## Scuba diving proves popular

Cradling a long-necked dark brown bottle in his hands, Perry Haskell points to the inscription and the rough edges left by the mold, and suggests the container must be at least 20 years old.

The insignia reads Silver Spring Brewery, Victoria, B.C. and attached to the side are two barnacles drying quickly under the heat of the late afternoon sun.

The bottle was discovered just off Beaver Point by scuba divers on their first dive. It is for finds such as these, and the life found in nearby waters, that the Gulf Islands is quickly becoming known as the place to dive in Canada.

Last year, two former Albertans, Haskell and Geoff Townsend, moved to Salt Spring to open the only scuba diving shop on the Gulf Islands. While last winter was a hard one for business, they note that as more people realize the diving potential and learn that oxygen is available here for divers, more and more are starting to come from other parts of British Columbia, Alberta and the United States to enjoy the sport on the west coast.

Townsend estimates that it won't be long before the Gulf Islands attract diving enthusiasts from all over North America.

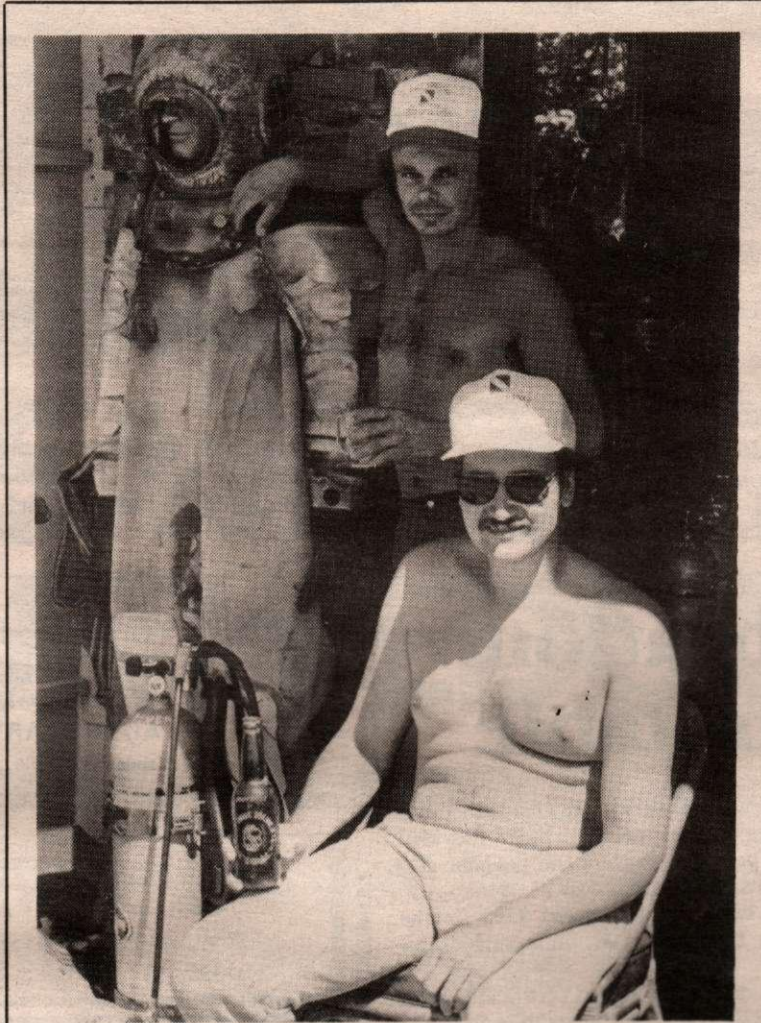
"People don't realize all of the things there are to see down there," he says, noting that the waters around the islands are literally teeming with fish.

"Vesuvius is just packed, millions of little fish from a half-inch to three inches long, and there are schools of them all over.

"You could sit for hours just watching the fish and they are as curious about you as you are about them."

Since coming to the island, Townsend and Haskell have identified close to 30 spots in the Gulf Islands where excellent diving can be found. It is another advantage of diving here that people can boat from one location to another instead of driving to various sites as they do in Vancouver and Victoria.

"Almost around any corner is a

good dive spot," said Townsend, adding that the diving is suitable for newcomers and pros.

"There are caves near Beaver Point you can investigate, and big kelp beds where you can find starfish and sun stars. And some of the octopus you see can be 10 feet across," he said. People can also go to one particular spot a dozen times and always find something different.

"There are hundreds and hundreds of different kinds of fish — rock fish, perch, sculpin and cabazon — and some of them are so friendly they will eat out of your hands."

Learning to dive requires a minimum of swimming skills and, in fact, Townsend suggests the hardest part is carrying the equipment to the water. The course is generally taught over a two-day period, one of which

is spent learning theory; the second is spent in the water.

However, Townsend notes that the demand for suit and equipment rentals on Salt Spring has been such that the local shop will not be able to offer more classes until next fall or winter, when business slows down and when the shop owners are licenced to give classes themselves.

One of the things that makes diving on the west coast attractive, though, is that diving can be done all year around. The water temperature in January and February is only five degrees lower than what it is in the summer, and though there is more life during the summer months, the visibility is better in the winter.

Altogether, lessons cost approximately \$500, which includes rentals and training. (The lessons cost \$250; students must provide their own mask, snorkel and fins, which generally amount to an additional \$250). And although the outlay may seem high initially, Townsend suggests it is comparable to skiing and in fact considerably less than many outdoor sports.

## Galiano parents request teacher

Problems at the Galiano school have parents concerned — and the Gulf Islands school board seeking solutions.

Galiano school, with approximately 91 children attending, has a staff of seven teachers covering 5.6 full-time equivalent positions. Disruptions in the staff in the past year, when four of the regular teachers left the school, created some problems in the classrooms.

Mike Marshall, superintendent of schools, assured the school board last week that although the Galiano school was "in crisis," district staff were working with the parents to find solutions.

Akasha Forest, a parent with children in the school, said the problem stemmed from the class splits in the school.

She suggested a class make-up of kindergarten, Grades 1 and 2, Grade 3, Grade 4, Grade 5 as well as Grades 6 and 7. Such a line-up would require one extra teacher for the school, she said, but would eliminate four split classes as is now the case.

She sought assurances on behalf of the Galiano parents that the extra teacher would be available for September. The parents, Forest told the school trustees, understood the extra teacher would cost the school district money.

"We really feel we need it (an extra teacher); otherwise we wouldn't ask for it," she told the school board.

Marshall will have district staff talking with the parents and the staff at Galiano. He assured the parents and the school trustees that staff would "take a close look at staffing, particularly on Galiano, as well as how it affects the whole district."

A major part of the problem was school funding, he noted. Lack of access to the local tax base, except through referendum, has placed constraints on the school district, he said.

The parents also objected to older children being shipped by water taxi to Mayne Island for middle school, Grades 6, 7 and 8.

The parents want the children to remain at the Galiano school. As of the end of May, the Galiano school had 18 children in Grade 4, five in Grade 5, eight in Grade 6 and 13 in Grade 7.

If those numbers remained stable for September, 22 children from Galiano would cross Active Pass each day for middle school on Mayne Island.

Marshall explained the problem with the older classes would be solved when the staffing problems were sorted out.

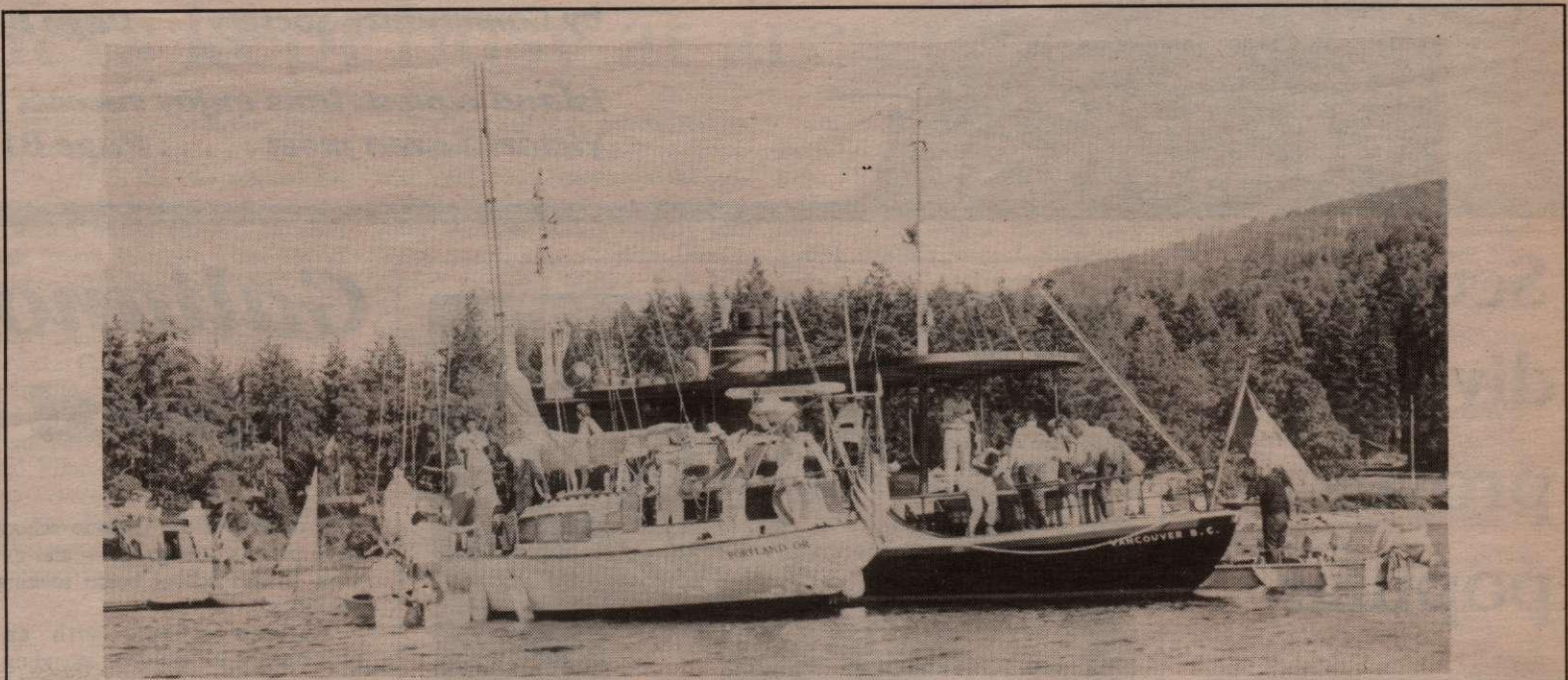

## 'Dry' celebration proves profitable

After-Grad '90 featured an alcohol-drug free party — and made money. A breakdown of income and expenses for the graduation party, provided by Sharon Crouse, shows the group of parent organizers and graduate students raised \$8,300 while the party and its preparations cost \$7,001.

When students carried out a bottle drive, they gathered \$555 for the cause. Selling advertisements raised a further \$4,700 while various individuals kicked in \$1,260.

Not included in the accounting were donated gifts and certificates from different business people, valued from \$20 to \$50 and given to each of the 56 grads.

The graduates themselves paid fees totalling \$870 and their guests purchased tickets to the affair to add \$915 to the total.

On the other side of the balance sheet, the largest payout was \$1,600 to cover the cost of food and non-alcoholic beverages. In addition, \$1,350 went towards the rental of the Oak Bay Recreation Centre where the party was held.

A further \$1,200 was spent on grand prizes for the evening. Various advertisements for the dry grad party cost 950 while screened tee-shirts as a memento of the evening cost \$715. Silver pins commemorating the event cost \$340.

Entertainment for the evening cost \$400 for music and \$215 for the games. Ferry fares to take celebrants to Vancouver Island cost \$120. Other expenses came through costs of decorations (\$36) and stationary (\$75).

The remainder of close to \$1,200 will be given to the After-Grad '91 committee, and that amount could be increased by \$500 when an expected government grant comes in.

# Community Society seeks applicants for low-cost island accommodation

The Community Society on Salt Spring needs to hear from people who might need low-cost accommodation.

Barbara Jordan-Knox of the society explained that it has been advertising for names of people who might need accommodation with a low rent. The society is in process of preparing an application for funding, if the need for affordable housing on Salt Spring can be proven.

The society needs the names of five potential renters for each unit the government would fund, she explained. If, for instance, the society planned for a 20-unit housing project, it would require the names of 100 potential renters.

Jordan-Knox said the society hopes to have all the needed information in place, and the proposal into the government, by January, 1991. The approval process and construction could take as long as two and

perhaps three years before the low-rental units would be available, she noted.

Jordan-Knox indicated the qualifications for potential renters covered low-income families, seniors on a limited budget or handicapped persons. The society would ask potential renters about their current housing, the family's monthly income, how many persons in the family and how many bedrooms they would require.

"I can't believe there is no need on this island," she said.

Money would come from B.C. Housing and the Canadian Mortgage and Housing Corporation.

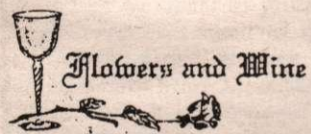

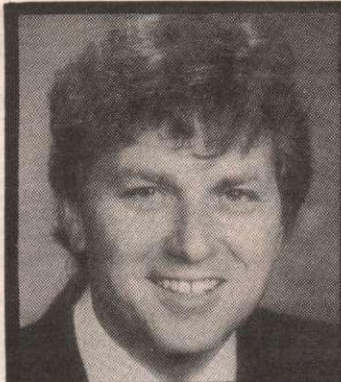

S.S. Kokanee, owned by Krista Scotvold, was champion Hunter Pleasure Amateur.

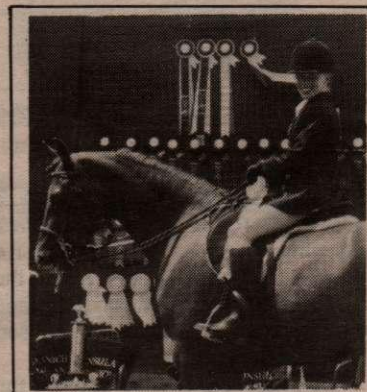
Warriors Legend, owned by Brenda Stewart, was High Point Dressage Horse, and won the half-Arab Hunter Pleasure championship class.

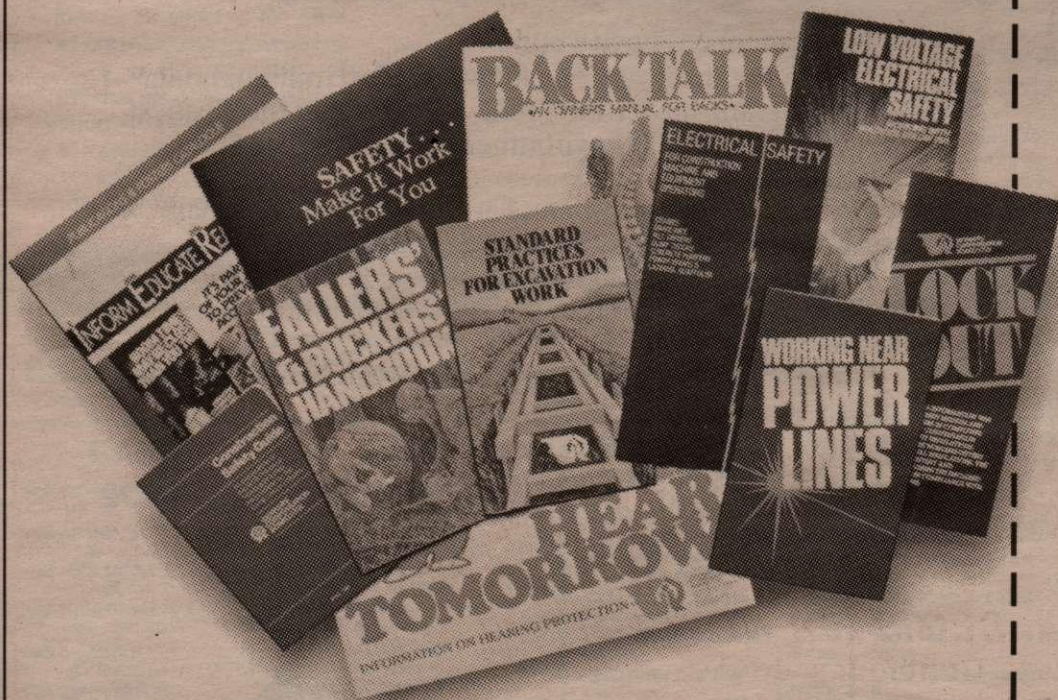

## Fletcher Challenge Canada. Creating a better environment by improving the Crofton mill.

People have been asking us about the \$300 million modernization program now underway at the Crofton pulp and paper mill which includes a large number of measures to protect the environment and make the mill more compatible with community life. Here are some of the most commonly asked questions and answers.

### Q. What's being done to eliminate dioxins?

A. A great deal. When it was first learned in 1987 that dioxins were formed in pulp bleaching, Fletcher Challenge Canada took the initiative to determine the causes and to deal with the problem. The new chlorine dioxide generator installed at Crofton the next year enabled the mill to substitute chlorine dioxide for chlorine in the bleaching process, substantially reducing dioxin formation.

We've now had some tests showing dioxins to be undetectable in mill effluent. And when our other pulp mill improvements come on stream over the next 18 months, we expect dioxins to be non-existent in our effluent and products.

### Q. What about other emissions into the ocean?

A. Many of the changes underway at the mill will make us more efficient in recovering pulping chemicals, which means our effluent will be cleaner even before its primary treatment stage. Currently, mill effluent receives primary treatment to remove solids and other materials. Our new \$70 million secondary treatment system will significantly reduce the presence of trace levels of residual toxicity, oxygen-consuming materials and organo-chlorine compounds. With all systems in place, we will be meeting the strict new government water quality standards going into effect in 1992.

### Q. What about air quality and mill odours?

A. We're installing the latest practical and proven technology

to deal with characteristic pulp mill odours and other air emissions at a cost of over \$100 million. This includes construction of a new low-odour recovery boiler and the conversion of existing boilers to low-odour technology. We're also installing new precipitators and scrubbers on mill stacks to reduce other particle and gas emissions to levels well within government environmental standards. We can't promise to eliminate all mill odours, but we've made important progress in recent weeks and there will be further improvements by the end of 1991.

### Q. Can noise levels be reduced further?

A. Yes. We are aware of our neighbours' concerns about noise and we're installing new vacuum pump equipment and silencers to reduce the noise emitted by our pulp and paper machines. Noise reduction will be an ongoing program at Crofton.

### A cleaner, more productive mill

Now in the third year of a four-year \$300 million modernization program, the Crofton mill will be one of the cleanest in the world once these environmental improvements are completed.
