# Printmaking past and present uncovered at Steffich Fine Art

Hames' collection illuminates complex art form

The work of art in the age of mechanical reproduction is a quandary that has occupied many artists and theorists. Walter Benjamin's much-cited essay of 1936 on that subject looked at reproduction as a way of freeing art from bourgeois power structures and politicizing its intent.

Others have taken a less optimistic slant, seeing mass reproduction as removing art's authenticity and rendering it merely commercial.

Vancouver Island artist Michael Hames, who is represented on Salt Spring by Steffich Fine Art, has a new exhibition at that gallery that seeks to educate the public on what an original artist's print is and on the diverse forms of printmaking. Hames has brought over his own collection of historical prints as well as a new series of work by himself to help with this goal.

There are many forms of printmaking, from etching to silk screening to wood block reliefs, but the common thread in an artist's print is that he or she creates both the surface image and the final result. Transferring ink or paint from wood, metal, screen or other to paper, cloth, etc., the artist is deeply involved in a hands-on process of creation. Traditional runs of such prints can be just a few or a few hundred, but generally speaking, the fewer the number produced the greater the value of each print.

Mass-produced copies of original artworks, however, take the process out of the artist's hands completely.

### ARTBEAT ON THE ROCK

These "prints" usually have little value beyond their copyright.

To emphasize printmaking as a respected art form with great history, Hames has brought examples that date back to the 1800s and include masters from Japan, Europe and North America.

In his own work, Hames has taken his stand further by producing just one print

in each run, with the exception of two runs of four. Hames has frequently used the monoprint technique, in which a flat surface coated with oil or ink is passed through an etching press — rendering it unusable after the first time.

In subject matter Hames has proved that anything is possible in printmaking. Some of his pieces are simply beautiful, and in keeping with his other recent work. Prints that look at the female form or at landscapes with a loving eye employ a nostalgic, old-world quality of light also seen in his oil paintings.

In others, Hames brings in a political side, reflecting some of the historical uses

of print methods used to comment on issues of social justice.

Ponderous Gluttony is Hames' most up-front political piece, as a portrait of a hugely fat, shirtless man smoking a cigarette. The U.S. flag tattooed over his breast leaves no doubt as to where this critique is aimed; the figure stares out without shame but with total contempt for anyone who would comment on his unhealthy ways. It's a bold piece without any attempt at subtlety, but strangely compelling, too.

Pipeline Prisoners is one of the only pieces to have more than one print. This linocut has the stark power of a woodblock print in its alternating black and white. Four figures in robes and turbans toil at work, their backs to the viewer. Its title reveals they are the modern slaves to our consumption madness, while the image itself resonates with its simplicity.

Stealing Paradise appears to be a commentary on homelessness. A shaggy older man wearing a big backpack is holding some kind of fancy game bird, staring out of hooded eyes with wariness. His attitude is vulnerable yet defensive, ready to take flight into the shadows.

Dead End is one that bridges the landscape and the political, making some scattered parking barriers and oil tanks look quite lovely.

The First Annual Exhibition of Prints and Printmakers continues at Steffich Fine Art until Sept. 11. Make sure to allow lots of time to examine the historical prints, which are accompanied by detailed information about the artists and their techniques.

# Stagecraft class teaches secret theatre language

Weekly sessions lead to Stagecoach show production

A new course offered by Stagecoach Theatre School will give Salt Spring teens a chance to acquire practical skills as they learn the art of stagecraft, the behind the scenes technical work without which the show cannot go on.

Intended for students aged 14 and up, Stagecraft will introduce them to the magic of theatre, including stage lighting, sound and special effects.

Led by ArtSpring's technical director Marv Coulthard, the new Stagecraft course will provide the opportunity for students to learn about theatrical lighting, sound and sound effects, both live and recorded, set design, costuming and backstage management.

Students will receive hands-on training throughout the year and put their skills to the test by producing the year-end performances for the school's Mainstage and Spotlight classes.

The course will also teach them the secret language

of the theatre, as they learn about stage directions and find out about germans, ghost lights, grids, flygalleries, sandbags, and the difference between a leg and a Leko.

They will also come to know whether greenrooms are really green, and why they are so important in the theatrical world.

Stagecraft teacher Coulthard has over 45 years of experience as a technician working in the television, film and theatre industry. For 20 years, Marv worked as an audio engineer for CBC television and for 10 years was a supervising technician at CBC North television.

For much of the last 15 years he has shifted his focus to live theatre. Holding professional certification as an electronics technician, in pyrotechnics, and as an Occupational Health and Safety Act-certified theatrical rigger, Coulthard is well-versed in all technical aspects of film, television and theatre.

Students in the Stagecraft class may be able to meet arts and/or practical skills requirements of the new British Columbia Ministry

of Education high school graduation program through participation in this course. School counsellors will have more details.

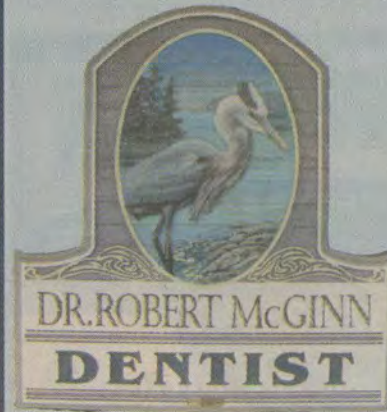

# History, myth collide in new book

Ron Wright releases 'What is America?'

"History is the best guide we have for threading our way through the frenetic video game of current events," says Salt Spring writer Ronald Wright in his new book, *What is America?* A Short History of the New World Order as he describes how cultural myths both define and delude the United States from the past to the present.

Wright's argument that "the New World made the modern world and now threatens to undo it" is firmly seated in America's sordid history of invasion, slavery, genocide,

Christian fundamentalism and corporate expansion. Sure, many other countries commit shameless acts, but none work as hard as the United States to repackage its history to match its idealistic image of itself as a beacon of freedom and democracy. Like the ancient shell game, America has managed to say one thing but do quite the other.

To really understand America and why its belief system is how it is today, Wright follows its record of expansion beginning from the pre-contact Americas. Gold plundered from the Aztec and Inca empires provided the capital for further European expansion, and inspired an insatiable European appetite for more. The idea that the New World was a limitless bounty available for the "civilized, God-fearing pioneer" or the "brave adventurer" still wreaks havoc today, spearheaded by a corporate-controlled government and the "American dream."

Since the days of the Puritans, fundamentalism continues to hold sway in America today. Wright says, "[M]any in the U.S., like their Puritan forbears, are so certain they are privy to the Almighty's intentions that they are willing to help him carry them out: some in the positive ways of altruism; others in bigotry and on the battlefield."

Fundamentalism creates a heady brew of entitlement (humans are privy to God's word) and justification for war (between good and evil). Demonization and/or dehumanization is necessary for the ruling class to steal and murder without feeling guilty.

"Greed is dressed as philanthropy," says Wright, and

every attempt to mislead people reveals "a moral insecurity about the basis of white tenure."

America has always had the vocabulary to explain itself, from spreading democracy to liberating people (in oil-rich countries), to saving souls, but underneath it all is a failure of ideals. Wright peels away nationalist sentiment and uncovers a history that has continuously been misrepresented in classrooms and in politics, spread by a corporate media, and embraced by people suffering from historical amnesia.

"All who delve into American history have to contend with a language of misnomer and condescension," says Wright, and he adds an illuminating example of the power of language in creating our reality—that it's all about how you spin it: "the school histories call all white victories, battles, and all Indian victories, massacres . . . White men who rise to protect their property are called patriots—Indians who do the same are called murderers."

Wright's straightforward assessment of the most powerful single nation currently acting on the world stage is based on extensive scholarship, seamlessly ordered in a book that is not only well informed but informs well.

He's done it before. As the writer of *A Short History of Progress* and a speaker at the prestigious 2004 Massey Lectures, Wright was able to trace the current patterns of farming and industrialization starting from the Stone Age and keep it short. Does that mean Wright has the tendency to be reductive? No, it means he makes things clear. Speaking plainly is refreshing in this age of politi-

cal posturing, sensationalism and sound bites. Moreover, Wright enriches the traditional path of linear history to a more composite search for truth which involves alternative perspectives, causes and effects, connections between events, and attention to people other than white male Europeans.

Though changing cultural myths seems a colossal step, too wide for people to accept, Wright does provide an example in the "big, bumbling, yet remarkably successful attempt to find a new way forward: the European Union . . . [growing] from tribalism, fanaticism and militarism, and towards a new commonwealth built not on the threat of war but on its memory."

Wright suggests that the only choice we have is a new world order based on knowledge of the past and attention to a sustainable future.

Perhaps the paradox that is America—a "peace-loving country at war almost constantly for 400 years; a nation both well-meaning and rapacious, welcoming and suspicious, devout and materialistic, friendly and fearful, innocent and corrupt . . ."—shows that there are possibilities for change, that the paradox means America hasn't quite grown into itself yet but could given the right leadership and a majority population able to reason.

From the first invasion of Europeans on the North American continent to the fear-mongering politics of America today, one of the bright lights amidst chaos is work such as Ronald Wright's.

Salt Spring Books hosts Wright's book launch at ArtSpring this Saturday, Aug. 30 at 7 p.m.





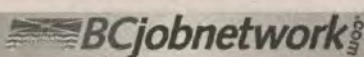
