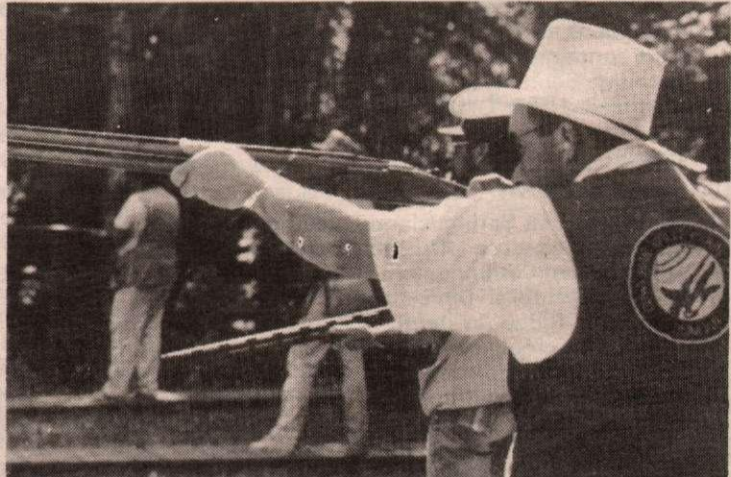
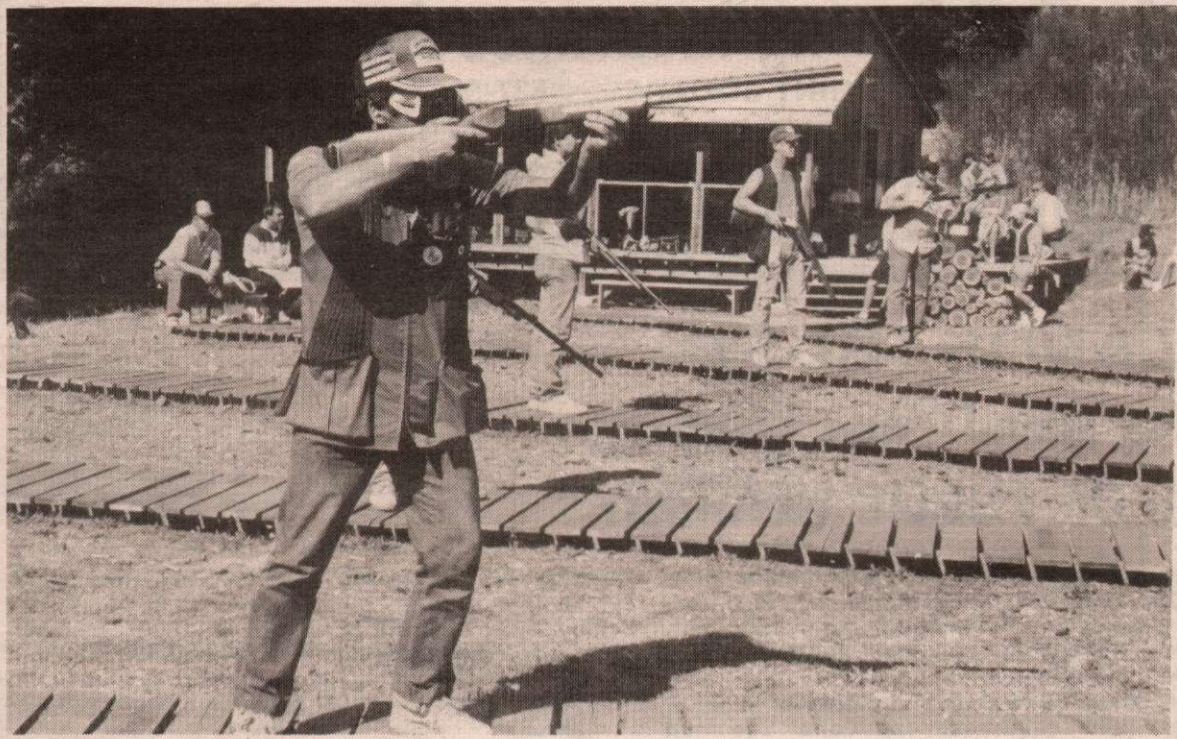

Save the Strait Marathon

Water adventures spread awareness

The Save the Strait Marathon was held last Saturday to raise awareness of the need for Georgia Strait survival, but Salt Spring Island participants in the event had some surviving of their own to do.

A team of five swimmers — Patricia Brown, Jane Janzen, Holly Kemp, Lois Phillips and Penny Polden — swam in relay across approximately half of the 16-kilometre route from Nanaimo to Sechelt in cold, white-capped waters. Their escort boat *Yucatan*, owned and skippered by Donald Layard, rescued less-equipped marathoners, and ended up towing an open Greenpeace boat carrying swimmers from another team.

The group also had to pull a swimmer from the water when an American Navy frigate boat would not respond to Layard's calls and maintained a course aimed at the *Yucatan*.

Janzen said they could see the American ship heading towards them, so Layard tried to contact it on the marine channel normally used in the area. He received no response, and the boat appeared to be increasing in speed. After the swimmer in the water was pulled out, Layard had to hurry away from the path of the frigate.

"They were so close you could see the baseball caps on their heads," said Janzen. "It was definitely an aggres-

Nanaimo and Gabriola Island, and Layard's boat was used as the recuperation base for everyone.


Other Salt Spring Island participants in the marathon were Matthew Coleman and his son Tim, who completed the route by canoe.

Susan and Uri Cogan, also of Salt Spring, provided a support boat for the canoers and kayakers in the strait, said Phillips.

Coliform counts up

As summer rolls to an end, the coliform count at various Salt Spring swimming sites rises, again.

The count, monitored weekly by the health department of the Capital Regional district, slid to a low for several weeks but now edges upwards.

Stowe Lake, in Fulford, rose to a count of 28 after being at 17 for a couple of weeks. Yet Weston Lake, just up Beaver Point Road, remained at a count of 16 coliform parts per 100 millilitres of water.

Vesuvius Beach edged to a 17 from the reading of 12 gained over most of the summer.

St. Mary Lake dipped to five from six while Cusheon Lake rose to six from four. Blackburn Lake remained level at six.

Across the CRD, Cadboro Bay has been posted with warnings to swimmers. That beach had registered 85 and shot up to 651.

The health officials issue warnings if the coliform count exceeds a count of 200 parts per 100 ml or when, as the case of Cadboro Bay, the count fluctuates dramatically. No beaches on Salt Spring have come close to needing warnings this summer.

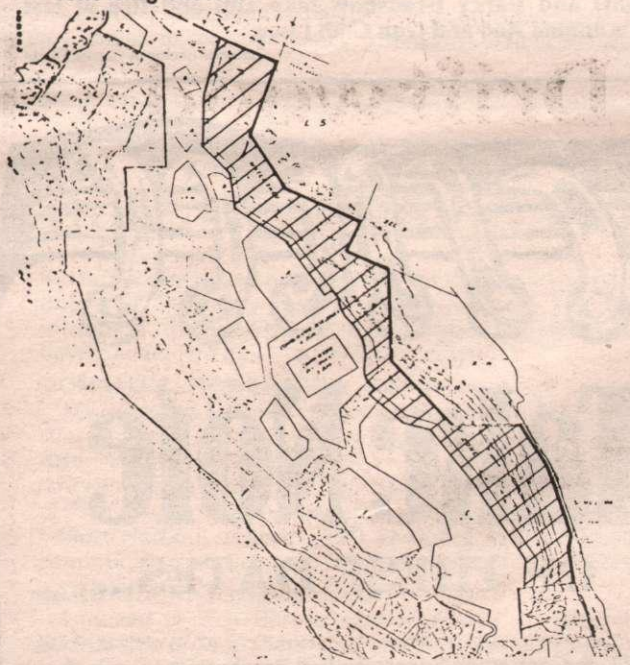

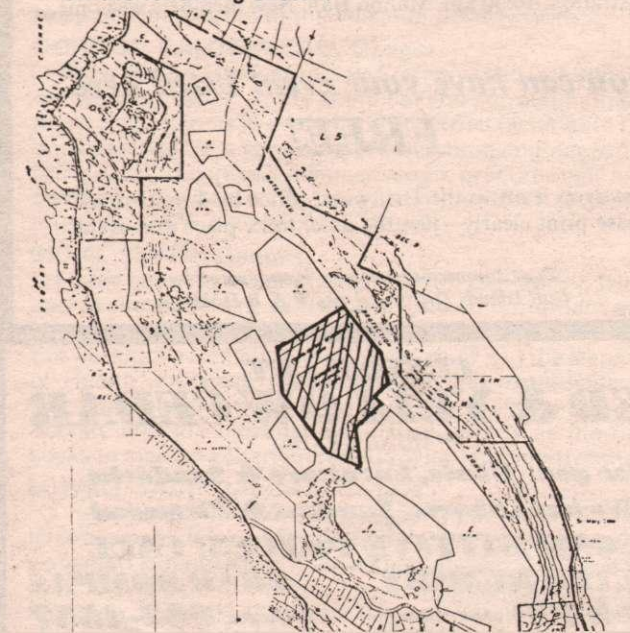
NOTICE is hereby given that all persons who deem their interest in property affected by the following proposed bylaws will be afforded an opportunity to be heard on the matters contained therein at a Public Hearing to be held on Monday, September 10, 1990, commencing at 1:00 p.m. at Unit 1205, Grace Point Square, Ganges, Salt Spring Island.

In general terms the intent of the following proposed bylaws is as follows:

1. Proposed Salt Spring Island Trust Committee Bylaw No. 254, cited as "Official Community Plan, Salt Spring Island, Amendment Bylaw No. 5, 1989", is a bylaw to establish Development Permit Area No. 4—Channel Ridge Watershed Development Permit Area. The proposed bylaw provides a rationale for designation, specifies guidelines respecting the marina by which the natural environment will be protected, and designates the boundaries of the development permit area. The approximate boundaries of the development permit area for a portion of the Channel Ridge area is as shown on the following sketch:

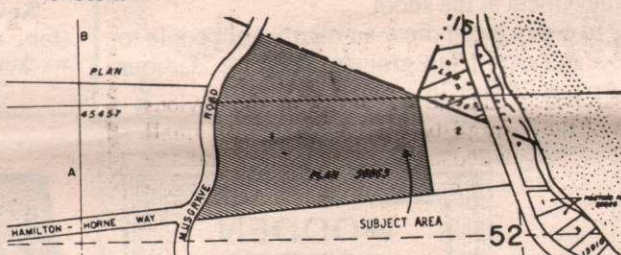


2. Proposed Salt Spring Island Trust Committee Bylaw No. 255, cited as "Official Community Plan, Salt Spring Island, Amendment Bylaw No. 6, 1989", is a bylaw to establish Development Permit Area No. 5—Channel Ridge New Village Development Permit Area. The proposed bylaw provides the rationale for the designation, and specifies guidelines for the form and character of commercial and multi-family residential development. In addition, the boundaries of the proposed development permit area are shown on the following sketch:



3. Proposed Salt Spring Island Trust Committee Bylaw No. 256, cited as "Official Community Plan, Salt Spring Island, Amendment Bylaw No. 1, 1990", is a bylaw that replaces the existing "goal" statement within the existing Official Community Plan with a list of "Island Development Principles" and a list of "Goals and Objectives for Land Use and Development".

4. Proposed Salt Spring Island Trust Committee Bylaw No. 269, cited as "Zoning Bylaw, Salt Spring Island, 1985, Amendment Bylaw No. 9, 1990", establishes an Agriculture 1-D Zone (A1-D) for the purpose of permitting farm use, one single family dwelling per parcel and seasonal cottage and home occupations. Site coverage, height, setbacks and minimum parcel area are also established within the zone. In addition, the proposed bylaw changes the zoning classification of Lot 1, Section 52, South Salt Spring Island, Plan 38862, from Agriculture 1 (A1) to Agriculture 1-D (A1-D) as shown on the following sketch:

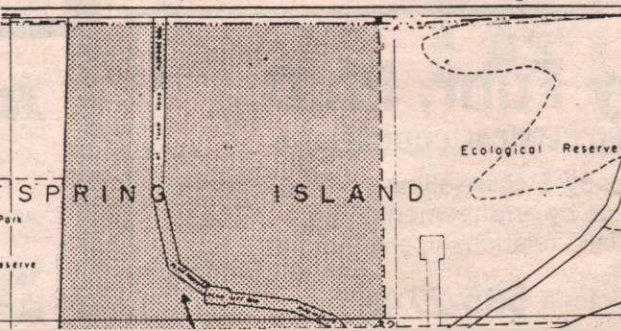


5. Proposed Salt Spring Island Trust Committee Bylaw No. 270, cited as "Zoning Bylaw, Salt Spring Island, 1985, Amendment Bylaw No. 10, 1990", provides a definition of "Bed and Breakfast" and establishes regulations for Bed and Breakfast use. In addition the proposed Bylaw permits Bed and Breakfast in the following zones: Rural (R), Rural Residential (RR1), Rural Residential 2 (RR2), Rural Residential 3 (RR3), Residential 1 (R1), Agriculture 1 (A1), Agriculture 1-A (A1-A), Agriculture 1-B (A1-B), Agriculture 2 (A2), Watershed 1 (W1), Watershed 2 (W2), Upland and Forest (UF1), Upland and Forest 2 (UF2), Upland and Forest Retreat (UFR) and Upland and Forest Cluster (UFC).

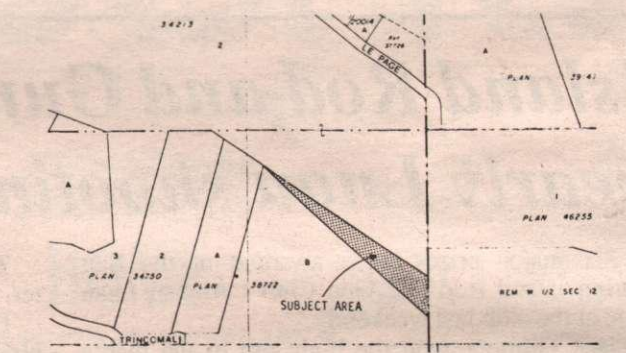

Proposed Salt Spring Island Trust Committee Bylaw No. 271, cited as "Zoning Bylaw, Salt Spring Island, 1985, Amendment Bylaw No. 11, 1990", changes the zoning classification of Lot 3, Section 2, Range 1 and 2 West, Plan 29481, from Rural (R) to Public and Recreation (PR) as shown on the following sketch:



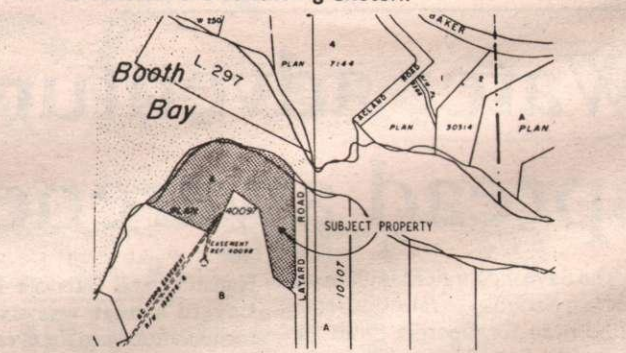

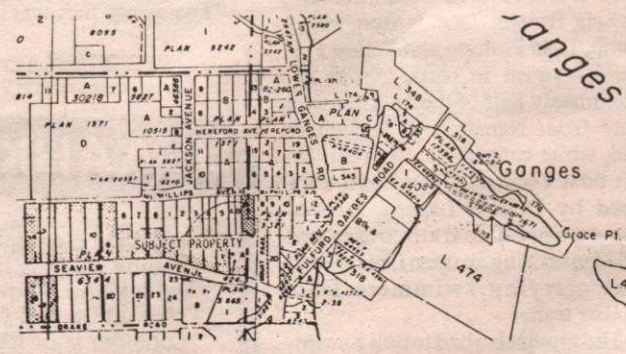

8. Proposed Salt Spring Island Trust Committee Bylaw No. 273, cited as "Zoning Bylaw, Salt Spring Island, 1985, Amendment Bylaw No. 13, 1990", changes the zoning classification of Lot A, D.L. 16, North Salt Spring Island, Plan 40097, PID 000039179 from Commercial 4 (C4) to Rural Residential 2 (RR2) as shown on the following sketch:

Proposed Salt Spring Island Trust Committee Bylaw No. 274, cited as "Zoning Bylaw, Salt Spring Island, 1985, Amendment Bylaw No. 14, 1990", changes the zoning classification of Lot 7, Section 1, Range 3 and 4 East, Land District 16, North Salt Spring Island, PID 000340227, Plan 3321 from Residential 1 (R1) to Comprehensive Development (CD) as shown on the following sketch:

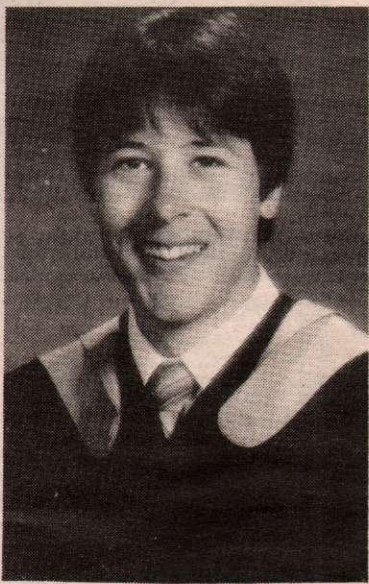

covered," said Phillips. "They (the organizers) were matching every boat with another boat."

The swimmers knew of only one person in the marathon who had to be removed from the water and taken to hospital due to hypothermia.

The coast guard and RCMP boats were also "very much in evidence," she said. The coast guard boat came up to the *Yucatan* several times to see if anyone on board needed assistance.

Janzen, Brown and Phillips all praised the patience and seamanship of Layard. Phillips said she felt his assistance was "a total gift of his time, effort and expertise."

While Janzen extended a special thanks to Phillips for monitoring the swimmers' conditions with such care, Phillips passed the praise on to Layard.

"I was taking my cue from him and felt confident under his command as captain of the ship."

Janzen said it was difficult for the swimmers to maintain their direction in light of the tide, waves and wind.

While she said it was a real "survival swim" for her, she felt none of the Salt Spring swimmers went beyond their capacity in the water.

Prior to the marathon, Phillips explained, the women "made a decision that (they) wanted to get there in one piece." She said "none of us was striving for personal glory. The whole point was to draw attention to the higher political good."

Brown said the marathon was a "real attention-getter" for the awareness that needs to be raised about the toxic wastes poured daily into the Strait of Georgia.

Upon reaching Sechart, Phillips

said she was struck by the obvious fragility of the cluster of small wooden boats on shore, and the people who had risked themselves in the strait's waters. "We are dealing with something tender," she thought.

It emphasized to her that the Save the Strait Marathon was "a really good way to make a point about fragility with something so fragile as the strait."

The swimmers estimate they raised about \$1,000 in pledges, which will be shared by the Save the Strait Alliance and Green Islands, the local sponsoring organization.

Power and Sail Squadron

Boating course is scheduled to start

The annual boating course sponsored by the Salt Spring Island Power and Sail Squadron is scheduled to get underway on September 5, 1990 at Gulf Islands Secondary School.

In outlining the course, Power and Sail Squadron training officer Don Watt said it will consist of 14 three-hour sessions held once a week. A written examination will be conducted in mid-December.

Offers variety of subjects including "rules of the road," seamanship and boating etiquette.

He said the course covers a variety of boating subjects including "rules of the road," seamanship, aids to navigation, boating etiquette and some elementary chart work. However, Watt said, the primary objective of the course will be to teach boating safety.

Owning a boat is not a prerequisite of taking the course.

"In fact," Watt said, "many people have taken the course prior to purchasing a boat and found the information they gained in the course was

helpful in making their final selection."

Upon successful completion of the course, a person is eligible to become a member of the squadron. Canadian Power and Sail Squadron clubs pride themselves on having this qualification for members, regardless of the individual's boating experience.

More advanced courses are available for those who become a member of the squadron. These include a course called *Seamanship*, which is required before moving on to *Seamanship Sail or Power*, *Advanced Pilotage*, *Junior Navigator* or the final course, *Navigator*.

The Salt Spring Island squadron is one of 18 squadrons in the Vancouver Island District of Canadian Power and Sail Squadrons. There are more than 150 squadrons across Canada, and each year they provide instruction in safe boating operation to more than 10,000 Canadians.

All instruction is given by experienced squadron members on a volunteer basis.

Anyone wishing to apply for this year's course can obtain application forms at The Village Cobbler or from one of several display panels set up throughout Ganges.

GORDON CALDERHEAD, Ganges

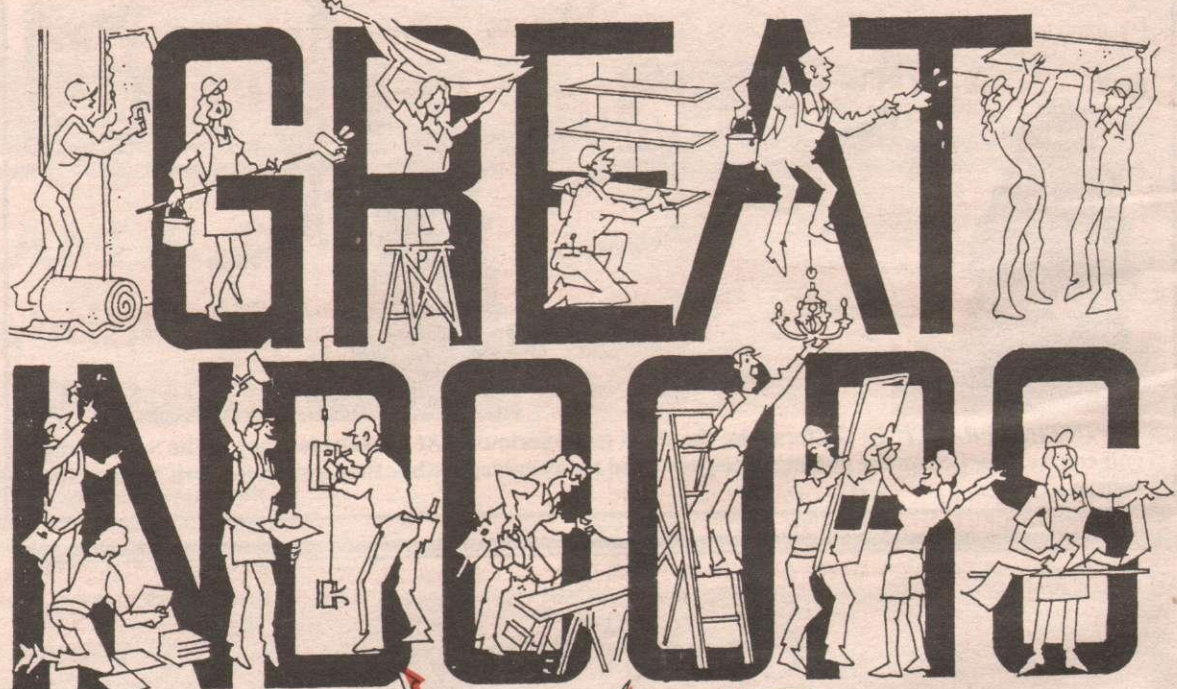

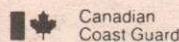
