New chairman looks to future of Gulf Islands School District

Grace Byrne expects the coming year to be a busy one for the nine trustees who make up the Gulf Islands school board.

Byrne, who was elected to chair the board last December, said that some of the issues it will tackle this year include building a new elementary school, negotiating wage settle-

ments and implementing the new "Year 2000" program brought out by the Ministry of Education last year.

In an interview with the *Driftwood* last week, Byrne said that the Gulf Islands School District is growing faster than any other district in British Columbia.

She noted the number of local enrolments here increased 28 per cent in the last three years.

The number of students in the Salt Spring district climbed from 1,177 in the 1986-87 school year to 1,508 last September.

Islanders to honour "strong volunteer"

Several Salt Spring groups are planning to honour an active community member who passed away earlier this month.

Margaret Haddow was known throughout the community as a "strong volunteer, always behind the scenes when needed." The 34-year-old died suddenly on January 11.

To commemorate Haddow's four-year participation in the Salt Spring Co-operative Playschool, youngsters there hope to plant an apple tree in the school yard early this spring.

The apple tree is symbolic because Haddow (who remained active in the pre-school even after her children no longer attended) initiated the school's apple-pressing fund raiser, held each year at the Fall Fair.

Haddow was also active in the elementary school system here, helping to organize carnivals, Christmas bazaars and hot dog days.

She made many friends as an R.N. at Lady Minto Hospital where she worked for five years.

As a result of Haddow's ties to the local school district and the hospital, a nursing scholarship is being established in her name. Although details are not complete,

Those who knew Haddow say the apple tree and the scholarship will help to carry her memory in this community for many years to come.

Haddow came to Salt Spring in 1979 with her husband Trevor. She leaves behind two daughters, Kimberly and Erin.

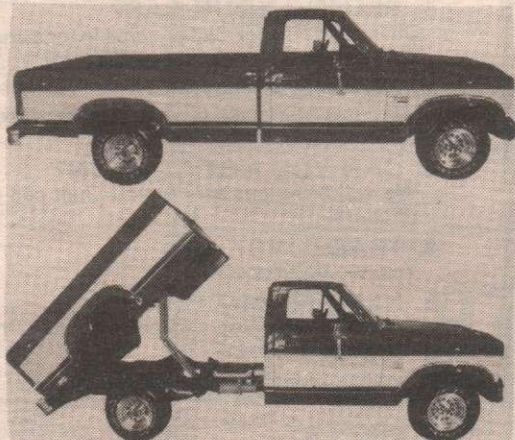

District considers several priorities

This is not the first time Byrne has served on a school board. Her background also includes an eight-year term with the school board in Canmore, Alberta where she lived for 14 years before coming to Salt Spring in 1983.

She was elected to the board here four years ago and has served as vice-chairman for the past two years.

She took on her new post as chairman in December.

A priority in this district, she noted will be implementing the new "Year 2000" program which was brought in by the education ministry last spring. Under that program, an ungraded primary affecting students in the kindergarten to grade three level must be introduced into all of the province's elementary schools by September.

Also on the agenda this year is the building of a new elementary school on Salt Spring: a project which Byrne would like to see started by the end of this year.

An offer to purchase has been placed on a Norton Road site and engineers with the Ministry of Education are expected to submit their reports on that site sometime within the next two weeks.

The school board is in the process of putting the finishing touches on the \$1.2 million addition to the Fernwood Elementary School which will officially open later this month.

One of the board's major concerns this year will include looking at the possibility of building joint-use facilities on the island. Byrne noted that while the province picks up 75 per cent of the building costs associated with new schools, the community is responsible for the other 25 per cent.

She said construction of joint-use facilities is one way taxpayers may get more for their money.

This is also the year that school boards throughout the province will be negotiating wage settlements with teachers as well as other school staff.

Byrne, who heads the board's negotiating committee, says negotiations with the Canadian Union of Public Employees are expected to start this spring.

Service needs support

A group of Salt Spring Islanders concerned about disposable diapers ending up in the landfill and the effect plastic diapers have on infants' health is trying to start a cloth diaper delivery service here.

Bob Twaites, a member of the solid waste management committee, said the service is ready to go as soon as the interest is there. At this point, about 10 local families have expressed an interest in the service, but Twaites said he is hoping between 30 and 40 families will subscribe.

From a health point-of-view, Twaites said, disposable diapers often irritate infants more than cloth diapers because of the plastic and perfumes used to make them. He noted Lady Minto Hospital has recently switched to cloth diapers. New mothers there are being given a week's supply of cloth diapers.

In environmental terms, Twaites said, disposable diapers are a "horrible waste" of pulp wood. He noted that 2.4 million trees are used in Canada to make disposable diapers every year. He also said disposable diapers make up between two and five per cent of the waste going into landfill sites. The soiled diapers also create other serious health risks.

A recent release from Saanich-Gulf Island MP Lynn Hunter notes that disposable diapers make up the largest single item in landfill sites today.

Twaites said an earlier attempt to encourage mothers here to switch failed because the interest wasn't there. He added that a company in Victoria is ready to start the service when the number of subscribers picks up. Initially, subscribers would have to pay \$12 a week for 70 diapers which does not include the cost of pick up and delivery.

Until the number of subscribers warrants the diaper service coming to deliver diapers to homes on Salt Spring, Twaites said volunteers would handle the delivery themselves.

Beside being healthier than disposable diapers, Twaites said cloth diapers are also cheaper to use. Statistics in a recent edition of *The Canadian Green Consumer Guide* suggest it costs \$2,300 to buy disposable diapers for two and a half years compared to \$1,200 for a diaper service and \$870 when families do their own laundering.

Said Twaites, "We have no commercial interest in this, no axe to grind, we just want this stuff out of the dump."
