"Quest" helps prepare students

Implementation of a new life skills program in School District 64 aims to prepare students for the onslaught of adolescence and the years beyond.

The *Quest* program has been in operation at Fernwood Elementary since December and will eventually reach all Grade Six to Eight students in the district. Susan Lee teaches the program to her split Grade Six and Seven class, which includes children from 10 to 12 years of age.

Quest uses language arts activities like reading, writing, discussion, research and drama to develop "skills for adolescence" in its pre-teen participants.

Some of the topics addressed include self-esteem, decision-making, drug and alcohol issues, relationships with family and friends, understanding your body, mind and feelings. A text and workbook is provided

to students and form the basis of lesson implementation.

Lee is enthusiastic about using *Quest*. "Some phenomenal things have happened" as a result of the program, she says, "and they (students) have really opened up to each other."

"Girls are more concerned about their looks," they said, and "boys are more sexist." Members of both genders, they agreed, "don't like their siblings."

Quest's success is dependent upon students feeling safe when they express themselves in class. Accordingly, says Lee, "the first part of the program is building up trust."

She says this has generally been achieved in her class, and observes the

positive effect a sense of trust has had on other classroom dynamics and activities.

Last Thursday morning, Lee's class discussed some perceptions and misconceptions about adolescents. They then formed groups to work on mural-sized renditions of teenagers as they viewed them. The groups produced a variety of males and females, and one group compiled a list of characteristics for each sex.

"Girls are more concerned about their looks," they said, and "boys are more sexist." Members of both genders, they agreed, "don't like their siblings."

A team of boys giggled madly as they produced a creature toting a "target gun" and using its "girl-sniffer" nose.

Lee did not encourage usual friends to work together on the project, but put less-familiar relationships to the test of cooperation.

Program materials were produced in the United States and sponsored by the Lions Club. Lions Clubs on Salt Spring, Pender and Galiano islands sponsored costs for training of district teachers and classroom materials.

Other teachers trained include Jean Sisson, Larry Field, Jack Barclay and John Bergsma from Salt Spring, Ken Cameron from Pender Island and Ken Trotman from Galiano. School District 64's Living for Learning Helping Teacher Debbie Magnusson also received training. Intensive three-day sessions were held in Nanoose in November.

Magnusson says Local Lions plan to sponsor the *Quest* program over a three-year period to ensure it reaches all Grades Six to Eight students in the school district.

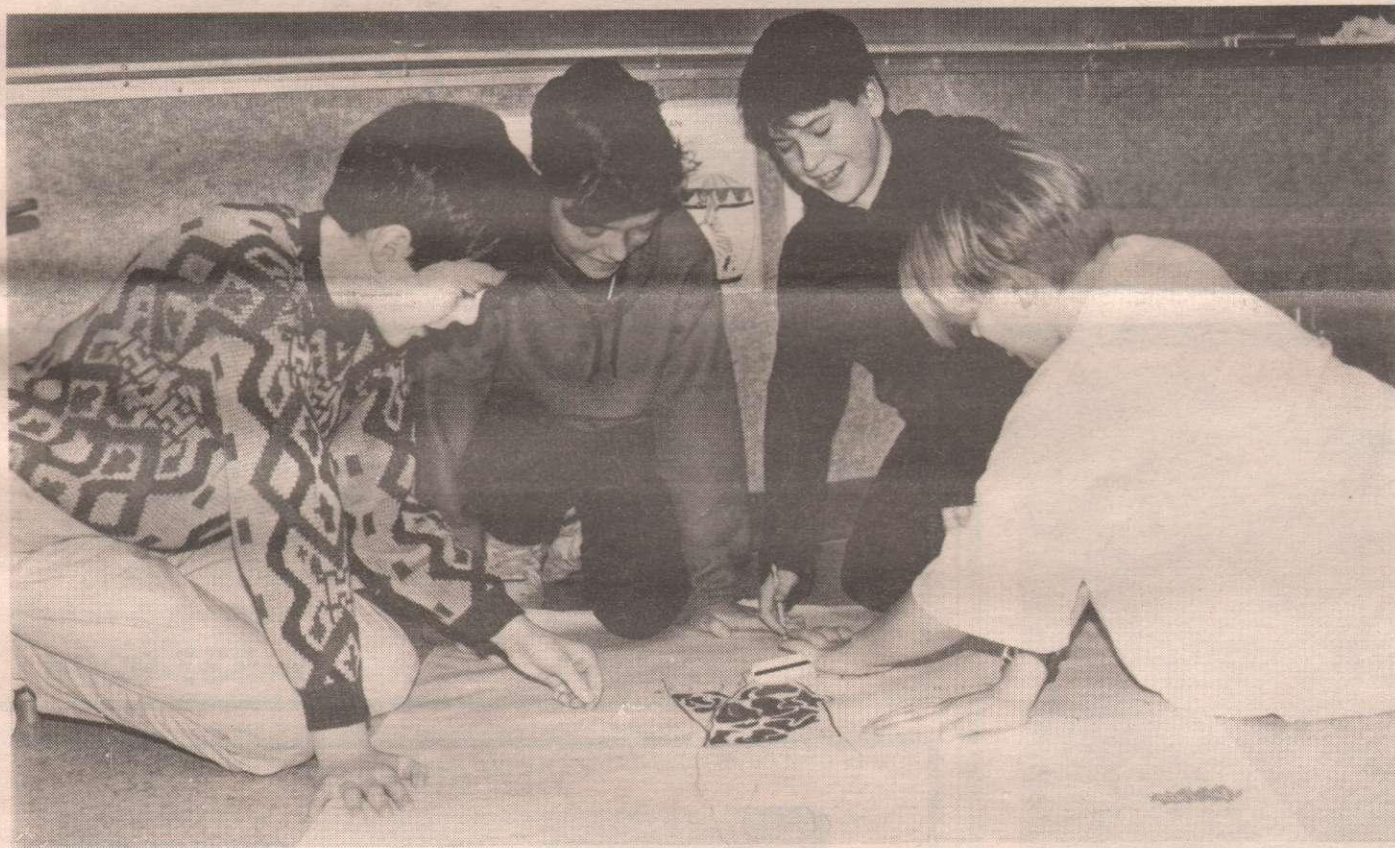
Appreciation for Lions assistance was expressed by teachers when they gave the Salt Spring Lions a gift certificate to purchase a tree. Magnusson says the tree is "to be planted, representing the spirit of the *Quest* program — for social growth which enhances self, family, school and community."

Knowing schools are not the sole providers of education and direction to its students, Magnusson says the program emphasizes parental involvement. A series of meetings are being planned, she says, where parents can "find out ways to encourage self-esteem in their children and find out more about alcohol and youth."

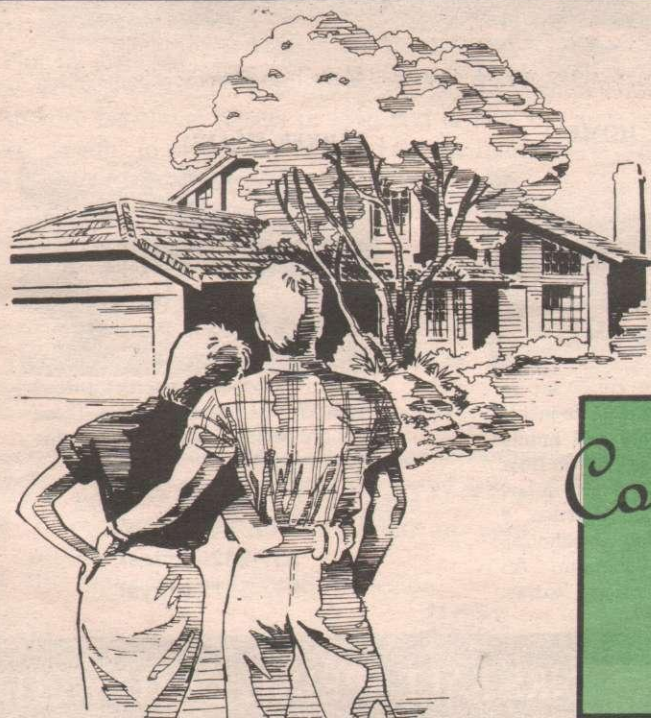
Magnusson adds that the program fills provincial education ministry requirements for a "learning for living curriculum" gradually being implemented in schools province-wide.

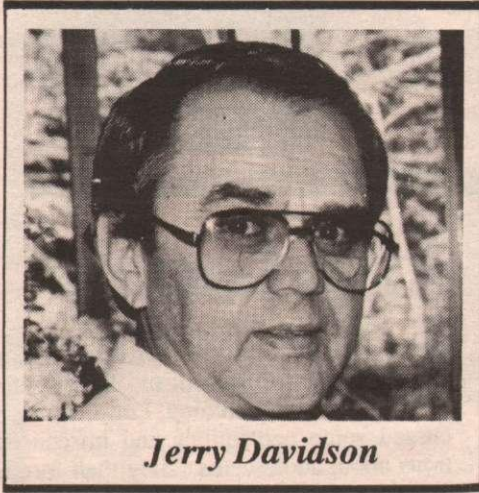

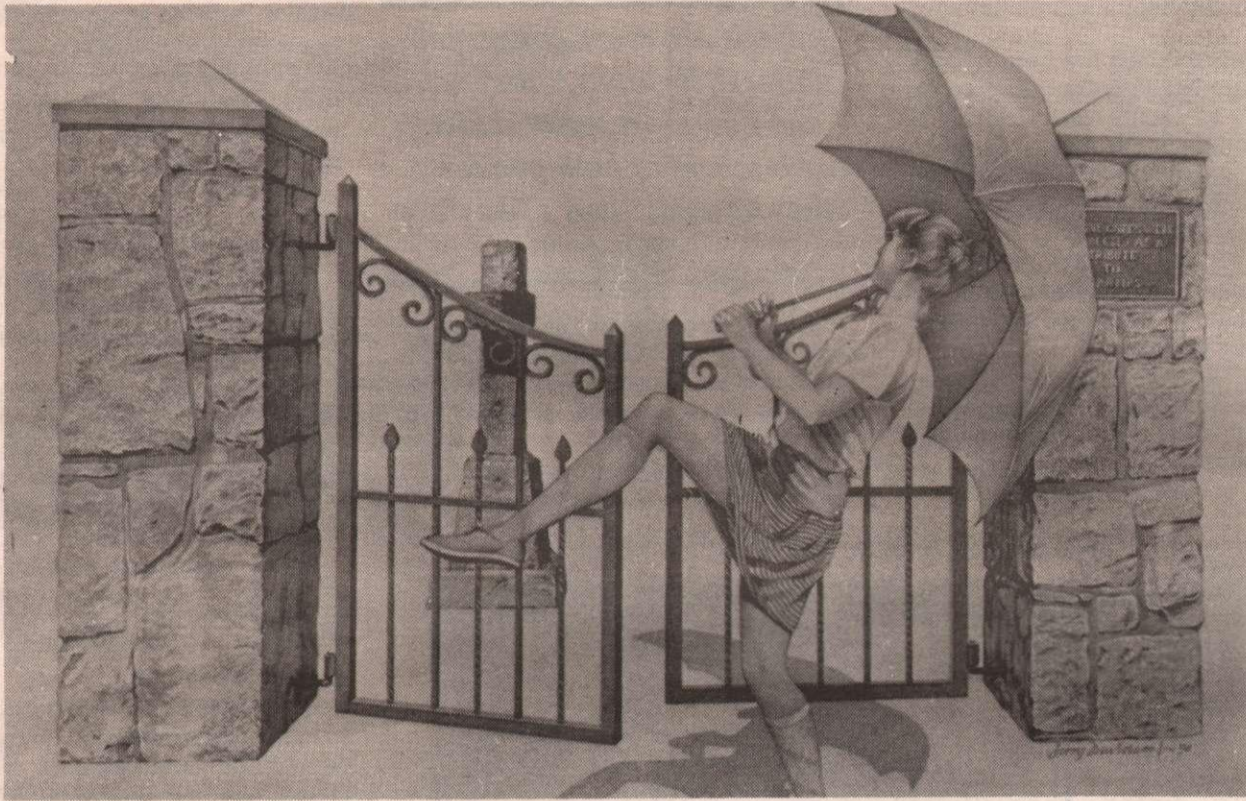
director of cinematography with the National Film Board and CBC.

He frequently uses the human figure as the central element of his compositions. Once a military pilot and commercial

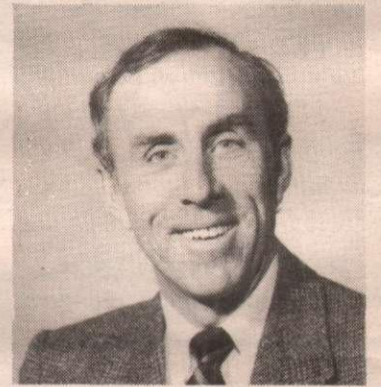

Water taxi safety concerns trustee

Saturna school trustee Lorraine Campbell is concerned for the safety of school children travelling to Salt Spring via water taxi.

With only one operator on each water taxi, she told a recent school board meeting, students travelling between islands could experience problems.

Campbell noted the water taxis are usually manned by only the driver. Students often fill in as the second crew member. Each boat should have a driver and a regular crew member, she stressed.

Jack Hughes of Gulf Islands Water Taxi holds the contract to taxi students to and from the Outer Gulf Islands and Salt Spring.

He indicated he is talking with the school board about the perceived problem and will respect its decision on the issue.

"Basically, we're willing to do anything within reason," he told the *Driftwood*.

Campbell further noted some students ride in the rear of the boat and could fall overboard in rough weather. Students ride the back deck of water taxis because smoking is not permitted in the cabins.

The second person could ensure the safety of the students as well as assist in docking the craft, Campbell concluded.

Ewes make British paper

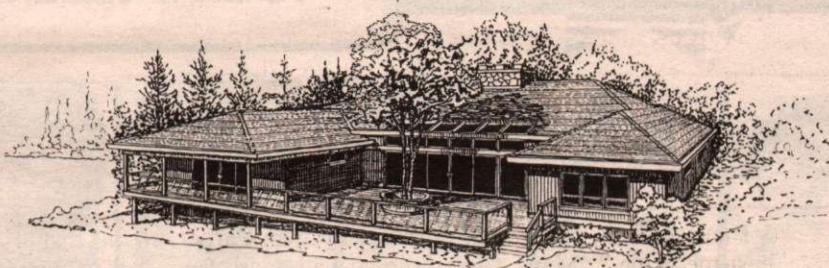
Sheep breeding relatives of Salt Spring's Charles Baseley had remarkable success after recent efforts on their Nottingham area farm.

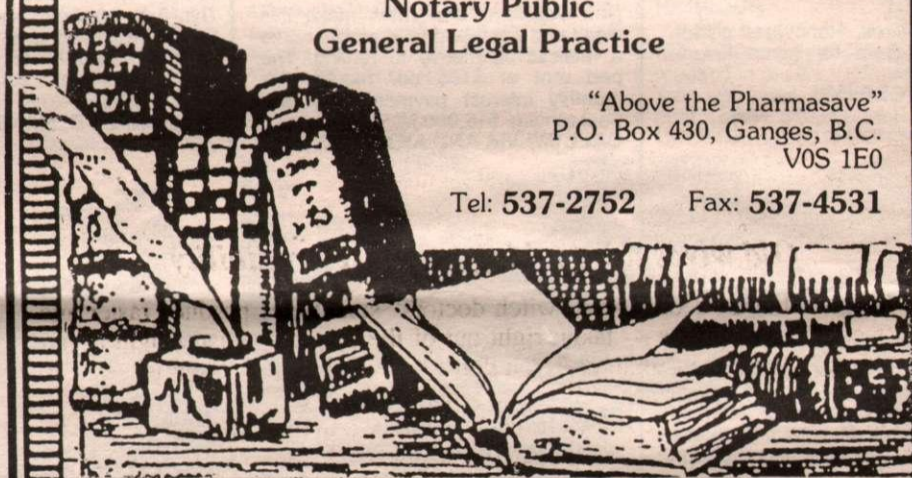

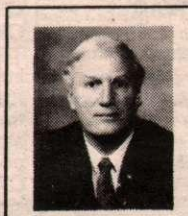

More beneficial ingredients hide on grocery shelves than are displayed on a pharmacy counter.

For decades now, ever since we went "modern," the medical profession has been advising on the beneficial aspects of "wonder" drugs. There is no doubt that many of them did eliminate numerous symptoms, ailments and diseases prevalent in bygone days. But now a growing number of experts in medical and other sciences, are returning to the slogan "you are what you eat".

A new Bantam book, *The Food Pharmacy* by Jean Carper, claims that "food is your best medicine." Many quotes shown below are from this publication. Grocery stores should be giving away this book with every \$100 food basket.

The new theories argue that if foods can affect the body in such unhealthy ways, as increasing cholesterol etc., then other foods can vastly improve bodily health. Scientific studies, especially from Japan, "have shown that foods are also full of powerful antimutagens that can neutralize the cancer threat".

Some may refer to latest trends as kooky

Japanese screening found broccoli, green pepper, pineapple, shallot, apple, ginger, cabbage and eggplant "remarkably effective" in blocking cancer — promoting cell mutations. Cauliflower, grapes, sweet potato and radishes were "moderately effective."

Some may refer to the latest trends as kooky, but increasingly the facts show that vegetarians "have lower rates of cancer, heart disease, stroke and a number of other chronic diseases than meat eaters".

Certain foods soon "will be prescribed and designed to dramatically improve health".

Dr. David Jenkins, University of Toronto professor and a leading expert on diet and blood sugar says (re combination therapy) "we have not yet realized that that is exactly what some foods are doing already — promoting a combination therapy of their own."

Others, like Dr. James Tillotson, head of research for Ocean Spray (cranberry juice) believe "that one day governments may insist on labelling not only nutrients in foods but also a food's total health effect based on solid studies of its pharmacological powers".

Old wives tales taking on more credibility

As one who has seen native "witch doctors" sometimes produce faster and more effective solutions — taken right out of the jungle — than taught at our so-called "advanced institutions," you don't have to sell me. Food is a potent, unpackaged (so far) medicine.

Other "scientists' adventures chronicle the food pharmacy's variegated possibilities of performance as anticoagulants, blood-clot dissolvers, cholesterol reducers, expectorants, prostaglandin-inhibitors (like aspirin), cancer blockers, antioxidants, antibiotics, antiviral agents, immune-system boosters and antibody manipulators."

"Old wives tales" are taking on more credibility and "are being transformed into new scientific facts." This book contains a fascinating number of remedies, including a black mushroom called mok yhee (Cantonese) with the same blood-thinning qualities as aspirin; the magic of onions; the yin-yang therapy of chili peppers; why food from the sea is sometimes superior to food from the land; nuts and seeds that surprise; how carrots can help "cure" cancer; cranberries' hidden antibiotic; and what's in wine, tea and yogurt that can be so helpful to human health.

Did you know that in a year "a single chicken can provide up to 30 kilograms of immunoglobulin": someday you may get your prescription in an eggnog?

Book may even save your life

That "just smelling apples can lower some people's blood pressure"? And why it helps when taking an aspirin to eat a banana first! That 300 years ago coffee was a medicine and not a beverage. Find out why the French put milk in their coffee and why "tests found that garlic was more powerful than penicillin and tetracycline."

Not far into the future, the line that currently divides food from medicine may diffuse or totally vanish. Now that genetic manipulation can add, increase or modify beneficial agents in food and drinks, the way is open to add even more "health" to everything required for the human diet. You can get ready — this book contains its own "Food Pharmacopoeia."

A well-planned trip to the grocery store may be the healthiest move you'll make all week.

This book is thoroughly interesting and contains much fascinating material. Try out a fraction of what's in there and at the very least you'll have a healthy gastronomic experience. It may even save your life.

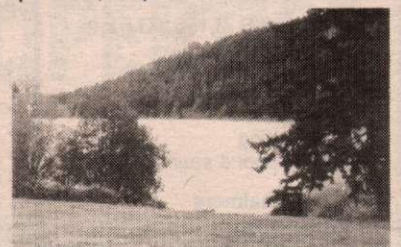

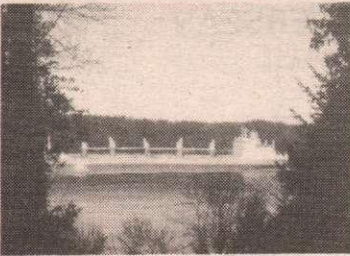

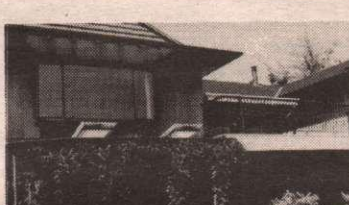
