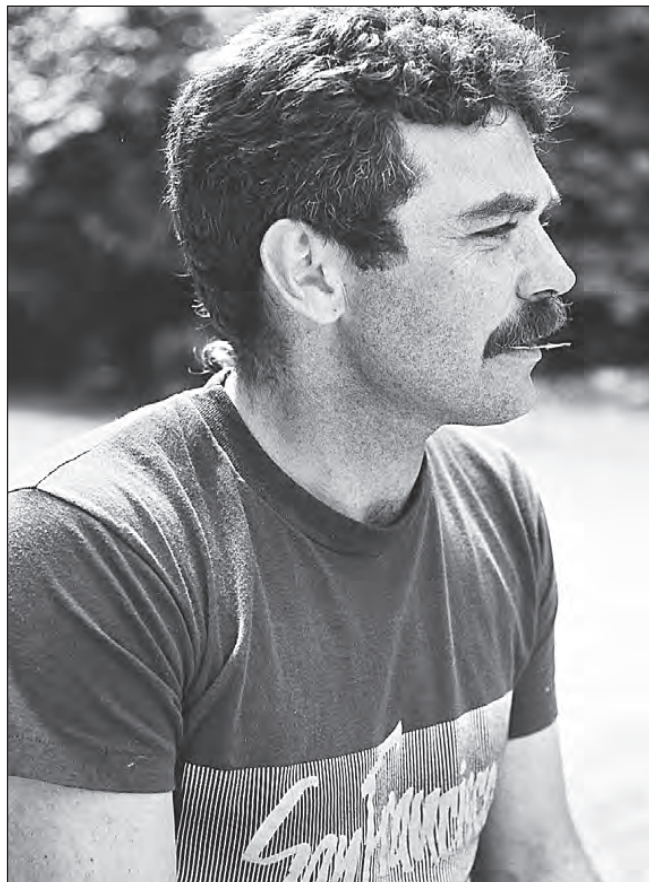

## From newbie to Driftwood cameraman . . . 20 years later



**June 17, 1992:** Photographer Derrick Lundy at Sea Capers just a few years after he started shooting for the Driftwood.

The first time Derrick Lundy held a camera it was mine.

It was 1986 and we were in Tofino, where I was writing a story on whale-watching excursions. I tossed him my trusty Yashica and said, "You be the cameraman."

Onboard now as a "photographer," Derrick's every movement was closely monitored. When he aimed my camera at the horizon, half a dozen other cameras lifted in the same direction. One wily, would-be photographer came in for a closer look, noticed the Yashica was set on "automatic" and asked for an explanation. Derrick said something convincing and soon everyone's camera was re-set to automatic.

Surprising to me back then — but not today — Derrick's whale photos were great. So in 1989 he was asked to point that fledgling photographic skill into periodic shoots for the Driftwood. Twenty years later — and more than a quarter million photographs — Derrick's camera eye has captured a visual history of Salt Spring Island.

A selection of those images is featured in the 28 pages of this edition, created in celebration of Derrick's 20 years as the Driftwood photographer.

Looking back through catalogues of his photographs, one relives almost-forgotten island news: the protests, fires, plane and car accidents, rescues and bizarre events like a man set in concrete to avoid eviction.

Then there are the children — whose joy and innocence have always inspired Derrick's camera eye — forever captured in the moment, many of them now adults with children of their own.

Over the course of those 20 years, Derrick and I married, had two children and separated amicably. But through the entire period, I worked as his photo editor and remain one of his biggest fans. Every Monday I sift through 200-500 of his photographs, selecting the images that will run in the Driftwood and

lamenting the fact so many will never be seen by the public.

In Derrick's time at the Driftwood, I estimate he has taken over 350,000 photographs: first using black and white film and bringing them to life in the darkroom; eventually interspersing some colour film and today, of course, shooting everything digitally in colour.

Most amazing to me, as I flip through the stacks and stacks of binders and computers discs that contain Derrick's repertoire, is his ability to shoot the same event, year after year, with undying enthusiasm and a persistent search for new angles.

In more concrete terms, this means Derrick has shot the fall fair close to 20 times (including over 500 images each year for at least the last decade). He has photographed about 20 versions of Christmas Light-up, where the Santa climbing off the floatplane has changed, but the photographer has not.

I have also been amused and impressed over the years to scan Derrick's photographs and see just what he can get people to do for the camera. This is a gift. Derrick has the ability to make people relax, to find the real "them" and capture on film the precise moment they "let go."

Many of Derrick's images have won newspaper awards and all of these are included in this special edition. Each of the past 20 years is represented here; although the photographs are not offered chronologically. Some images have been selected for their news quality; some for who they depict and others for sheer beauty. Many of these are among Derrick's favourites.

To this day, he says, he can look at each photograph and recall the moment he took it — therefore many are included with anecdotal quotes.

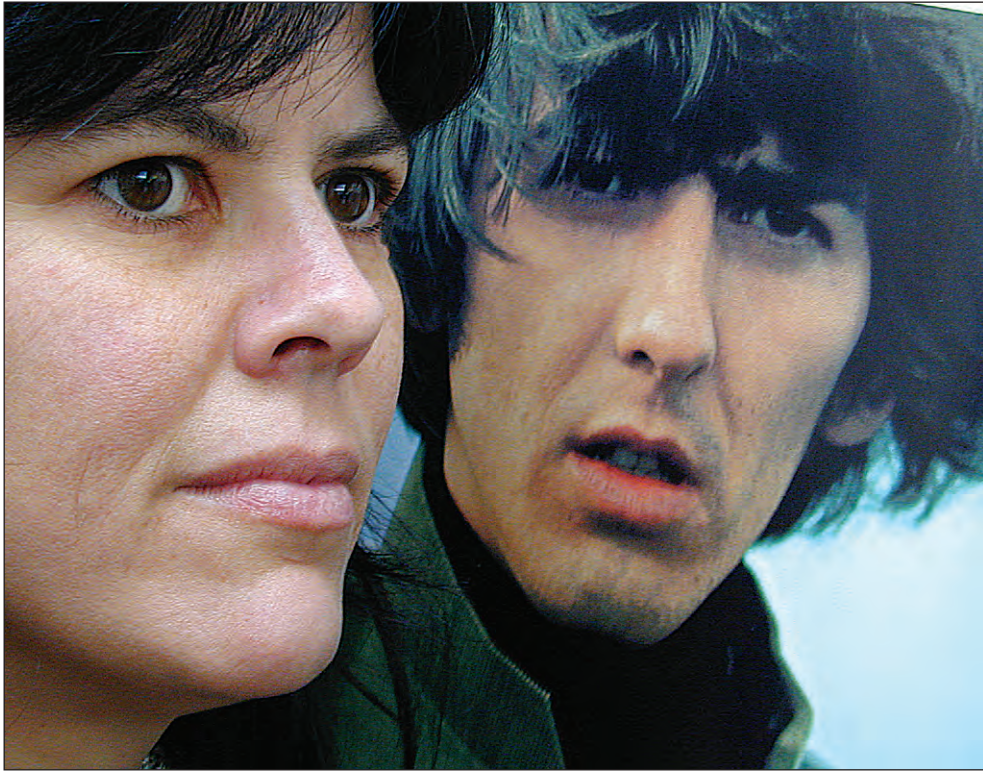
Over the past 20 years, Derrick — dressed in trademark black — has become a fixture on the island. He's so familiar at least two people have dressed up as him for Halloween.

And as I survey the treasure trove of images presented in this edition, I can't help but think how far he's come from shooting whales with an old Yashica set on automatic.

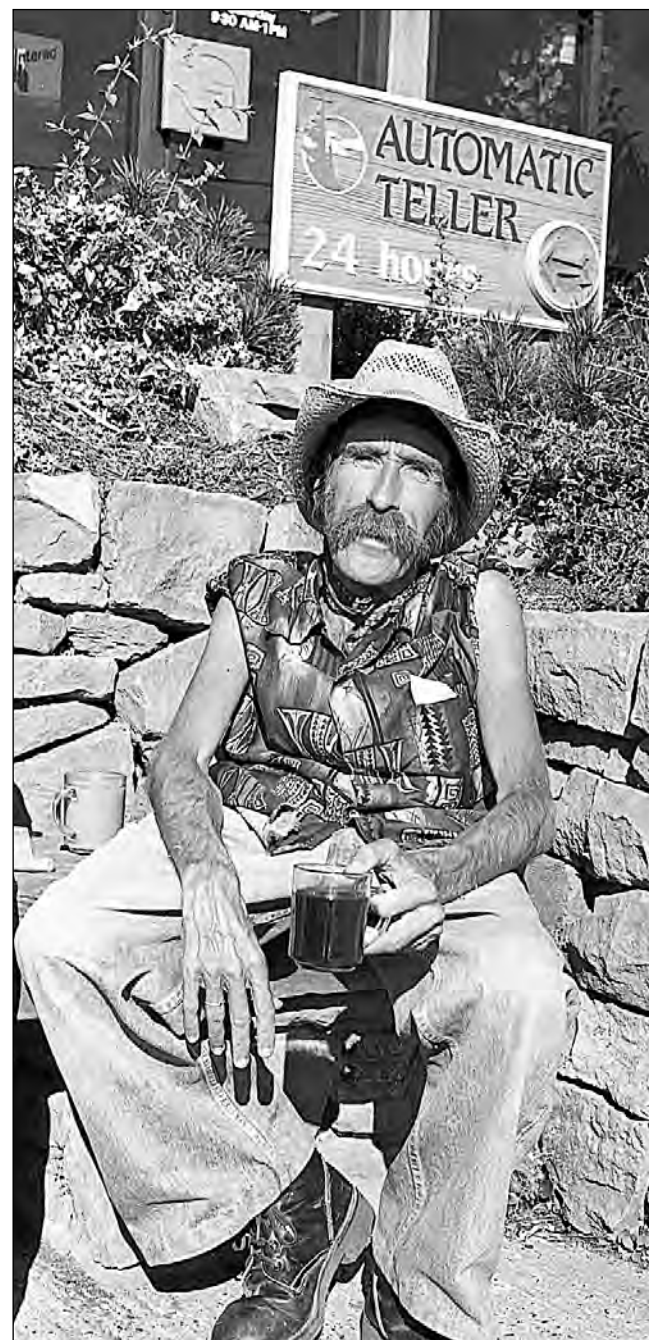

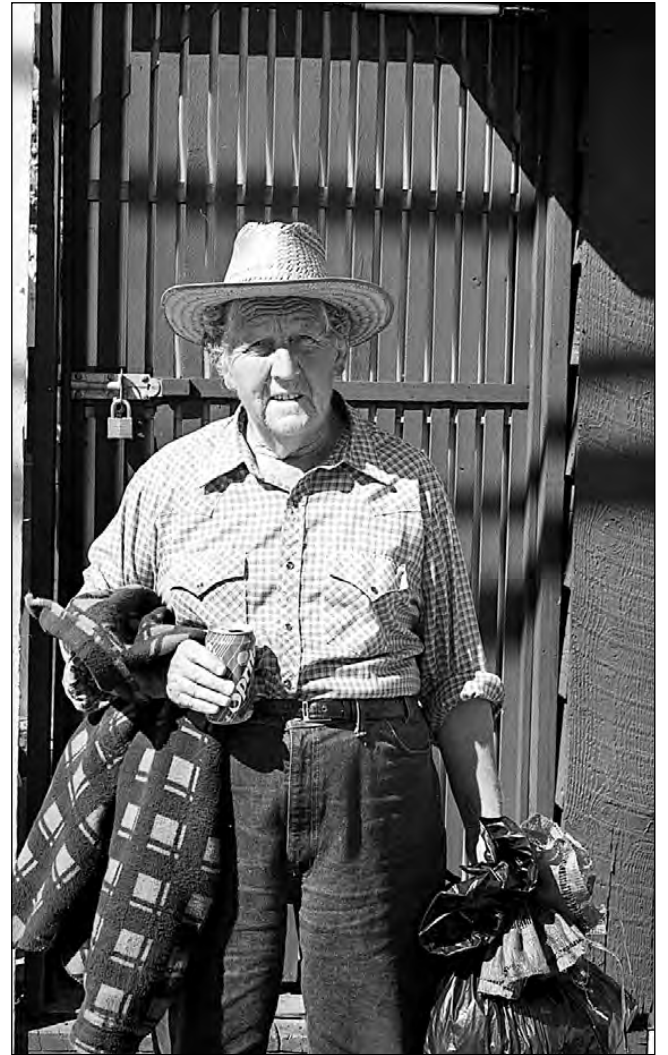

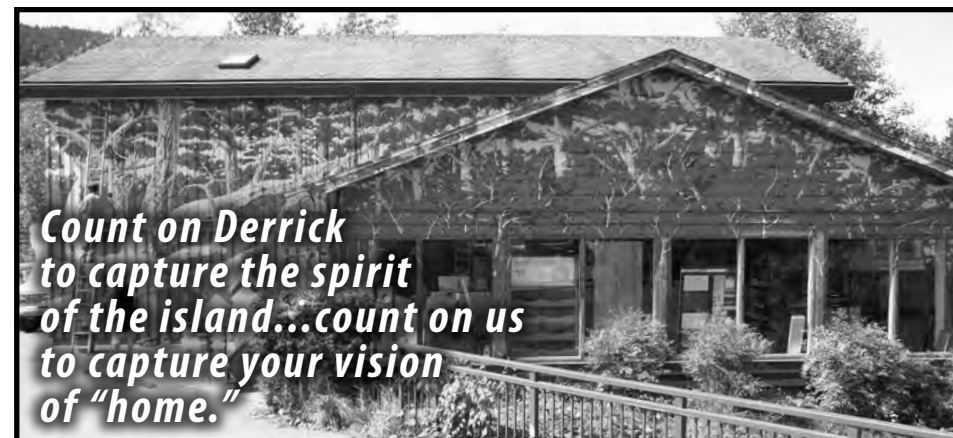
