### ArtCraft stage show inspires

Jewellery and more combined for special exhibit

It is easy to be enchanted at ArtCraft's current showcase exhibition.

The Precious Metals show brings together exquisite materials with innovative, creative designs.

Almost everyone will covet the jewellery crafted by many talented artists, but there are other treasures as well, including candelabras, wall pieces and sculptures.

Martin Ebbers, the master goldsmith behind Martinus Studio, was on hand yesterday morning polishing up his fine jewellery pieces.

Ebbers has been leading a more quiet life on Salt Spring for the past four years, coming from the bustle of international shows in Europe.

Recently, Ebbers has enjoyed working with 18-karat rose gold for the settings of his rings and earrings.

Rose gold, like regular 18K gold, is 75 per cent gold, but the remaining portion has a higher ratio of copper to silver. The result is a warm and rosy hue.

As Ebbers explained, "I just love the gentleness of the tone."

Ebbers also said rose gold looks very good on some skin tones, particularly people with red hair.

One of Ebbers' personal techniques is to combine metal tones with similarly coloured gemstones, rather than looking for a contrast. His pieces on display pair rose gold with a naturally coloured champagne diamond or soft kishi pearls, or white gold with greenish natural Tahitian pearls.

# Hot Cuban band kicks off Treasure Fair weekend

ArtSpring the place to be on Thursday night

Islanders can expect a night of hot and sultry, high energy dance music when Cuban band La Gran Union con Wil Campa comes to ArtSpring tomorrow (Thursday) night.

The brass and percussion salsa band plays the kind of music that has made the Cuban sound so exciting and appealing around the world and the ArtSpring show promises not to disappoint.

"It's amazing what comes over the transom sometimes," says ArtSpring executive director George Sipos, referring to the manner in which the band was booked.

"A woman who is bringing a major Cuban band to perform in Vancouver phones because she has run into Valdy, who said 'Why not perform on Salt Spring?' Next thing you know, ArtSpring is hosting a concert by a hot 13-piece band performing some of Cuba's best music."

The band is built around Wil Campa, one of Cuba's top younger generation song masters. Since his international debut in 1989 where he toured Europe, Canada and Latin America with the legendary band Maraca, Campa has had multiple successes.

"He has sung in the company of Winton Marsalis, Natalie Cole, Ibrahim Ferrer and the wonderfully named Jose Aleberto el Canario. One of his three CDs was nominated for an American Grammy award. And now he has his own band making its first Canadian tour."

After La Gran Union's June 21 performance at the Vancouver International Jazz Festival, critics Alexander Varty and Tony Montague called it "the best from the Vancouver International Jazz Festival so far."

According to the reviewers, Campa had the huge crowd in Gastown "on their feet cheering after almost two hours of hot Cuban dance music. Genial bandleader Campa, who has a sweet and powerful voice, proved a relentless animator for audience and musicians alike."

Thursday's 8 p.m. performance is timed to coincide with the ArtSpring Treasure Fair. Audience members are invited to tour through the galleries and bid on the over 480 items that comprise this year's fundraising extravaganza before the show and during the intermission.

Tickets are available in advance through the ArtSpring Ticket Centre (250-537-2102) or at the door one hour before the start of the show.

# Nostalgia and yearning at next M&M

Rook performs Schubert and Chopin

Pianist Simon Rook takes centre stage at Music and Munch on Wednesday, July 23, with a moving program that complements his skill and versatility.

A well-established member of the island's arts community, Rook has delighted audiences with concerts ranging from ragtime to the romantics.

Since his membership on the first ArtSpring board, he has contributed to its ongoing success and has encouraged and supported musical ventures in the community.

Wednesday's program contains pieces by Schubert and Chopin that move away from the sort of virtuosic pieces found in some of Rook's past lunchtime recitals.

Nevertheless, the program is not easy, for the Schubert pieces are considered to be some of the most difficult to interpret in the entire piano repertoire.

By coincidence, all the pieces were written at the end of the composers' lives or have a nostalgic farewell to them.

The longest piece is Schubert's last sonata in B flat, written only weeks before he died. He never heard it and it wasn't published until 10 years later. Rook will be playing the first two move-

ments. Rook will also play from Schubert's OP.90 impromptu in A flat, sometimes called the "waterfall impromptu" because of its cascading arpeggios in the right hand.

It was also written about a year before the composer's death and contains a middle section full of yearning.

The two Chopin pieces are the so-called "adieu" or "farewell" waltz in A flat and the great C minor nocturne, OP48 No.1, which is one of Chopin's longest, finest and almost certainly the most anguished of his nocturnes.

The free music begins at 12:10 p.m. at All Saints, followed by an optional lunch for \$5.50.

One set of pearl drop earrings combines peach cultured pearls with a rose gold ring, separated by a tiny white pearl to highlight the warmer tones.

Michael Surman is a long-time Salt Spring resident and a silversmith trained in England.

His pair of candelabra with twisted ropes of silver were fashioned by a very old and time-consuming technique, one that Ebbers said only three or four other people in Canada know how to do.

Surman also has a set of mushroom-topped lamps on display, which make use of bronze and copper shades and stained glass panels. One lamp has a driftwood stem, while another is made from arbutus.

The shades in some ways recall a Tiffany lamp with its panels of stained glass, but in Surman's pieces the jewel-toned segments are just small windows in the polished metal.

This allows for the copper or bronze to take centre stage as a fine worked material, while the glass panels let pockets of light shine magically through.

Karin Marita Jones brings an ancient technique into the modern age with her pieces in Damascene Inlay. The method of inlaying precious metals into steel was commonly used in the past on weapons and armour, known from Japan to Toledo, Spain.

Jones has retained some of the technique's history in her unusual designs; a bracelet cuff in blackened steel is inlaid with a skull and branches, while another has a pile of bones and a single heart.

Many other interesting creations in precious metals appear at ArtCraft's stage gallery through July 24.

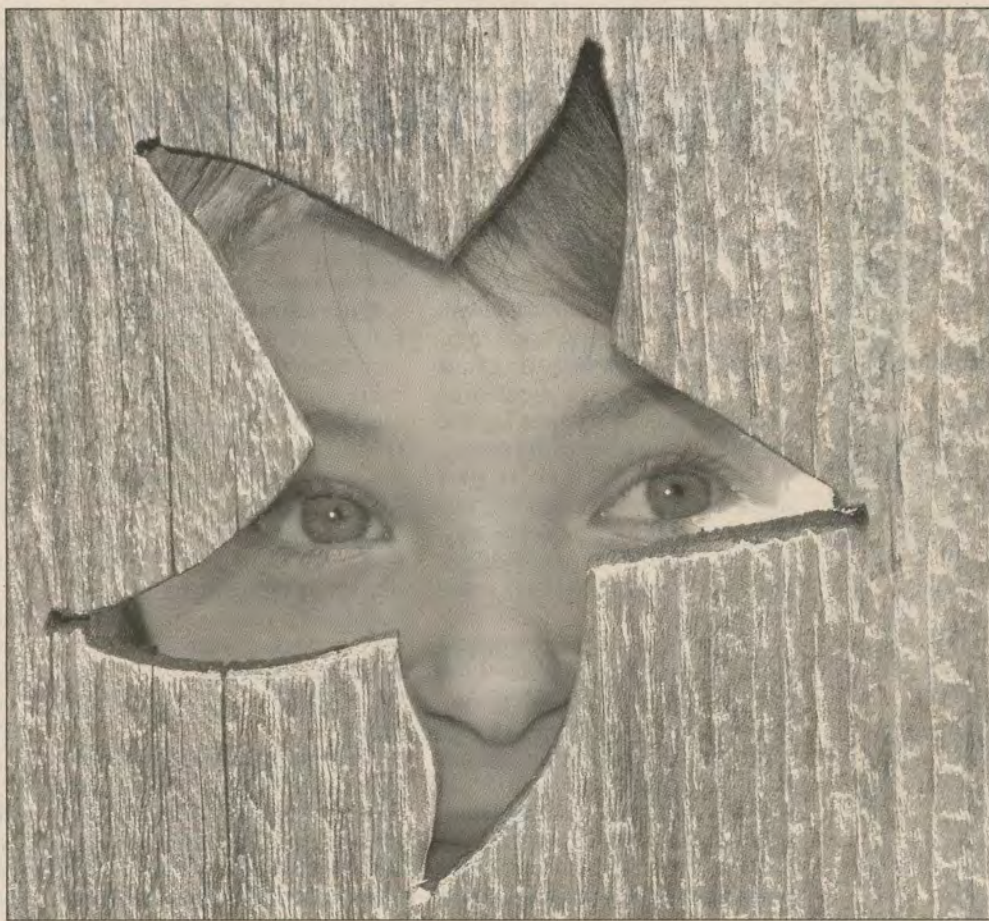

# Afro-Cuban drumming set

Jose Sanchez leads July 29-31 session

Cuban master percussionist Jose Sanchez is sharing his years of experience and passion for his craft in a three-day workshop set for Salt Spring Island.

During the July 29-31 workshop, people can immerse themselves in the origins of Afro-Cuban music and Cuban folklore through learning various styles of percussion.

A workshop for people of all skill levels, it runs from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on the three days.

Sanchez, who now lives on Salt Spring, began his studies in percussion at Manuel Saumell School of Music at the age of 11. He graduated with honours as a musician and teacher from the Amadeo Roldan Conservatory in Havana.

He has participated as percussionist and producer in many recordings in different parts of the world.

He has toured extensively through South America, North America and Europe with big Cuban groups and with the Puentes Brothers, Juno award winner Alex Cuba and Canadian pop singer Amanda Marshall.

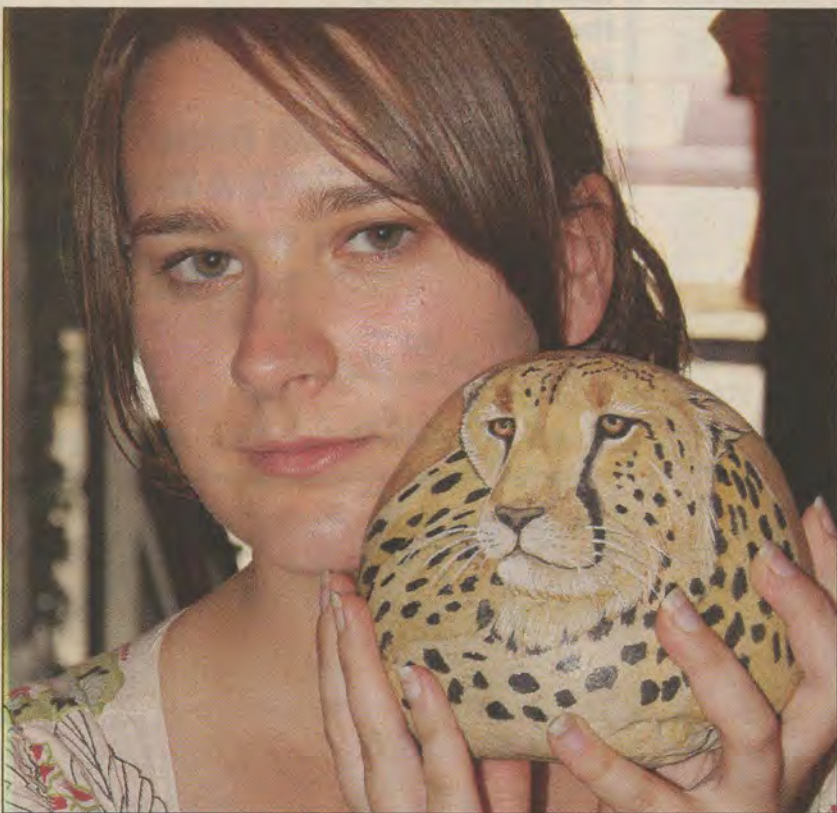

# Top folk musicians at ArtSpring

Part of arts centre's Summer Strings Series

Jaime RT's Collaboratopia will be a concert of new and traditional folk music featuring four of the West Coast's most outstanding folk musicians in one joyful evening of inspired music.

The concert, which is part of ArtSpring's Summer Strings series, hits the stage on Friday, July 25. It will feature fiddles, piano, accordion, guitar, voice and trumpet.

"It will be a very exceptional musical evening, and one of the things I am really looking forward to is celebrating the folk tradition's longstanding history of making music together — this time on stage!" states Jaime RT in a recent press release.

"It will be a bit of an 'old world meets new world' night . . . we

will play in various configurations throughout the evening, from duos to trios and of course as a dynamic four-piece."

The evening will feature a special set of Oliver Schroer's music, "as a tip of the hat to this brilliant man whom we all knew, loved and deeply admired," as well as traditional Celtic fiddle tunes, jazz songs and new music from the West Coast.

Performing in the concert will be Daniel Lapp (fiddle, trumpet, piano), a Victoria-based internationally renowned folk and jazz musician, who has played on stages all over the world with some of the world's finest musicians.

Jaime RT (fiddola) is Salt Spring's own internationally touring folk artist and two-time CFMA nominee, touring with Andy Hillhouse and the James Keelaghan Trio.

Hillhouse (guitar, voice) from Vancouver is a Juno winning artist with The McDades, Mad Pudding and Jaime RT.

The July 25 concert takes place at 8 p.m.

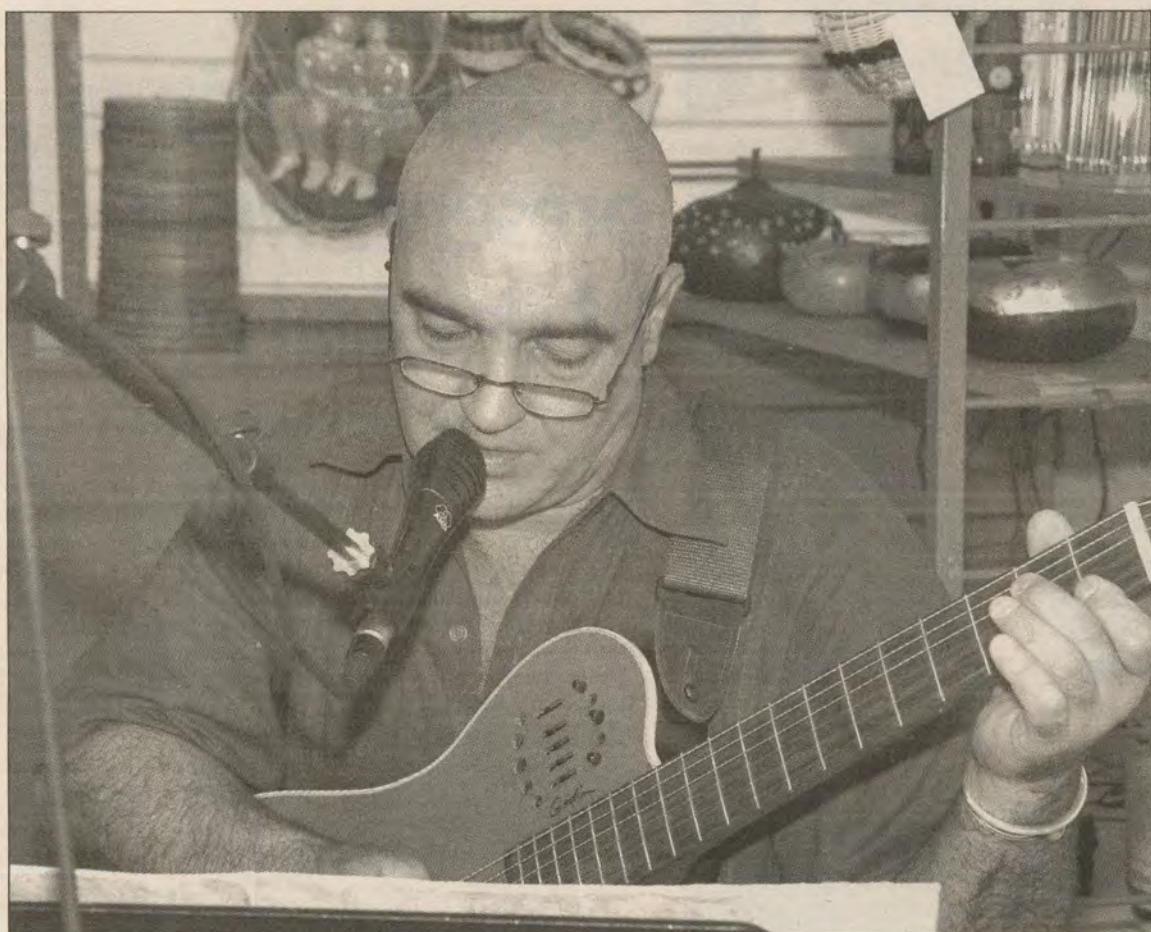

# Ed Peekeekoot nominated for four Aboriginal People's Choice awards

Performs Sunday with Alan Moberg at Tree House Cafe

Islanders can join a movement to vote for Crofton musician Ed Peekeekoot's In the Key of Cree CD in the first run-off of the 2008 Aboriginal People's Choice Music Awards.

Peekeekoot is a frequent performer on Salt Spring Island, and will be at the Tree House Cafe on Sunday, July 20 with his good friend Alan Moberg.

According to a press release, Peekeekoot's CD is being considered for Best Country CD and Best Album Cover Design, while he is up for Aboriginal Entertainer of the Year and Best Songwriter in the awards that will be held in Winnipeg this November in conjunction with the Manito ahbee Festival.

Three tracks are being featured. "Wild Lilies to Wheat Fields tells about the time of transition for his people with the move onto reservations and learning a new way of providing for their families — farming," states the release. "This changed their

relationship with the land and with themselves, and people still know who they are."

Jiggin' is an instrumental piece. "I come from a family of fiddlers," Peekeekoot said. "My grandmother was a little Metis woman who would do a jig around the kitchen while my uncles played. Prairie dances were a highlight of the summer."

Dance of the Northern Lights is also an instrumental. Cree legends say that the northern lights are the spirits of the ancestors.

The first round of voting runs from July 8-Aug. 15. Registration is free to anyone wishing to cast a ballot at <http://www.aboriginalpeopleschoice.com/signup>.

In the Key of Cree was #1 on the Top 30 chart at CHLY, Nanaimo, and #10 in the folk/roots/blues chart at CFUV, University of Victoria radio. It has been receiving CBC airplay from B.C. to Saskatchewan.

Some of Peekeekoot's live performances in B.C. this summer include the Islands Folk Festival at Providence

Farm, Duncan, the Abbotsford Agrifair, the North American Indigenous Games in Duncan and the Armstrong Interior Provincial Exhibition and Rodeo.

# Summer Strings presents week of classical music

Performers play at ArtSpring, Mount Maxwell and park

The week of July 21 to 26 marks the launch of a brand new music project at ArtSpring: the Salt Spring Chamber Music Festival — Summer Strings 2008.

"The long title attempts to capture two separate ambitions," explained ArtSpring executive director George Sipos.

"The first is to bring together string players, both accomplished professionals and young emerging talent, for a week's residency to play their hearts out as string quartets, piano trios, quintets and larger ensembles. The second is to have this residency grow in future years into a larger summer festival of chamber music beyond just the string repertoire."

For now, the week will include intensive tutoring of the younger players by the professionals, masterclasses other musicians are invited to watch, three public concerts, a free sunset concert on top of Mount Maxwell and a Saturday morning concert by the students at the gazebo in Centennial Park.

The week's activities have been designed and organized by David Visentin, dean of the Young Artists Performance Academy at the Royal Conservatory of Music in Toronto. Visentin is a regular summer resident of Salt Spring who has performed at ArtSpring for several years with an ensemble made up of friends and colleagues from Toronto, Barcelona and Salt Spring.

"This is such an exciting opportunity both for established musicians and especially for young players," said Visentin. "A week devoted to the finest music in congenial surroundings. I can see this as the beginning of a major annual summer event on Salt Spring."

Summer Strings 2008 participants are:

- The Emily Carr Quartet from Victoria, made up of musicians from the Victoria Symphony.

They will be part of the first public concert on Tuesday, July 22, playing a Schubert quartet and then joining with the David Visentin ensemble in the Mendelssohn string octet, and finally joining with all the participants in the festival to present a Mozart piano concerto.

- The David Visentin Ensemble, which includes Salt Spring's own cellist Paula Kiffner as well as David Visentin, Hiroko Kagawa, Kai Gluesteen and pianist Catherine Ordroneau, will perform their own concert on Saturday, July 26.

with the music of Beethoven and Dvorak.

- The student participants in the festival include the Divertente Quartet, made up of four hugely talented teenaged players from the Victoria Conservatory, a fine young Canadian cellist currently studying in Barcelona, Salt Spring cellist Rylan Gajek and violinist/violist Sarah Lundy, and pianist Bryna Visentin. The students will present their own concert on Thursday, July 24.

- Tickets for the public concerts are available from the ArtSpring Ticket Centre, either singly, or as part of a \$50 festival package, which includes all three concerts plus Jaime RT's Friday evening performance of fiddle music with Daniel Lapp, Adrian Dolan and Andy Hillhouse.

On Wednesday evening at 7 p.m., people are invited to the top of Mount Maxwell to hear some members of the David Visentin ensemble and the student participants in the residency play music against the backdrop of sea and sky and Vancouver Island.

"The musicians will play on the cliff-top and the audience can sit on the rocks or bring folding chairs if they wish," said Spos, "The place is irresistibly beautiful. What better place for Bach?"

On Saturday, July 26, the students will play for an hour between 11 a.m. and noon at the gazebo in Centennial Park.

Masterclasses open to the public will be held at ArtSpring on Friday, July 24 at 9 and 11:30 a.m.

Six athletes to represent Salt Spring at B.C. Summer Games in Kelowna

The number of Salt Spring Island youth headed to the summer games got a little higher last week with announcements that basketball player Adrian Alonso and soccer star Lukas Wenzel will be heading to Kelowna.

Alonso and Wenzel will join four other Salt Spring islanders, whose names were announced earlier this month.

The athletes leave for the Okanagan next week to compete in four days of compe-

tion at the B.C. Summer Games, running from July 24 to 27.

## Time to put a stop to the NHL-KHL feud

Who would have thought that the sport of hockey would ever be on the brink of disaster, with a war brewing between the two largest and most powerful hockey leagues on the entire planet?

The National Hockey League (NHL) has always been the cornerstone of hockey worldwide, providing an opportunity for players from various countries to showcase their skills as professional hockey players. But ever since the Russian Super League (RSL) disbanded to make way for a new league known as the Continental Hockey League (KHL), there has been some serious concern as to the state of the players in the NHL and the threat of having those players being lured away for tax-free, big-money contracts in Russia.

The NHL-KHL feud began when Pittsburgh Penguins superstar and former RSL player Evgeni Malkin left Russia to play in the NHL while still under contract

with his former club, Metallurg Magnitogorsk. Metallurg filed a lawsuit against the NHL and the Penguins, stating that since Malkin was still under contract in Russia, he should not be permitted to play in the NHL. In February 2007 the case was dismissed and Malkin has since enjoyed huge success as a member of the Penguins.

The KHL didn't let the Malkin ordeal go and instead began offering massive contracts to a number of NHL superstars in order to lure them to Russia. In June 2008, reports suggested that several Russian clubs were willing to sign Malkin to a monstrous multi-year deal worth about \$12.5 million a season, but

the Russian superstar decided to stay with the Penguins as he had signed a five-year deal worth \$43.5 million. As recently as last week, one of the NHL's most elusive and famed players, Jarmir Jagr, announced that he would be leaving North America to go play for Avangard Omsk of the KHL. Jagr was not the only player from the NHL that would seek greener pastures in Russia — former Ottawa Senators goaltender Ray Emery also waved goodbye to the NHL as he signed a one-year deal with Atlant Mytishchi. Jagr and Emery are just two high profile players that have been swooped up by the KHL but a substantial amount of others have also been brought to Russia.

On June 10, 2008, it was announced that the NHL and KHL had made peace as the KHL agreed to stop threatening the NHL by offering its players massive contracts. This agreement was tested a mere day after it had been set as Nashville Predators forward Alexander Radulov stated that he would like to leave Nashville to go and play in Russia where he would sign a deal worth a total of \$13 million (tax free).

The twist? Radulov has one year left on his contract with the Predators and is legally obliged to complete his time

in the NHL before accepting any offers from the KHL. On the Predators website, a statement was issued saying that Radulov still has a year left on his contract and he will be playing for Nashville in the upcoming 2008-2009 season.

So now this puts both leagues in an awkward situation; the NHL is getting a taste of its own medicine as they took Malkin out of the RSL in the same fashion that the KHL is trying to take Radulov. But unluckily for the KHL, Radulov's contract is crystal clear and states that he must complete one more year with the Predators before signing elsewhere, while Malkin's contract was apparently a result of the immense psychological pressure his former club put on him, thus making it easier to get out of. But then again, what's to stop Radulov from claiming the same thing?

Whatever the case may be, the fact remains that these two leagues have a problem with each other and the sooner they clear it up, the sooner everyone can sit back and enjoy hockey in both North America and in Russia.

So my message to the NHL and KHL? Stop the nonsense and bickering and let's play some hockey!

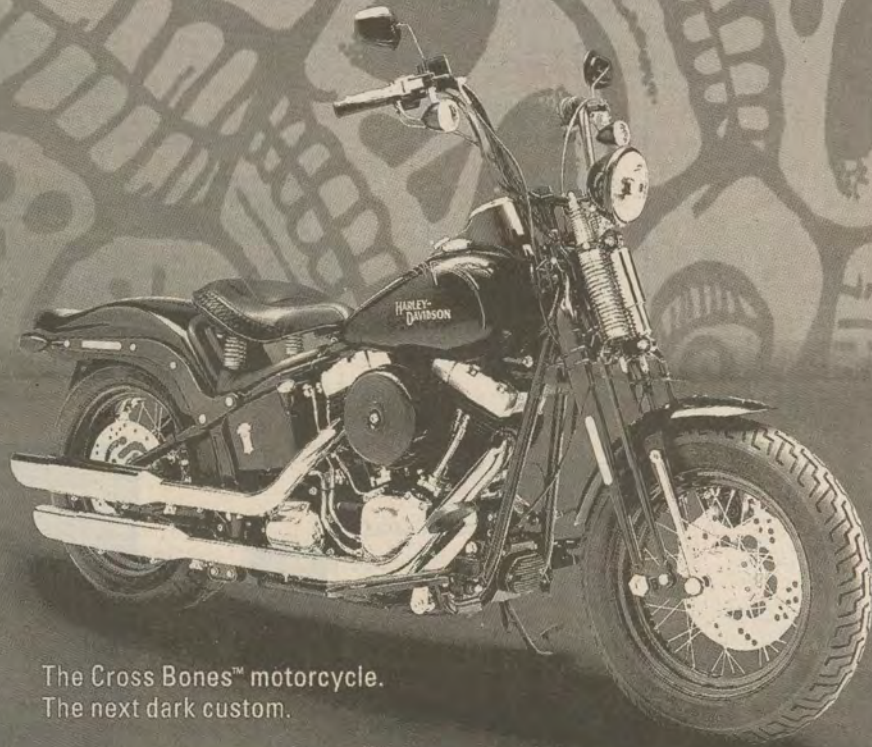

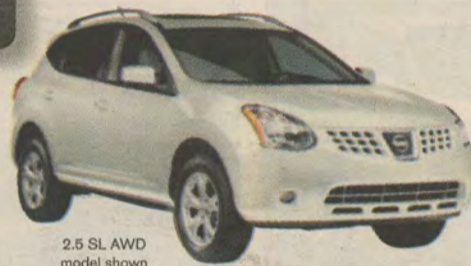

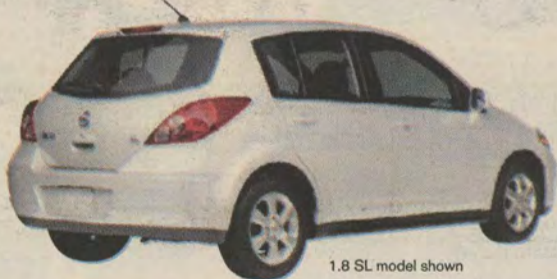

Vehicle owner Tim Duke, who purchased the truck as an investment around six weeks ago, confirmed the custom-built machine is a hit wherever it goes.

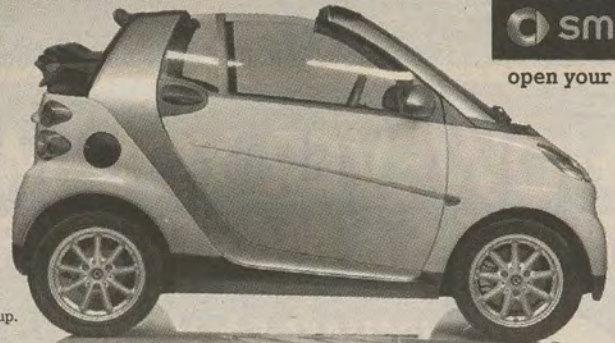

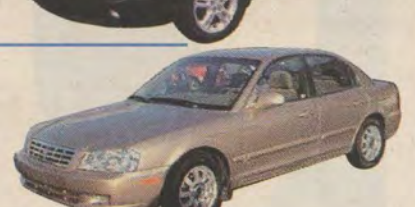

# Glitter man makes everything shine

Bruce Bensmiller has a passion for straightening and polishing

Almost exactly 52 years ago, then 17-year-old Vancouver-born Bruce Bensmiller was trying to raise \$25 to buy a worn-out 1940 Dodge sedan. When he couldn't scrape the cash together, his father suggested he make a trade.

Bensmiller offered the car owner a record player and the deal was sealed.

That transaction set the course for Bensmiller to restore the 1940 Dodge and many other cars over the years. And it also set in motion Bensmiller's ongoing contribution to the car restoration hobby. Bensmiller is the glitter man.

You see it right away when you lift the hood of the suburban Langley resident's 1948 Chevrolet street rod. This isn't the original "Blue Flame" six-cylinder engine residing there. Power comes from a high-performance 383-cubic-inch Chevrolet V8 motor that just drips in chrome and polished aluminum. The customized engine compartment reflects Bensmiller's passion for straightening and polishing aluminum and stainless steel automotive components.

Modern vehicles don't use stainless steel the way it adorned the cars of the '50s and beyond. For example, Bensmiller's 50-year-old Chevy was delivered new with

stainless steel grille bars, stone guards on the rear fenders and rocker panel moldings along the lower edge of the car.

Typically, stainless steel trim on a car this old is banged up, creased and possibly twisted. Bensmiller painstakingly straightens all the pieces. Then he gets to work picking and filing the dents and creases. What follows is smoothing the surfaces with a grinder and varying grades of sandpaper before final polishing with a buffing wheel.

Many of the pieces Bensmiller works on for classic car and streetrod enthusiasts are difficult to replace or impossible to find. This includes side moldings, grille pieces, interior moldings and wheel discs that have been damaged when errant drivers have hit curbs. The results of his work are stunning: Stainless steel that glitters and shines and looks brand new.

Bensmiller turned his hobby of straightening and polishing metal into a home business a number of years ago. His expertise is known far and wide, resulting in custom work coming to him from as far away as the southern United States.

Stainless steel is defined as an iron-carbon alloy with more than 10 per cent chromium content. As the name implies, it doesn't stain, corrode or rust as easily as ordinary steel. In short, it ages well. And Bruce Bensmiller knows how to make it look like new — an artistry that started with the restoration of the 1940 Dodge 50 years ago.

Back then, Bensmiller had a

weekend job in a body shop and learned how to work with metal. He applied that to the restoration of his first car with a lot of help from his father, who was head mechanic for forest giant Mac-Millan Bloedel.

When it came to the restoration of the stainless steel components of the old car, young Bensmiller applied the same techniques

he had learned in the body shop: Hammer out the dents. Then grind and sand the stainless steel until it is smooth. Polishing is the final step to gleaming stainless steel car ornamentation.

He has polished everything from wheel-opening moldings to a kitchen sink. The kitchen sink was a stainless steel model from a vintage Chris-Craft boat.

Bensmiller also applies his polishing skills to aluminum to make it shine like chrome — the same as the stainless steel he works on. He has done entire automatic transmission cases, engine heads, intake manifolds, exhaust headers and carburetors.

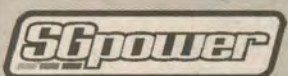
The polishing under the hood of his vintage Chevy is a moving billboard for his work.
