## Sea Capers bash is set in motion

Sea Capers organizers promise another weekend of land and nautical fun as they gear up for Salt Spring's 12th annual initiation to summer.

More than a dozen activities are planned for this year's Sea Capers which opens with a dance at the Fulford Community hall on Friday, June 15 and finishes with a windsurfing regatta in Vesuvius the following Sunday afternoon.

Between 4,000 and 5,000 people generally turn out for Sea Capers — a remarkable number considering the event is only promoted on the island and the majority of participants come from Salt Spring.

"It's the biggest and best event on the island," says organizer Lynn Richardson, adding the goal is to bring people together and have fun.

While there will be some slight variations in the activities this year — including a revival of the boat-build-

ing competition — the agenda will closely resemble that of the past 12 years.

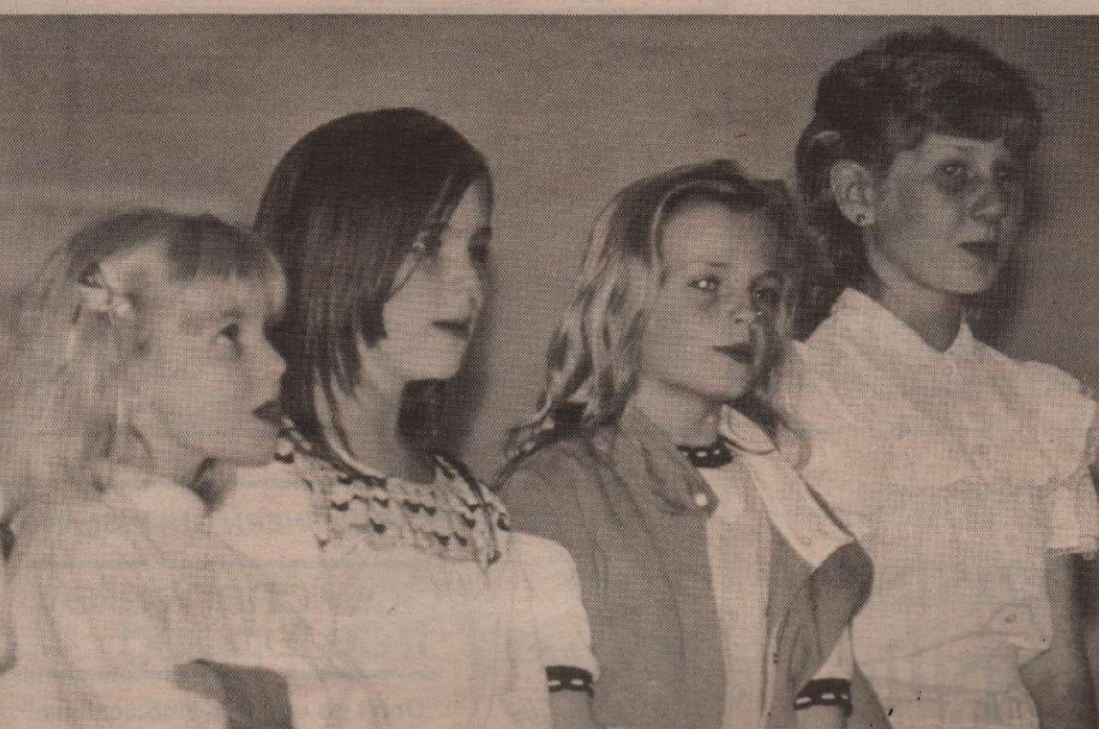
On Saturday, the itinerary includes a pancake breakfast in Centennial Park at 8 a.m., parade at 9:30, water events, the Gourmet Garden and Lark in the Park (for kids) at 11 a.m., followed by the tug-of-war and outdoor concert in the afternoon.

Most of the activities on Sunday will take place on the beach in Vesuvius, beginning with the treasure hunt at 10 a.m. and sandsculpting at 1:30 p.m. The day will end with the windsurfing regatta.

The winner of last year's treasure hunt, says Richardson, walked away with a treasure chest containing 200 loonies — one drawing card to the popular event.

This year, like the 1989 treasure hunt, the first and final clues will

## Beach bird count needed

A Salt Spring woman hopes to organize a team of volunteers to undertake a monthly bird count on local beaches.

Anna Hawthorne says the information gathered in those surveys could be especially helpful in the event of a large oil spill.

The idea comes in part from Hawthorne's own experience in Newfoundland last winter, when she spent two months cleaning oil-

soaked birds. The plan is also part of a pilot project sponsored by the Royal British Columbia Museum and organized by a Victoria biologist who hopes to see surveys completed all along the West Coast. Information gathered from the surveys would be kept on file at the museum.

## Count would help biologists determine impact of oil spills

Hawthorne says that because so many birds are affected by oil dumped by tanker traffic on the east coast, teams of trained volunteers now patrol beaches regularly. Volunteers were disappointed in the small number of birds they were able to save, but found participation in the project rewarding.

"It was exciting to be involved in an intensive project to try to save the birds and keep track of what happened to those that ingested the oil."

Even with the low survival rate of the birds, Hawthorne says the counts provide information about the impact of oil spills and other water contaminants on wildlife.

Biologist and project coordinator Alan Burger says the main purpose of the surveys would be to record the number of dead birds which wash up on the shores. This, he says, would give an indication of what species are dying. The only bird count undertaken in B.C. now, he adds, is the annual Christmas count which concentrates on live birds.

A paper prepared by Burger earlier this year, notes that over 20,000 seabirds died off Washington and British Columbia when the *Nestucca* spilled its load off Gray's Harbor. In the investigation which followed, biologists realized how little is known about the natural mortality patterns of seabirds and how difficult it is to interpret the impact of spills.

Burger says the beach surveys, which have been done in California and a number of European countries

for the past several years, have found a high proportion of the sea birds die from oil contamination. Many of the birds die after coming in contact with oil from large spills, however, minor spills contribute significantly to the overall kill.

The surveys themselves are done by people recording the types of dead birds found on a particular beach section ever month. The surveys must be done over the same length of beach for as many months as possible and using the same number of people.

The information would be turned over to Burger.

Hawthorne suggests there are probably a number of people who

have already been gathering information on an informal basis but have not known what to do with it.

On a broader scale, Hawthorne would like to see a facility identified on Salt Spring where contaminated birds could be taken for treatment. She said it would also help to have the names of veterinarian and volunteers who would be willing to help out in the event of a spill.

## Changes to Pension Act offer some "good news"

Changes in the federal *Pensions Act* offers good news to widows of disabled pensioners.

The act was amended last year to allow resumption of survivors' pensions for widows or other dependents of disability pensioners. Previous changes had eliminated those widows who had subsequently remarried after the death of the disabled pensioner.

The amendment allows resumption of pensions at the percentage established at the time of death of the pensioner. For example, a survivor who had been receiving between five per cent and 48 per cent of the full pension can now be eligible for a similar amount.

For survivors who had been receiving between 48 and 100 per cent of the pension, renewal would be at a full widows' pension.

likely be found on Vesuvius Beach. And if competitors think the hunt is easy — guess again.

Richardson says it typically takes treasure hunters between two and four hours to find all of the more than 20 clues in the hunt which generally attract upwards of 60 participants.

While Richardson says it's hard to single out any one Sea Caper event as the most popular, the water events, treasure hunt and sandsculpting competitions seem to be particular favourites.

"The sandsculpting is strictly for fun and it's a gas," says Richardson, adding that entries range from sandcastles to mermaids and giraffes. The family category has been won three times by a family who typically builds a car people can climb in.

"You get into some pretty sophisticated stuff in the adult group."

Six yards or more of sand is usually brought to Vesuvius Beach for the competition in which participants can enter one of several categories designed for both individuals and groups.

This year competitors will have to work quickly to beat the incoming tide.

A schedule of Sea Capers events will be sent through the mail by organizers this week.

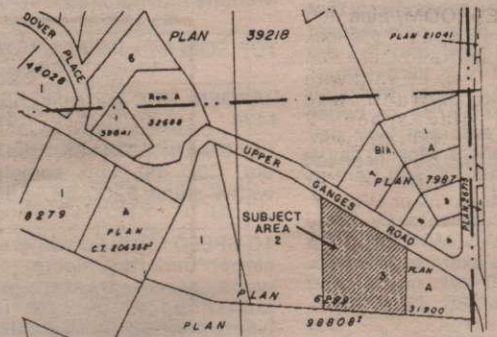

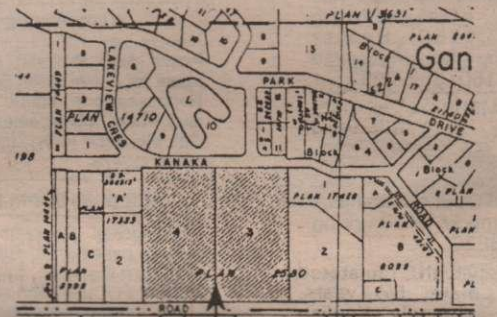

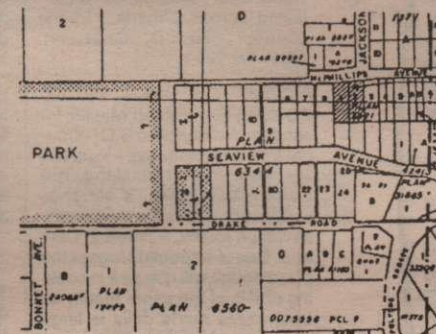


Bylaw No. 267 cited as "Zoning Bylaw, Salt Spring Island, 1985, Amendment Bylaw No. 7, 1990" changes the zoning classification of Lots 3 and 4, Section 2, Range 3 East, Plan 2580, NSSI, Cowichan Land District, from Agriculture 1 (A1) to Agriculture 1-C (A1-C) as shown on the following sketch. In addition the proposed bylaw establishes an Agriculture 1-C Zone (A1-C) for the purpose of permitting public schools, community halls, non-profit group facilities and public recreational facilities. Setbacks, site coverage, and height restrictions are also established within the Zone.



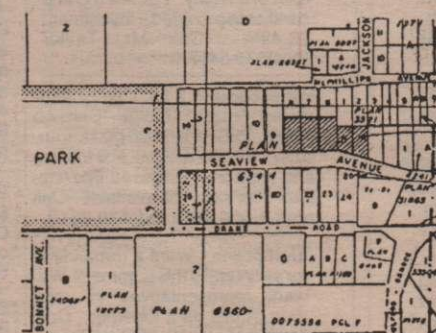
Properties being rezoned from AGRICULTURE 1 (A1) to AGRICULTURE 1-C (A1-C)

Bylaw No. 266 cited as "Zoning Bylaw, Salt Spring Island, 1985, Amendment Bylaw No. 6, 1990" establishes a Parks and Recreation Zone (PR-B) for the purposes of permitting parks and park reserves, nature house facilities, outdoor recreational activities and indoor and outdoor cultural activities and facilities. Site coverage and height restrictions, and setback requirements are also established within the Zone. In addition the proposed bylaw changes the zoning classification of Lots 1 and 2, Section 1, Range 3 East, Plan 3321, North Salt Spring Island, Cowichan District from the Residential Zone (R1) to the Parks and Recreation Zone (PR-B) as shown in the following sketch.

The proposed bylaw also changes the zoning classification of Lots 4, 5 and parts of Lots 6, 7 and 8, Plan 6344, Section 1, Range 3 East NSSI, Cowichan District from Public and Recreation Zone (PR) to Parks and Recreation Zone (PR-B) as shown on the following sketch.

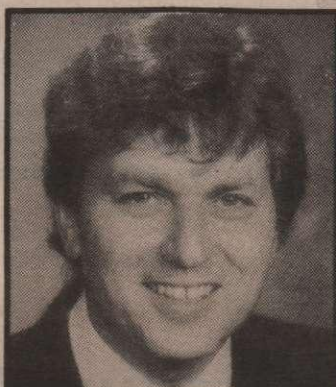

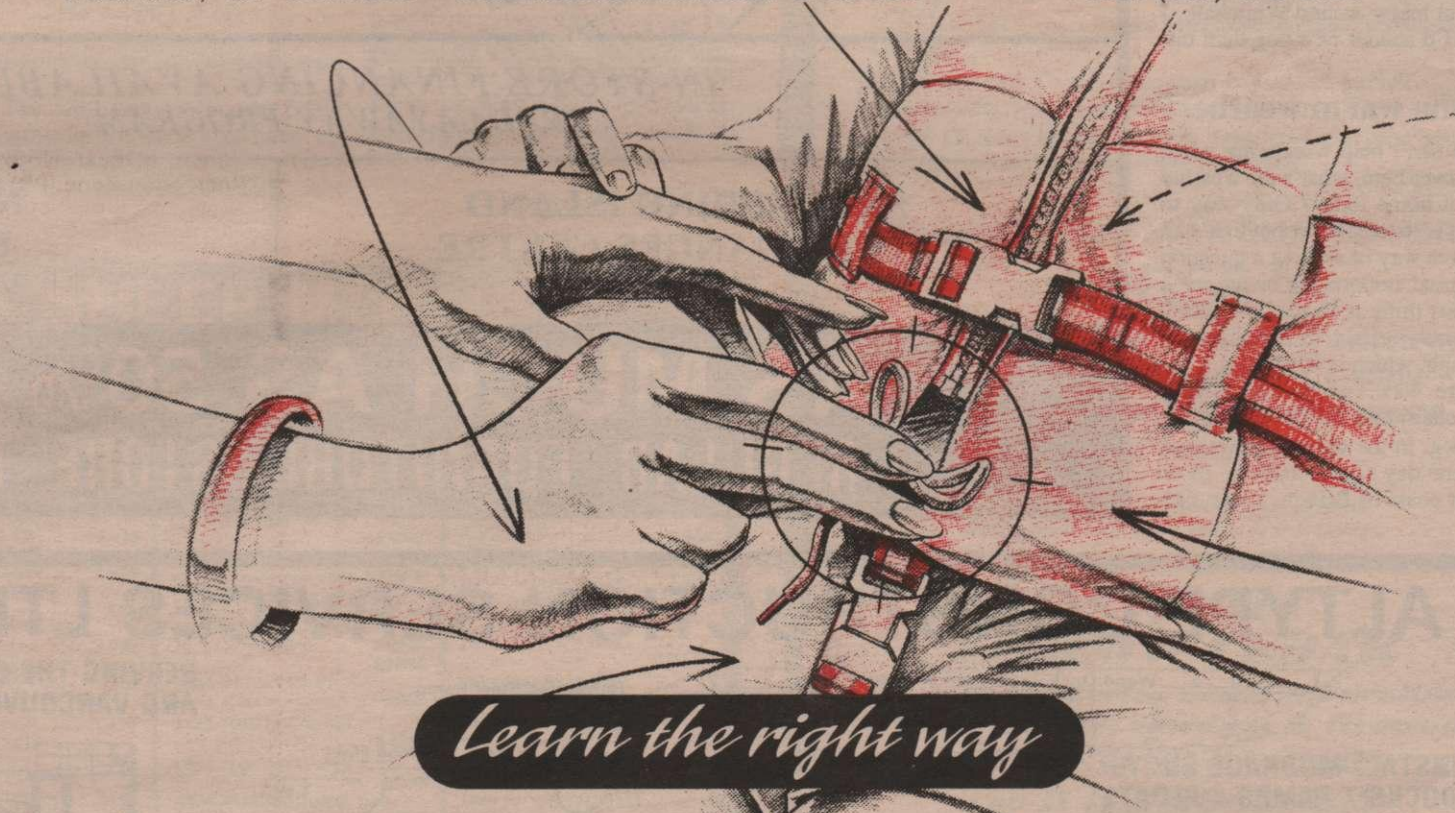

And in the shadow of the 21st century who is going to live in a city without his best friend to look after his interests? And there you have it.

Lots of parks in some cities and lots of friends near the rural towns. You know what it all means; like, something to sniff about here? Not everywhere, of course, but in Yorkshire generations of dogs have worked to control the landscape. Perhaps, one day, they'll succeed. Out they come from a third floor apartment, duly and dutifully becollared and bechained, all ready for a new encounter with the world.

You'd think that was enough. You'd figure that French Poodles on the sidewalks and Yorkshire Terriers on the park greens would have told the entire story but there's an odd dog's leg in this canine story of Europe.

Like back home, there's a segment of the doggerly goes overboard. There are Bull Terriers and Rottweilers and Alsatis and a few others have been obstreperous in the lesser instances and a harsh threat to survival in the more serious cases.

Only way to find out is to telephone, but that's an expensive way of settling a question of no great importance or urgency. Next best thing is to read the world weather synopsis in the London Telegraph, which is what I did.

There was Vancouver, proudly laying claim to a high of 13 deg. C, or 55 deg. in the old and unwanted. The same day saw a claim of 18 on the east coast of Britain. I was sud-
