In Porlier Pass

Island Trustees express concern about dumping waste in the sea

Trustees at the Islands Trust Council meeting held on Saturna Island last week agreed to endorse a visit of one of its members to Department of Fisheries and Oceans in Ottawa.

The motion was made following discussions lead by Galiano trustee Margaret Griffiths, who expressed concern over waste dumping in Porlier Pass.

Griffiths said she has received numerous phone calls on the deteriorating condition of local waters and suggested that Dumpsite 32 be removed from the federal register.

"The area where they're dumping is too close to Galiano, it's too shallow, and it's an important fishing ground," the trustee explained. Islanders recently became aware that the dumping of materials in coastal waters has been approved of by Environment Canada for many years.

When the Canadian Environmental Protection Act went into affect in September, 1988, regulations stated that dumping schedules had to be published in local newspapers.

As a result, dumping practices along the west coast have been given a much higher profile.

About one million cubic metres of waste is dumped annually along the west coast. This figure does not include dredged materials from the Fraser River which are dumped to provide channel maintenance on the river.

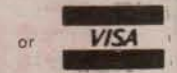



Before a dumping permit is issued by Environment Canada, the company seeking the permit is required to provide results of scientific analysis of the material.

"The company takes its material to commercial lab where the materials are identified and the lab report is included with the sample," Hal Nelson of Environment Canada told *Driftwood*.

The likelihood of a commercial lab falsifying information on lab results is extremely remote, he added.

Environment Canada reviews the application and lab information. If results indicate there are no chemicals in the material, the application is approved.

"What we look out for is dioxin or 2378 TCDD, which is found around pulp mills and which are a result of the effluent itself," Nelson said.

In two samples out of six submitted by Fletcher Challenge, traces of 2378 TCDD were found. Consequently, Environment Canada cannot approve the company's application to dump at the Porlier Pass dumpsite.

There are several dump sites along the west coast. They include sites at Campbell River, Cape Mudge and at Comox as well as south at Point Grey and in Haro Strait. The Porlier Pass dumpsite is a misnomer, Nelson said.

"The Porlier Pass dumpsite is located three and a half miles out into the Georgia Strait from Porlier Pass and has a depth of 200 metres," Nelson explained, "It shouldn't have been called Porlier Pass."

Until 12 years ago, there was a dumpsite in Stuart Channel near Crofton but the site was closed when shrimp fishermen complained.

Some companies are not required to seek approval each time they wish to dispose of industrial waste. MacMillan Bloedel has a long-term permit while Fletcher Challenge is required to update its permit.

Monthly meeting


