A museum in Atlin preserves early pictures and records as well as a variety of tools and equipment from the quite recent past. The museum also displays a large range of ancient machinery salvaged from various mining operations. Unfortunately, there is little keen interest evident in renovating any of the old tractors and bulldozers, motors, steam shovels and the like.

I enjoyed Atlin and I could visit there again, but the long winters would scare me off. I'm too spoiled by creature comforts to hanker after cold winters again. Yet I can

see the attraction and even the challenge of a community that has seen its thousands of residents shrink to a hundred or so and is now once again on the rise.

Incidentally, we enjoyed a very pleasant stay in the former home of a successful miner. The Noland House was the home of a miner of that name. When he found gold he left home. The house has been modernized and brought into the 21st Century.

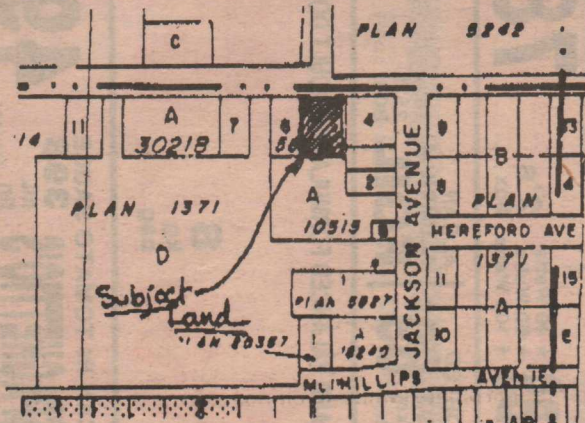

selected to be displayed in the store," McEacher said.

The Clothing and Craft Store is another training outlet. Operated by a full-time employee of the centre, assisted by some of the handicapped people, it provides, in many cases, a first-time exposure to life in the community.

"They gain a measure of self-confidence to a point where a few of them go to a nearby restaurant for coffee break by themselves," Doucet said. "It may seem a small thing but it is something they never would have been capable of doing before they became participants in the Activity Centre programs.

Doucet is concerned about the future of the store. "It is not yet self-supporting and is still being subsidized by the Community Society," she said. "If things don't improve we are going to have to look pretty closely at its operation. We can't afford a continuous subsidy for it."

In addition to the various training programs it conducts, the Activity Centre provides a number of recreational activities such as bowling, swimming, an exercise program, some camping and special outings. There are also music and theatre classes on a weekly basis.

Much of the financing for the operation of the Activity Centre comes through the provincial ministry of social services and housing, the local parks and

recreation commission (which finances the bowling program), from the sales of services and goods produced by the participants, and by many private donations.

"However, there is always a need for more funding," Doucet said. "We are hopeful that some of it will come from the grants the Community Centre will receive through its participation in the United Way of Greater Victoria."

This will be the second year residents of Salt Spring have been given the opportunity to contribute to the United Way and, through it, support the widespread community services provided by the Community Society. This year's solicitation will be in the form of an insert in the October 12 issue of *Driftwood*. In addition, personal letters will be mailed to 1,100 residents of the island.
